"The Coin Machines Merry-Go-Round"

1942 MARKET PRICES

Since publication of The Confidential Price Lists in our past (September 7) issue there have been some questions regarding prices which appeared in that issue. According to GMPR (General Maximum Price Regulation) under which all "wholesalers" in this industry are regulated and have been regulated since March, 1942, your highest selling price for any item as of March 1942 is your ceiling price for that item. If you did not sell any given item in March 1942 the way for you to determine your ceiling price on such an item is to take the price of your competitor for that item. The September 7th issue of The Confidential Price Lists show the market prices of your competitors!



As is well known to the trade, The Cash Box has been conducting The Confidential Price Lists for some years. We made an intensive survey to get the March 1942 market prices which appeared in the September 7th issue of The Confidential Price Lists. We also left an open space alongside these market prices so that you could write in the prices for which you may have sold any of the machines in March 1942. If your selling price was higher than the market price you can write this price in as your ceiling price as long as you can prove this higher price by showing a bill of sale or other transaction record. If your selling price in March 1942 was lower than the market price shown you can write this in, too. If you have no record of a selling price for any certain item as of March 1942 you can instead use the market price (which appeared in the September 7th issue of The Confidential Price Lists) and which were your competitors prices for that period.

It will be to your interest to obtain a copy at your local OPA office and read the General Maximum Price Regulation which was amended on March 11, 1943. This tells you how to arrive at your ceiling prices. You can accept the market prices of March 1942 as they appeared in the September 7, 1943 issue of The Cash Box in The Confidential Price Lists as the prices of your competitors, or you can do as we did and arrange a complete compilation yourself covering all equipment sold in March, 1942, for the similar equipment you are selling at this time. Remember, if you have no record of any sale price for any certain item for March 1942 you can quote the market price known for similar equipment in March 1942, that is, the prices of your competitors.

The Confidential Price List has its own methods for discovering and computing the market prices. These are compiled and placed on record in this September 7, 1943 issue as the market prices of March 1942. You cannot sell any machine above your ceiling price without first proving to and getting permission from your local OPA office as to why you must get more money for the machine. You do this by filing an application on which you show repair costs, costs of parts, labor, trucking, overhead, etc., etc., and which brings your price up. We understand that individual applications must be filed for individual machines. If your local OPA office agrees to this increase and gives you permission, then you can sell that certain machine above your ceiling price.

The problem of MPR-429 still remains static. That is, the clarification from OPA as to whether the "operator" is to be considered the "consumer". The general opinion of the trade is that the operator is NOT the "consumer". (OPA hasn't as yet stated otherwise.) The belief is that he is a wholesaler, according to the definition of what a "sale at wholesale" is in MPR-429. As far as the wholesaler is concerned, and even if the operator is also interpreted as a wholesaler by OPA under MPR-429 (which became law on September 1, 1943) he is still under GMPR. The wholesaler is excepted from MPR-429. The wholesaler continues under GMPR where he has always been along with all the industry. The definition of a wholesaler, according to MPR-429, and which has been repeated here many times, is:

"Sales at wholesale. A sale at wholesale is a sale to a person who buys for the purpose of reselling the goods, rather than for use. Sales at wholesale remain covered by the General Maximum Price Regulation."

Here is the bone of contention which the appointed committee argued before OPA in Washington. The fact that an operator does not purchase a coin machine for his own

"Use". He does not "use" the machine as he would other products covered in this regulation MPR-429, like hatchets, axes, wheelbarrows, etc. He instead leases the machine to the location owner and the ultimate consumer is the "public". The public "use" the machine to obtain an amusement or other service.

This matter may yet have to be decided before a court of law if OPA will attempt any but the proper clarification. It will be up to whoever goes to court to prove to the court that a "coin operated vending machine" as mentioned in MPR-429 is not "used" like the consumer's durable goods mentioned in this regulation. We feel confident that some coin machine man is going to win this case, if such ever comes up. Under GMPR (as amended March 11, 1943) the definition of a wholesaler is:

"'Sale at wholesale' means a sale to a person who buys a commodity and resells it without substantially changing its form to any person other than the ultimate consumer except for the purpose of paragraph 1499.3 of GMPR. A sale at wholesale shall include any sale by such person to an industrial or commercial user."

Remember that no decision has as yet been made (at least not up to this writing) by The Office of Price Administration as to whether the operator is the consumer or whether they are going to add into their definition of a wholesaler in MPR-429 the words "or leasing", and thereby make this clarification read as follows:

"A sale at wholesale is a sale to a person who buys for the purpose of reselling OR LEASING the goods rather than for use."

The market prices as of March 1942, which appeared in the September 7 issue of The Cash Box, were compiled from prices as quoted thruout the entire nation at that time. These market prices can be accepted for ascertaining your ceiling prices on machines on which you have no sales price in March 1942 for they are the prices of your competitors. Again we repeat, if you have quoted lower prices in March 1942 for some of the machines which appear on this list, these are your ceiling prices. You can type them in the column that is left open for you for this very purpose. If you, likewise, believe that you should get higher prices than your ceiling prices (as of March 1942, prices you quoted) you can make application to your local OPA office to get such higher prices by proving to them why you must get more for those machines.

If you study the September 7, 1943 issue of The Confidential Price Lists carefully you will be amazed to learn that a great many machines you thought were getting high prices at this time were actually LOW, in comparison to the prices that were being quoted in March 1942. This is one of the many peculiarities of this business, due to the popularity of certain equipment under certain conditions at certain times.

To keep you further informed, and beginning with this (September 14) issue, we shall also list (alongside the March 1942 market price) the highest current price being quoted for all equipment. This will help you to maintain the records that are required by OPA. In most cases you will probably find that the highest current market price for any machine for the week may be lower than the ceiling price. We shall list higher prices than March 1942 market prices, too. We shall accept these higher prices on the theory that someone obtained permission to make his price higher, or that he sold for this higher price during March, 1942, and that this higher price is therefore his ceiling price. The March 1942 market price will remain as a stationary price fixture for the time being in The Confidential Price Lists.

SECOND WARTIME CONFERENCE

A great many problems as yet face this industry. The Petrillo situation grows more and more involved each day. At some future date it will prove imperative for this industry to be represented at conferences which will yet have to be held with the AFM. Here again is the need for an intelligent committee to be present at such a meet to carefully guard the interests of the automatic music men in this industry.

The ASCAP situation is more serious than some believe. Their demand, which amounts to from \$60. to \$120. per year per location by these publishers of copyrighted music is something to be seriously considered. This may be the route that will lead to a confiscatory drain upon the incomes of a great many in this business. A legal case is getting under way being fought out by one association of music operators and they are doing all the work to defend what is really a national matter for all in the music machines division of this industry.

The 5% cabaret tax is also puzzling to a great many. An educational campaign in this matter should be arranged for to as completely protect the men in this industry as is possible. All these attempts to obtain part of the revenue being enjoyed by this industry is sufficient cause for the men in this business to come together for their own self preservation.

Washington may soon announce completely new and higher taxes in regard to coin operated machines of all types. This, in addition to city, county and state taxes will create a noticeable dent in the bankrolls of the men engaged in this business. If the federal government decides that this industry should pay more than it is now paying, with no one present to somehow help it from being so overtaxed, the effect may prove more serious than anyone as yet has any idea it will be.

It is therefore the hope of The Cash Box, as well as the large majority of those who attended the first Wartime Conference, that another conference be held within 60 days in some centrally located city (probably Chicago) to call together the members of this industry from every section of the country to meet in national conclave and to create there the National Coin Machines Board of Trade. This is to be an organization for all present organizations and all individuals in this industry to use this organization as the common meeting ground for all connected with this business as a non-political, non-profit, mutually beneficial organization.

NEED FOR CENTRAL BODY

One noted midwestern coinman in speaking for the necessity of an organization to represent this industry nationally stated, "Here we have an industry wherein millions of dollars are invested. An industry that takes in millions of dollars annually thru its many different types of equipment. An industry composed of a large number of progressive and fairly well off business men. Yet we continue to conduct our business, from a national standpoint, like a little two-by-four shopkeeper without any inventory books, records or other definite information regarding our industry.

"There are only a few, if any at all, who can give any correct statistics about our business. We don't even know the exact number of persons engaged in this industry. We don't know the exact number of machines or locations in the country. Everything we say cannot be backed up with facts or figures. When we claim: so many thousands of locations for any one division of the field, we are only guessing, and basing this guess on what someone has told us was the number of this type of equipment sold.

"It is absolutely necessary for us to come together and to create a body of men of our industry who will arrange for surveys and other data which will at least enable us to know where we stand as an industry, and what should be done to make this industry greater than ever before, thereby earning more money for those already engaged in this business and those who are entering to know how to proceed correctly."

Certainly these are simple and direct words. Certainly they expose a great weakness of the coin machines industry. And most certainly this condition should and could be cured by the cooperation of all the men engaged in this industry.

CIGARETTE AND CANDY MACHINES

After a great many requests from all over the nation that we set up a market price listing for cigarette and candy vendors, The Cash Box with this (September 14) issue of The Confidential Price Lists starts listing this equipment. This will follow along the same lines of the prices now being listed for other types of equipment. Cigarette and candy merchandisers have won an impressive position in this industry. These machines have become more or less price standardized.

The cigarette machine operator, jobber and distributor knows just about what the price for each individual type of machine should be. Yet machines are always coming and going on this market and therefore a very large number of subscribers are interested in this field and would like to have a compilation of each week's high and low quotations.

It is our hope, that like with all other equipment now appearing in The Confidential Price Lists, we shall receive the complete cooperation of the cigarette and candy coinmen and that we shall thereby be able to give these people a timely and accurate report of market price conditions from week to week.

THIRD VICTORY LOAN DRIVE

Once again coinmen have an opportunity to help more directly in the war effort with the campaign now being planned for the Third Victory Loan Drive thruout the country. It would be of tremendously gratifying benefit to all this industry to have every coinman thruout the nation enter into this drive wholeheartedly and not only purchase some War Bonds himself, but make it his business to get as many of his locations as he possibly can to do likewise. Such effort is instantly recognized and commended by the leaders in each community. It is the one sure way to win the proper prestige and respect for this industry. 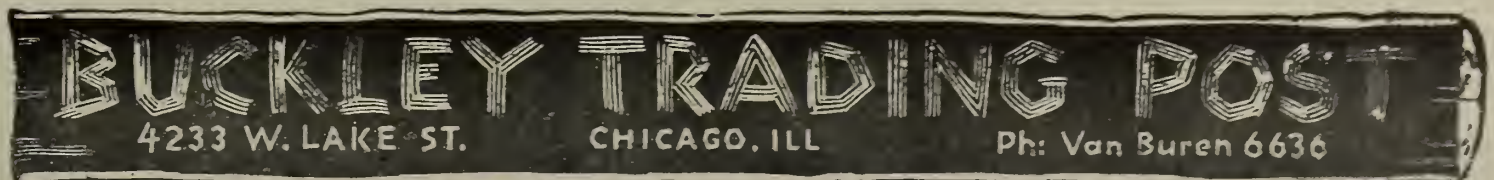

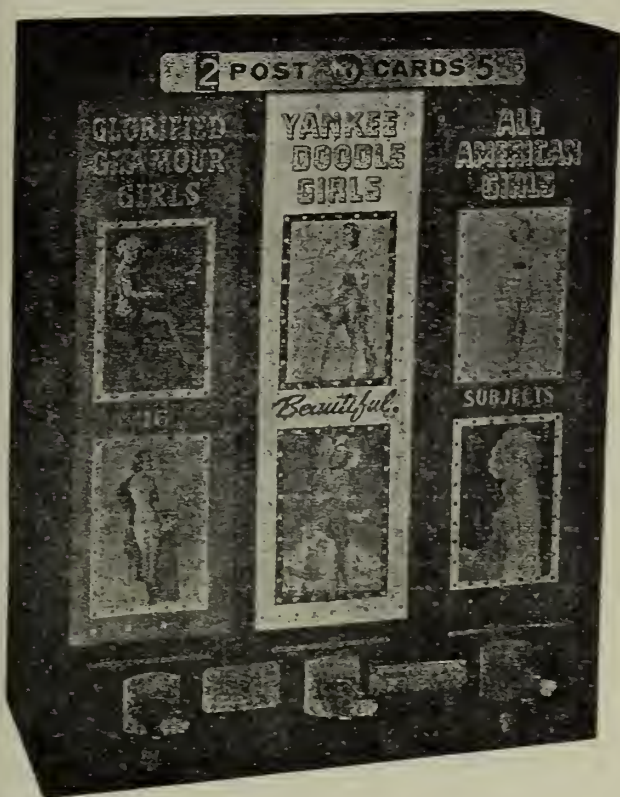

SINCE YOU ARE UNDER GMPR (GENERAL MAXIMUM PRICE REGULATION) YOU MUST HAVE A RECORD OF YOUR CEILING PRICES FOR ALL TYPES OF EQUIPMENT WHETHER NEW OR USED.

HERE'S HOW YOU GET YOUR CEILING PRICES: MAKE A LIST OF THE MACHINES YOU SOLD IN MARCH 1942 WITH THE PRICES AT WHICH YOU SOLD THEM. THESE PRICES BECOME YOUR CEILING PRICES FOR THESE SAME MACHINES - WHEN YOU GO TO SELL THEM TODAY.

IF YOU HAVE MACHINES FOR SALE TODAY THAT YOU DID NOT SELL IN MARCH 1942 - AND THEREFORE HAVE NO RECORD OF PRICES FOR THESE MACHINES ON YOUR BOOKS AS OF MARCH 1942 -- AND WANT TO OBTAIN YOUR CEILING PRICES SO THAT YOU CAN SELL THESE MACHINES WITHIN THE LETTER OF THE LAW -- YOU THEN TAKE THE PRICES OF YOUR COMPETITORS FOR THESE MACHINES -- THE PRICES THAT THEY SOLD THESE MACHINES FOR IN MARCH 1942.

THESE ARE THE PRICES THAT APPEARED IN THE MARCH 1942 MARKET PRICES OF "THE CONFIDENTIAL PRICE LISTS" IN THE SEPTEMBER 7, 1943 ISSUE OF "THE CASH BOX". THESE PRICES THEN BECOME YOUR CEILING PRICES ON THE MACHINES WHERE YOU HAVE NO RECORD OF ANY PRICES ON YOUR BOOKS IN MARCH 1942. (A SPACE WAS LEFT OPEN FOR YOU IN THIS SEPTEMBER 7, 1943 ISSUE OF "THE CONFIDENTIAL PRICE LISTS" ALONGSIDE THE MARCH 1942 MARKET PRICE THAT WAS LISTED SO THAT YOU CAN WRITE YOUR PRICE IN.)

WHATEVER CLARIFICATION OPA MAKES REGARDING MPR-429 DOES NOT AFFECT YOU AS A WHOLESALE. WHOLESALERS, WE REPEAT, ARE EXEMPTED FROM MPR-429.

REGARDING MPR-429: The industry contends that the operator "leases" machines and does not "use" machines as persons would use a hatchet or wheelbarrow or some used furniture or any other consumer's durable goods (as covered by MPR-429 which was originally written to protect the migratory war worker from being gouged by inflated prices for used furniture and other consumer's durable items). Therefore the operator should be considered a wholesaler or retailer so that he can buy and sell at wholesale. (Remember, that as yet OPA hasn't given any interpretation or clarification that the operator IS NOT a wholesaler). If the operator is interpreted to be a consumer by OPA then he will have to be sold under the conditions appearing in MPR-429. These conditions are as follows: Used machines in good condition will be designated as Class I used machines and the operator must be sold the machines in this category at 75% of the new list price of these machines; used machines in poor condition will be Class II used machines and the operator must be sold these machines at 33 1/3 % of the new list price of these machines. THIS IS ONLY IF AND WHEN OPA RULES THAT THE OPERATOR IS TO BE CONSIDERED A "CONSUMER".

The industry contends that the basic and actual "consumer" of the services of any coin operated machines is the public - the man who actually puts the coin into the machine to play it for amusement, music or obtain some merchandise or other service from it.

REGARDLESS OF WHETHER OPA DECIDES THAT THE "OPERATOR" IS THE "CONSUMER" THIS STILL DOES NOT AFFECT THE "WHOLESALE". HE STILL REMAINS UNDER "GENERAL MAXIMUM PRICE REGULATION" AS OF MARCH 1942.
