"The Coin Machines Merry-Go-Round" By Bill Gersh



CREDIT BUREAU

Many months ago The Cash Box suggested that a "Coin Machines Credit Bureau" be created to help solve a great many problems existant today, and that such a bureau would prove especially effective for the future. Without dosiring to, The Cash Box has been acting as what might be termed, a "Credit Clearing House" for sometime now. A subscriber in California, ready to do business with someone somewhere olse in the country, wires us for information. We, in turn, wire whatever information we have available. (We are generally in receipt

whatovor information we have available. (We are generally in receipt of from two to thirty wires of like character each wook.) Wore there a "Coin Machines Credit Bureau" in existence it could properly rate each man's position in this industry - as manufacturer, distributor, jobber or operator, as well as arrange for a credit rating (which most firms in this industry do not care to turn over to general credit sources) and therefore could be the medium for exchange for all credit information for the industry.

Futheremore, by establishing a credit rating with such an organization, would not necessarily mean that one member of this industry would have to issue credit to another or even ship open account. But, it would mean that coinmen would know, from week to week or month to month as the credit information was issued, whether by shipping this certain person C.O.D. they would be stuck with froight charges and have to recall the merchandiso or whether the party they were doing business with was sufficiently accredited to receive such courtesy.

As we have predicted, after this war higher finance will enter into the coin machines industry and will open credit for members of this industry with greater liberality than ever before. The finance firms back of the music machines industry have proven that credit can be safely issued and that coinmen are just as trustworthy as all other businessmen. With more credit better available than ever, after the war, this will mean that the average distributor in this business will have to be in position to give credit and will perhaps have to be financed for the credit he will issue. Therefore the establishment of a "Credit Bureau" or a "Credit Clearing House" at this time is all-important.

Most of the pre-war manufacturers were already issuing credit, financed of course to their distributors who, in turn, passed it along the line to the operators. Therefore credit has already been established. To continue to make credit a further possibility as well as a surety for the post-war era - the members of this industry should get together now to create a "Coin Machines Credit Bureau".

BEER RATIONING


The brewing industry is now studying plans to ration sales of beer to retailers. Such action is necessary, it was reported, because of the recent order of the War Production Board restricting the brewer's use of malt and the possibility that the war may be prolonged.

What does this mean to the coin machines industry? Simply, that by rationing boor, the brewing trade is actually giving greater importance than ever before to the coin operated equipment located in tavorns.

The take from coin machines will now become extremely important to the tavern owner. It will mean the difference between his remaining in or getting out of businoss.

Once again, the coin machines industry is proving its usefulness generally by boing the means for the maintenance of the retail business backbone of this nation. Retailer after retailer would long ago have closed his doors if not for the coin operated equipment in his place of business. The average drug or early store fighting hard to get their usual merchandise (and not getting it in most instances) are paying their rent and the greater part of the rest of their overhead with their share from coin operated equipment located in their places.

This is one fact that only a National Board of Trado, able to obtain figures from everywhere in the country, could capably publicize and win greater respect from all business men, as well as from the general public, for the coin machines industry. And this, too, is another reason why the members of this industry should bear themselves with greater dignity and understanding and cement the friendships that they are making today to assure themselves of temorrow - especially for the boom that will follow the war.



TRANSPORTATION

Once again the problem of continued transportation for coin operated equipment rears its head, and this time from a potential subscriber to The Cash Box. This man is well known to all the industry. He has just re-entered the business and is impressed with the work that The Cash Box is doing. "But", he writes, "what about future transportation of non-essentials?"

As our readers know the transportation problem has been one that The Cash Box has never evaded. It has stepped in and dared tread on ground considered much too delicate by others. We bet \$100.00 last October ('42) in Detroit with one distrib there who told us at that time that within 60 days there would be no further transport of coin operated equipment. In fact, we gave him much longer than 60 days - we gave him instead, up to March 21, 1943. And we've won that bet. (We hope he'll pay off.)

The trouble with a lot of us these days is that we have our noses pressed too closely to the windows of our own place of business to see what is going on around us. By closing down one industry after another, and thereby saving freight space, there was a certainty that transportation (both rail and truck) would continue. In short, the freight cars that were formerly used for automobiles, rofrigerators, electrical appliances, furniture, etc., etc., down the long line of industries not doing business anymore, are now available for war transport purposes as well as for the transportation necessary to maintain whatever business there is left in this nation. And, with the nation's leaders wracking their brains to help keep the retail business backbone of this nation going, there is no earthly reason as yet why coin machines should not be transported. In short, as more industries disappear, more room is made for those that are continuing - that's only simple logic.

To back up the above statements here are the figures of the American Association of Railroads as announced on April 1st, "Loadings of revenue freight for the week ending March 27th were 787,360 cars. This was 19,226 cars or 2.5 per cent more than for the preceding week, 20,926 cars or 2.6 per cent fewer than for the corresponding week last year and 6,443 cars of .8 per cent fewer than during the corresponding week two years ago."

Another fine barometer that U. S. coinmen can use for continued transport of equipment is that of Great Britain, where, blitzed and blitzed again, coinmen are still doing business, still shipping each other the few machines that are available and getting as much as \$200. (in our money) for the eldest type pin games. England will continue and so will these United States to enjoy continued shipping that means maintaining the retail business backbone of the nation. And, there again is another reason for a National Board of Trade - to tell the public why coin machines are important, especially during this time of general business stress.

MANPOWER

Another prospective subscriber to The Cash Box came to us with this question, "What in the h--1" are we going to do on May 1st when the manpower problem will really get tough?" It is the belief of The Cash Box that the manpower problem just can't get any cougher than it is at the present time for the members of this industry. The industry has already lost the majority of whatever fine mechanics were available. Yet, most firms have been able to continue and are doing a very fine job of it, too.

The Cash Box agrees that the manpower problem will get tougher. Perhaps by May 1st - perhaps later. But, it will get tougher as the demand for agricultural workers increases from now to harvesting. And that's why The Cash Box has been the lone voice in the great void of this industry that has been urging coinmen to get mechanically minded gals to work for them while they still have mechanics to act as teachers and while there is still time.

In answer to this prospective subscriber and to all of our subscribers who may be seriously thinking of the manpower problem - get gals. As we have stated in the past, they have proven themselves efficient, capable and loyal. After this war is ever we're going to see a lot more women engaged in this business than we did before. We're going to see that because some are going to be widows taking over routes, some are going to have to handle business for men who will return maimed, some will jump in because of the knowledge of mechanics they are now gaining in war production plants and the fascination of this industry and some will come into it who are now serving their apprenticeship as mechanics and servicegals for firms here and there thrucut the country who have already put them to work. (One noted music operator in Bostom who is already using two girls for servicing and collecting reports that they are much more reliable and much better all around than the average man he has had on these jobs.)

BRITISH COIN MACHINE FACTORIES?

It is reported that certain manufacturers in England are today considering the manufacture of coin operated equipment after the war. British manufacturers have proven themselves extremely capable during this war. Now, with general manufacturing in this highly commercial and industrial nation at a greater peak than ever before and with more skilled labor available due to training in war production work, certain English manufacturers believe that they, too, are just as ingenious as are our own American coin machine manufactories and contemplate entering the coin machines field with creations of their own when the war is over.

As one noted commentator wrote a few days ago, there is a possibility that England may have a six months jump on us if the war in Europe finishes first. He believed that even the British would keep their word and help us to lick the Japs, that with the war over in Europe, the British Isles, regardless of the Pacific tangle would be able to come back to normalcy first and that they would gain at least six months or so on American manufacturers which would prove extremely costly in the race for international business that will follow the end of this war. We are personally of the opinion that American ingenuity and American methods will overcome even a 16 months lead by the British for international trade. But, at this moment some are wondering whether American operators because of this will be importing machines from England as England did from America prior to this war.

Recalling far back in the earlier stages of coin machines history Americans imported machines from Germany, Switzerland, England and France. Many will still recall the "Seca" scale which won a large following in '27, '28 and at the famous "scale convention" in '29 at the Hotel Winton in Cleveland. Others will also recall other machines of various types that were imported. Since then, of course, and with the introduction of the pin games, American manufacturers took over and led the parade.

Yet, it is interesting to consider the possibilities of an English industrial invasion of the American coin machines market, especially in view of the fact that there is a great possibility that they may be producing six months or so ahead of our own manufacturers and the trade here will be crying for new machines of all kinds. Some factories in this country, years ago, sold the manufacturing rights to their products to British firms who did a very miserable sales and promotion job. But, with the world changes that have come about, with a greater fraternization of peoples, many unique and uncommon things are going to happen when this war ends. We shall interestingly await the first products that these British manufacturers produce. There is no doubt that they will have some unique ideas and some of these may prove of value to us over here. But, by far and large, the American market, because of its ingenuity, speed and many complexities will dominate the world coin machines scene, both in manufacturing and sales methods, in our humblo opinion, regardless of how many British manufacturers enter the picture.
