PHONO HIJACKING INCREASE WORRIES OPS

NEW YORK - Phono hijacking is on the increase here. First reports appeared in The Cash Box some months ago. Hijacking seemed to quiet down for a short time. Has now risen to new heights with many music ops reporting losses. Machines hijacked are in best category, usually Wurlitzer 700, 750E, Seeburg 8200, etc. Ops therefore convince convinced hijackers are well acquainted with music values. Hijacking reports coming in from all over city and as far away as Yonkers, N.Y.

Only safeguard ops have is insurance coverage which they are obtaining for as low as 57¢ per \$100 on route valuations over \$25,000. This policy also covers them for fire, theft, etc., as well as hijacking. Routes valued under \$25,000 pay at rate of 75¢ per \$100.

N.Y. ARCADES FEAR UPPED LICENSE FEE

NEW YORK - Rumors are rife thruout this city that the Common Show license fee of \$50. per year, now in effect for arcades and bowling alley games will be increased to at least \$150 after the 1st of the New Year.

AOA (Arcade Owners Assn.) is now investigating these rumors and checking with this city's License Dept. Belief for sometime now has been that this license fee would be upped.

PARAMOUNT REPORTED MAKING ARCADE PIC

NEW YORK - Noted arcade men have been approached by Paramount in regard to picture they are reported to be making in their Hollywood Studios featuring an arcade. Some arcade men volunteered as "technical advisors" in an effort to prevent any adverse publicity being featured in pic.

Sometime ago King Features of Hollywood, owned by the Kochinsky Bros., California coinmen, made a picture built around a penny arcade.

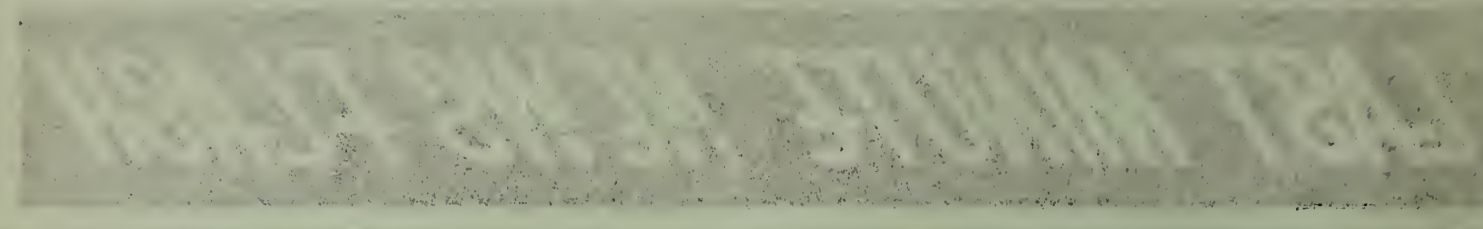
TENNESSEE COINMEN ASK LICENSE HELP

NEW YORKER GETS APPEAL TO CONTRACT

The New York Times reported today that the government has agreed to a new contract with the New York Times Co. for the purchase of newsprint. The contract, which is expected to be signed in the next few days, will provide for the purchase of 100,000 tons of newsprint over a period of five years. The price of the newsprint will be fixed at a level that is 10 percent below the market price. This is a significant concession by the government, as it has previously refused to fix the price of newsprint. The New York Times Co. has been one of the most vocal opponents of government price controls on newsprint, arguing that such controls would reduce the quality of the newspaper and harm the industry. The new contract is seen as a victory for the newspaper industry and a sign that the government is beginning to ease its economic controls.

"The Coin Machines Merry-Go-Round"

"QUIET"

Many months ago The Cash Box published an editorial entitled "Quiet". This editorial suggested that all "flash" be tapered down; that large sums of money not be openly displayed; that all matters relative to this industry be removed from public view where possible; and that quiet conservatism reign during this war period. All this was especially emphasized in view of the fact that this industry had been declared "non-essential".

Once again this same appeal is made to the industry. The report from the War Manpower Commission, the War Production Board, and other government agencies, that this war is now at the stage where all must push everything they possibly can into it, to help finish it as rapidly as possible, has brought about the feeling that non-essential industries may perhaps not be in line with the full effort required.

The tremendous success and prominence of coin operated equipment during this war period has created comment. This has particularly been noted by the sudden demand for increased taxation of this industry in various communities. This has, and will probably continue to find its way, into such crusading press as feels that such items may be of interest to their readers. Therefore, if ever there was a time for quiet - this is it.

There is no reason, at this time, why any coinfirm should have trucks roaring thru the streets with large and colorful signs of machines adorning the sides. And especially not with machines on these trucks uncovered to public view during these gas shortage days. If anything will arouse public resentment, this surely will.

There is no reason for coinmen to gather in bunches in front of any coinfirm and discuss their business openly and loudly on the sidewalk. Unloaded, and especially uncrated machines, should not be allowed to remain on sidewalks for longer than is absolutely necessary. There is also no need for store windows to be emblazoned with large and colorful signs and the interiors open and highlighted with displays of machines. Neon lighted signs and displays of this kind surely can be eliminated at this time. Of all things, this is surely not the time for any coinman to flash rolls of money.

This is the time when coinmen should most carefully guard any statements they may publicly make. It is well known thruout the trade that much territory has been lost thruout the nation during this war period. Much of this loss is attributed to too much open discussion of inner-industry affairs and too much flash at the wrong time.

By carefully, quietly and confidentially conducting its business at this time, this industry has every opportunity to continue on successfully during this war period. But, as the war nears its end, the nerves of the average man and woman in this nation become raw from the pressure being applied to speed victory. People seek some outlet for this inner unrest caused by overwork, sorrow and even anger. This industry should most certainly keep out of trouble by giving a wide berth to all matters which can create difficult and embarrassing circumstances.

This trade will have ample opportunity to shout its many advantages and its greatness to the world when the post-war era arrives. At present it should carefully contain itself. It should plan now, quietly, of its work for tomorrow. It should carefully avoid anything which might bring it to the attention of the very people who seek to harm it for their own personal gain.

Surely the members of this trade will agree that the coinman who drives a flashy car thru the streets, who calls on his locations in such a car, whose voice is unusually loud and raucous when greeting location owners, who has his men noisily carry in machines, who gathers crowds of coinmen about him in front of his place of business and loudly and openly discusses his industry and its inner secrets, who flashes large bills in public, is surely not doing this industry much good, at this time especially.

"Quiet" - is the watchword for this industry now!

RE-OPENING CLOSED TERRITORY

With so much closed territory in the nation, two courses face the trade: 1) that this territory be re-opened by legal means or 2) that machines be produced which will not apply to the present legalities under which these territories have been closed.

Naturally, everyone in the trade hopes that the latter will become the fact in the post-war period. But not much hope is being held forth in this direction, at the present time. All discussions regarding first production seem to concern itself with the products last seen by the trade when the war started.

The first course is naturally the toughest. This is something that not only requires exceptional legal talent but also needs much money and time.

It is a known fact thruout the trade that with such cities as New York, Chicago, Detroit, St. Louis, Milwaukee, Cleveland and many others closed to various types of equipment, that atremendous chunk of the post-war market is wiped away.

For example, the average computation based on the last known figures, is that the city of New York alone had in operation approximately 35,000 pin games. Chicago, Detroit and Cleveland surely had as many more. These alone account for a market of more than 70,000 machines now closed to the industry.

The trade feels this loss. It realizes that the average manufacturer will not have as much incentive to produce as he should when he notes that a great part of his market has disappeared.

This lack of proper incentive holds back progress. With competition keen, and manufacturers producing to outshine each other for the market's demand, some very fine and unusual products are the resultant effect. But with lack of competitive incentive, there surely won't be that keen desire to produce something better than the other man. The result is that the trade does not get the sort of equipment which keen competition can bring to it.

It is also understood at this time that while many coinmen discuss the fact that so much good territory is closed, very little is actually being done about it. Here and there are rumors of movements under way to get some territory open. These fail to excite the trade. Furthermore, territories are not opened on rumors nor hopes, nor just patient waiting.

During this war period, Pennsylvania and New Jersey have been lucky enough to re-open their territory. Other states, at the same time have seen much of their territory closed. For example, the adverse Supreme Court decision in the state of Wisconsin. San Diego came thru with a good decision. But others failed to bring forth good action.

This is the time for this industry to take more careful stock of this situation and decide here and now the course it will follow to get territories opened for the post-war period. This is the time when all obstacles should be cleared away to make room for the coming booming expansion period, which the post-war era is sure to be.

NEWSPAPER ADVERTISING

For some years this industry has discussed the feasibility of newspaper and general magazine advertising. In times of stress, when certain territories seemed destined to fall, coinmen got together and many times promoted advertising for the local press in what usually proved a belated effort to subsidize the paper and to also create better understanding of this business.

Newspaper advertising was also used by leading, large operators, jobbers and coinmen's associations in an effort to popularize certain types of machines as well as gain greater prestige for themselves in their territories. Such newspaper advertising usually advised the public to patronize certain locations, a list of which usually appeared in the advertisement, and which already featured this type machine.

But for some years now, and especially for a few years prior to the war, no such advertising was conducted by the members of this industry to amount to anything which might gain national attention. Just the other day, one of the leading publications in the advertising field reported that a Canadian juke box operator was now using fairly large size ads in his local newspapers. This noted trade publication wondered whether this would become general for all those engaged in the juke box business.

There is no doubt that such advertising is of value. Not only does it do its job, if conducted on a continuous and intelligent basis, that is: attracting the attention of the public and bringing them into the places of business (which this Canadian advertisement featured) where the machines of the advertiser are located, but it also has a very fine effect on the public from the standpoint of good and progressive business.

There is no doubt, too, that should a newspaper publisher receiving such ads, and should he also receive an adverse news release on coin operated machines, would probably first call in such an advertiser to obtain a better understanding, prior to releasing any editorial matter which might inadvertently harm an advertiser. This, in itself, is worth the cost of such advertising to all coinmen.

A great many in this country; distributors, jobbers and operators, are planning to eventually use such advertising. They not only plan to get to the public directly and urge more constant use of their equipment, but some even believe that they can get their locations to share in the expense. They intend to make a deal with locations whereby they will remove a small sum from each week's collections for continuing such an advertising program. Most believe locations will be happy to agree to such a plan.

Naturally, such ads would help the location as well as the operator. The ads boost the idea of patronizing the location for its food and entertainment, etc., as well as listening to the music and playing the games. Some are even of the opinion that new blood may even use such advertising as a wedge to obtain the better locations by assuring the location owner steady campaigns of this nature.

This may even open wider plans for the benefit of the trade. Perhaps with the amusement pages of the daily newspapers featuring coin machines advertising, an entirely new era may open for this industry. This would surely help to place this business on a more equal footing with other divisions of the entertainment world. And perhaps, eventually, and if sufficient volume results, this industry might also obtain the sort of daily publicity featured in the press for the movies, stage and radio worlds. (Such publicity was obtained many years ago by the sportlands in New York.)

Many other good results can also be visualized from such advertising. As yet, of course, many in this trade are in but the planning stage for such campaigns. No definite starts have been made. But from what many report, there is no doubt that such advertising will be seen, possibly even before the war is completely finished. The average coinman, tho, believes it best to wait until peace arrives, prior to starting any definite advertising program of this nature.

In the meantime, all will agree that this Canadian operator has pointed the possible new trend for '45. His advertising not only captured the attention of this noted advertising trade publication, but it is sure to capture attention of all newspaper and magazine publishers and probably start their solicitors out on a program of obtaining such advertising, too. This may yet lead to what this industry has always wanted, from a public relations standpoint, to gain the greater understanding of the public and its officials - thru the press of this nation - which has proved itself the mightiest wielder of public influence.

"TALKING OUT LOUD"

TRADE FEARS BIG TAX BOOSTS IN '45

WANTS NATIONAL FIGURE TO HEAD TAX COUNCIL & PUBLIC RELATIONS BUREAU TO HELP OFFSET BITES OF TAX BUGS.

NEW YORK—Growing fears of tremendously increased license fees for 1945 were apparent thruout the trade this past week. A great many letters have already been received by The Cash Box to this effect. As state legislatures prepare to meet for 1945, coinmen believe that bills will be brought up on the floor and placed into instant action, requesting that coin operated equipment be highly taxed.

Coinmen point to the news now appearing in their local press to substantiate their beliefs. They claim that with almost every state suffering from lack of gasoline tax revenue, in addition to the fact that post-war public works programs are now being placed into effect to help returning servicemen, all adds up to the need for instant protection for coinmen.

Tennessee has already heard that when their state legislature gets together this January that there will be a bill introduced to tremendously increase coin machines taxes. Savannah, Georgia is now fighting a proposed increase in phono and pin licenses. Other states and cities are worried. Many have sent in rush calls for former precedents, as well as for all data which can be quickly gathered together, to help offset tax increases.

"This is only the beginning", one noted coin leader writes, "they are intending to boost taxes on phonographs and pin games and all other types of coin machines during 1945. The states need revenue. They need plenty of it to offset the losses which they have had on gas and other taxes.

"They also are trying to prepare themselves for the return of soldiers and sailors by arranging public works programs. They will need plenty of tax money for such programs.

"It looks like this industry is in for one hell of a beating unless we do something quick. Your proposal that we get together into a National Tax Council and have this Council backed up by a Public Relations Bureau is the best that has as yet been advanced. This should be done immediately."

These past few weeks have also seen more letters urging that the services of a national figure to head a Public Relations Bureau and a National Tax Council be obtained than ever since this plan was first offered to the trade.

All agree that there must be some outstanding and nationally recognized personage, who would prove of tremendous value to the trade, to head either a National Tax Council or a Public Relations Bureau or possibly even a combination of both, for the general welfare of the industry.

The suggestion The Cash Box made sometime ago that a National Tax Council where all data, records, cases, bills, precedents and all other necessary material would be on hand as well as a trained staff of tax experts, is now gaining greater agreement as the trade faces this New Year. The majority believe 1945 will probably see greater taxes than ever before for this, and many other industries.

Each day more and still more reports continue to filter into The Cash Box urging that some method be instantly adopted to create the National Tax Council and the Public Relations Bureau, and that some sort of self-imposed payment be arranged whereby these will be made self-supporting.

There is no doubt that before 1945 is well advanced something will have to be done to offset the plans of these tax bugs or otherwise they may tax much of this industry out of being. An educational plan could also be evolved which would explain to the various councilmen and legislators just what effect high taxation has upon industry.

The lesson which Uncle Sam learned when overtaxing the jewelry and fur trades can also be brought home. Other unfair and inequitable taxation methods which have resulted in general economic loss should be brought forth. All this requires a complete and efficient staff — and such would be the case were a National Tax Council and a Public Relations Bureau arranged, as trade now urges.

SAVINGS DEPOSITS AT RECORD LEVELS

PHILADELPHIA, PA.—Those who may have feared that the public is wastefully spending its money and that there wouldn't be any good customers to sell to in an effort to increase the membership of this, or any other industry, can put those fears to sleep, according to the report of SEC (Securities and Exchange Commission) just made public in this city.

The American public's liquid savings during July, August and September totaled over \$10,600,000,000, the highest on record. Of the total, \$6,400,000,000 is in cash and deposits, \$2,300,000,000 in U. S. Government securities, \$1,200,000,000 in Government insurances and \$700,000,000 in private insurance.

The rate of growth in individuals' cash and deposits was the greatest in history, with the total increase reflecting a \$1,300,000,000 rise in currency, a \$2,900,000,000 rise in demand deposits and a \$2,100,000,000 rise in time and savings deposits.

NEW JERSEY MAYOR WANTS BINGO

UNION—Mayor F. Edward Bier-tuempfel of this city not only favors Bingo games but wants them for his community.

The Mayor personally doesn't go for the game, but neither does he think its simple pleasures should be denied to his constituents, provided of course that the prizes are in merchandise and not cash.

"It's ridiculous", the Mayor stated this past week, "for one county in one section of the state to interpret the state laws differently from another county."

The Mayor was upset over the report that Attorney General Walter Van Riper was reported beginning an investigation of the bingo situation in Hudson County.

"As a public official", the Mayor claimed, "it is incumbent on me to study what the people in Union Township want in the way of simple pleasures, recreation and thrills. They, I have found, want bingo."

The Mayor outlined a code of ethics for bingo. No bingo on Sunday was the first rule. The second, children were not allowed to play. No cash prizes, only merchandise awards and these could not be bought back by the sponsors of the game. The game only to be operated by recognized local organizations. He doesn't want fancy promoters in Union.

"I'm convinced bingo as we play it", he concluded, "is not gambling. As long as it isn't gambling, I say let our people have some fun."

WHITE HOUSE COIN MACHINES FAIL PRESIDENT

WASHINGTON, D. C.—The coin machines located in the White House failed President Franklin D. Roosevelt this past week.

These are two cigarette machines, and since the shortage all visitors as well as the guards, secretaries and other White House retainers have been purchasing their cigarettes from them.

When the President sent down his secretary this past week to get his favorite brand of cigarettes — the machines were empty. According to reports, this is the first time the machines have failed the President.

NEW YORK — The party given Teddy Cohn by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Nat Cohn (Modern Music Sales Company, this city) in honor of his 13th birthday, jammed the Starlight Roof of the Waldorf-Astoria this past Saturday evening and brought many coinmen from out of town as well as from this city to this affair.

Everyone present pronounced it the most outstanding affair of its kind in their memory. In addition to Nat Brusiloff's work and the regular entertainment, dinner and dancing which Nat provided there were many guest stars. Henny Youngman, Jan Bart, Arthur "Street Singer" Tracy, and many others made appearances and entertained the gathering.

Among those from Chicago who were present were Al S. Douglas of Daval Products Corp., Mr. and Mrs. Lou Koren, Mr. and Mrs. Max Glass.

WPB MAY TIGHTEN LUMBER CONTROL

Philip Boyd, director of WPB's Lumber and Lumber Products Division, the tighter regulations would have the effect of placing distribution controls over lumber that now may be bought without certification.
