

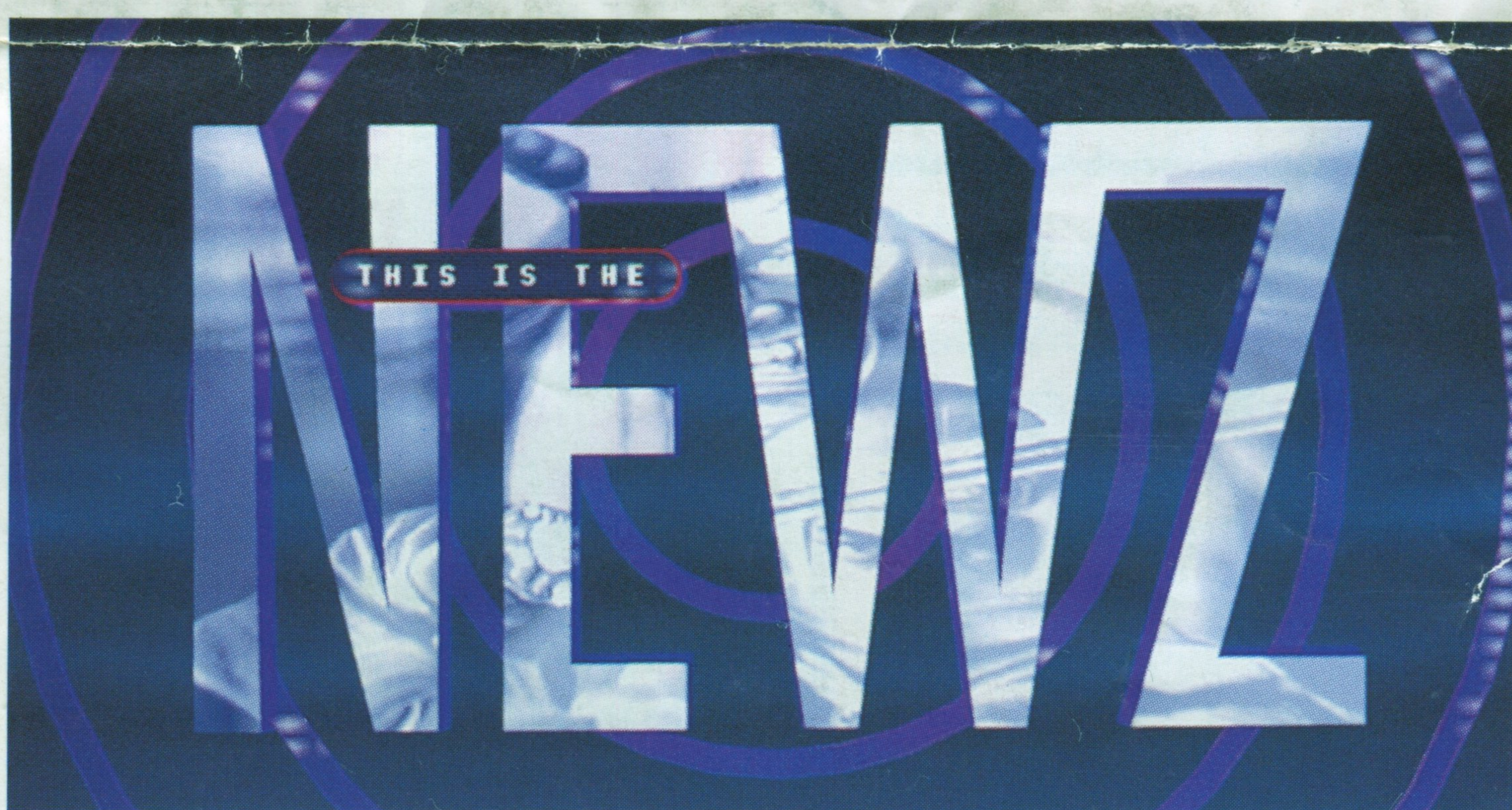

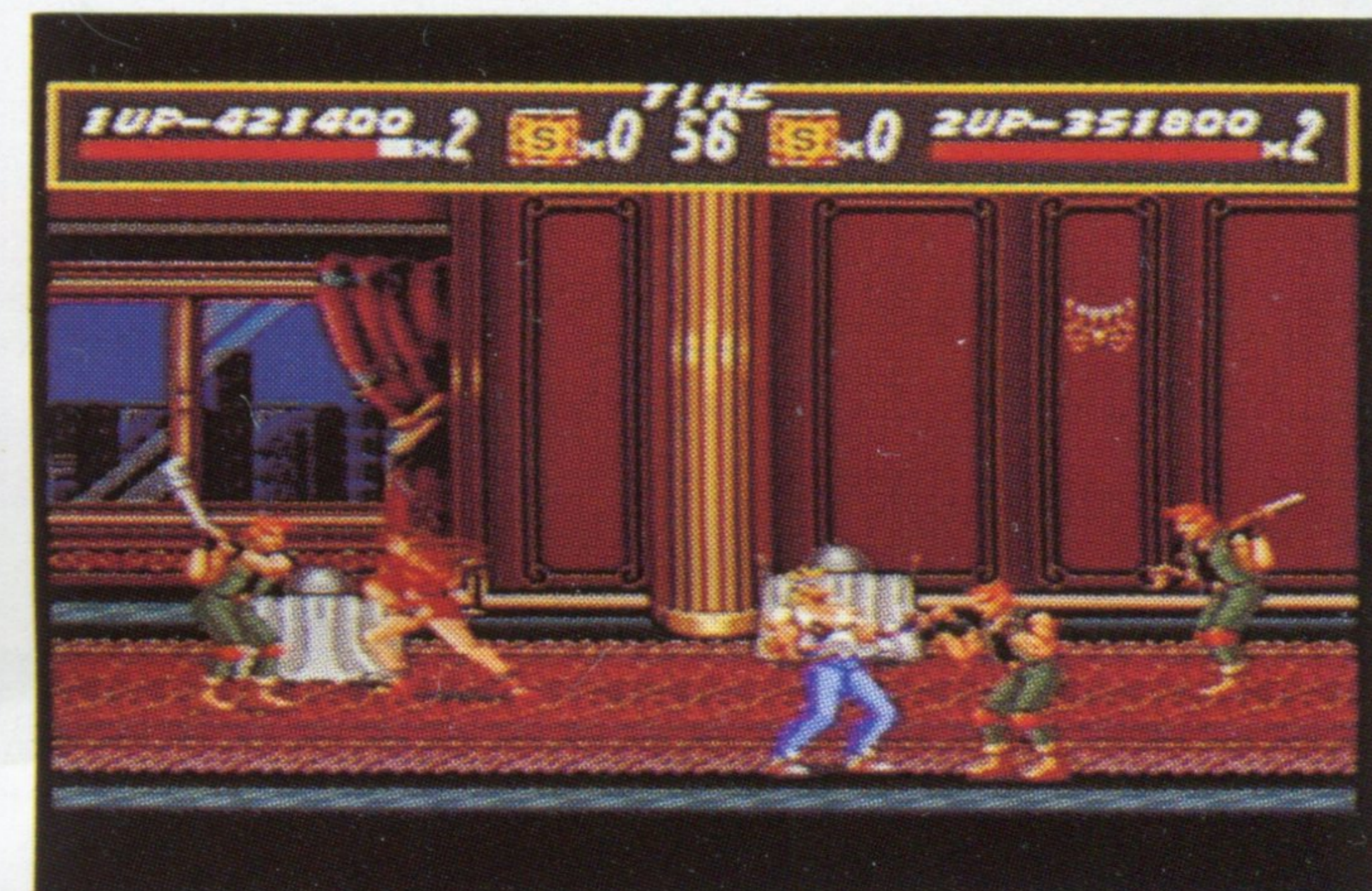
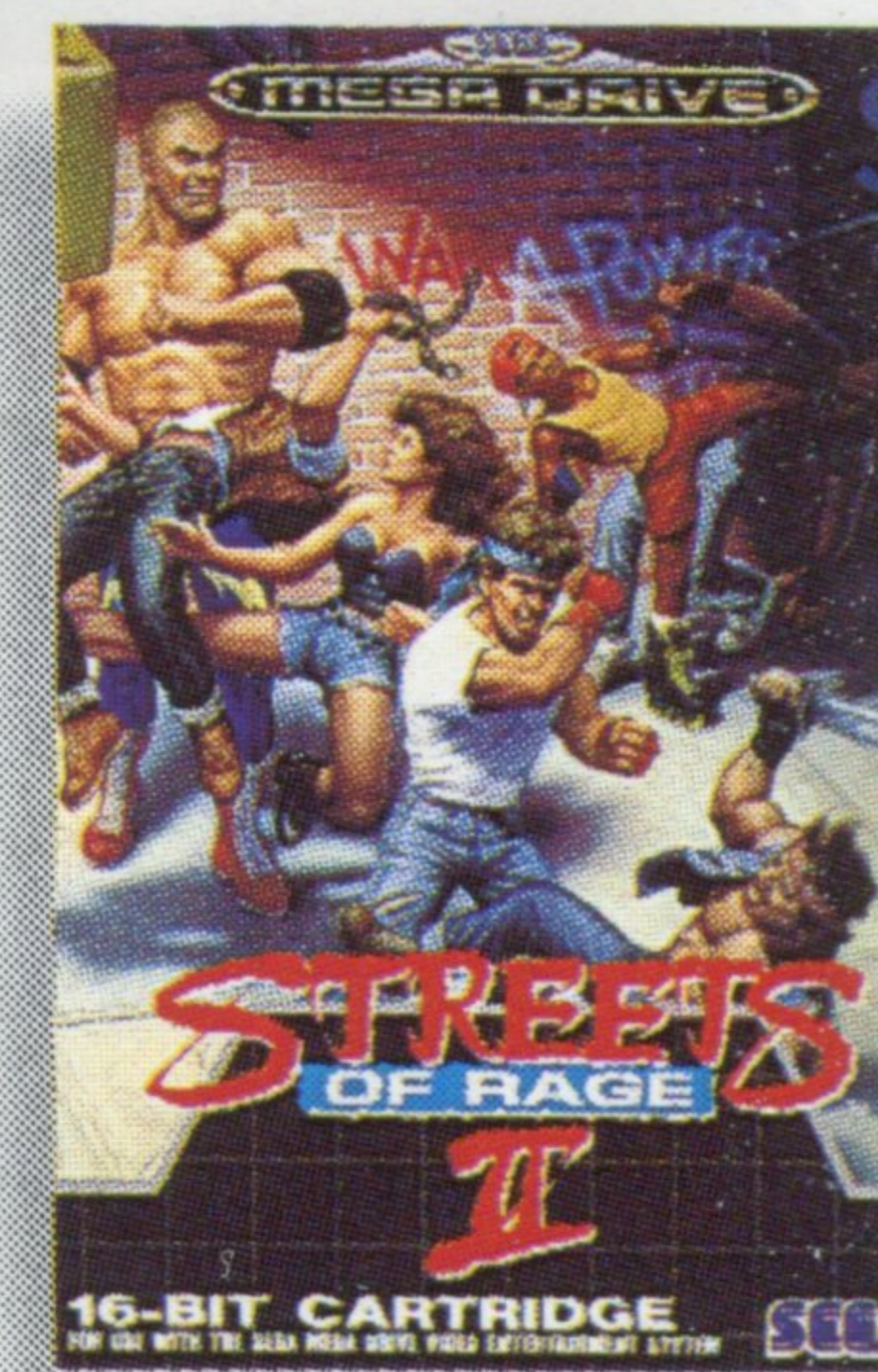


Some great games came out this month, here's a look at just a few. These games will surely prove to any doubters that Sega games are fast becoming seriously arcade superior.

He's taken things too far, so grab a friend or go it alone and take him down once and for all. It's not going to be easy though because an army of bad guys stands in your way, and I mean an army.



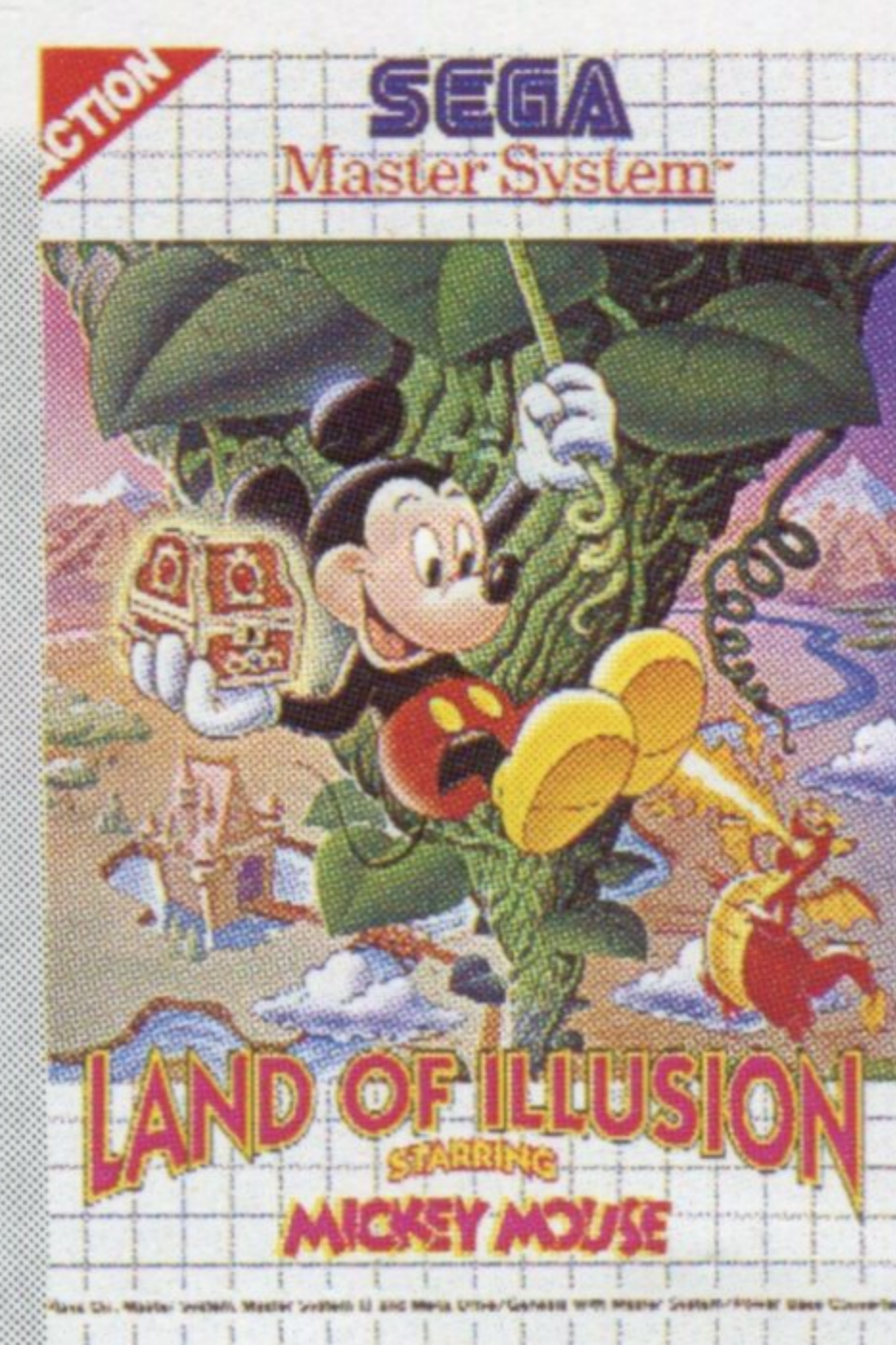

er System and just like the first it's hard to put down. This time Mickey wakes up and finds himself in the



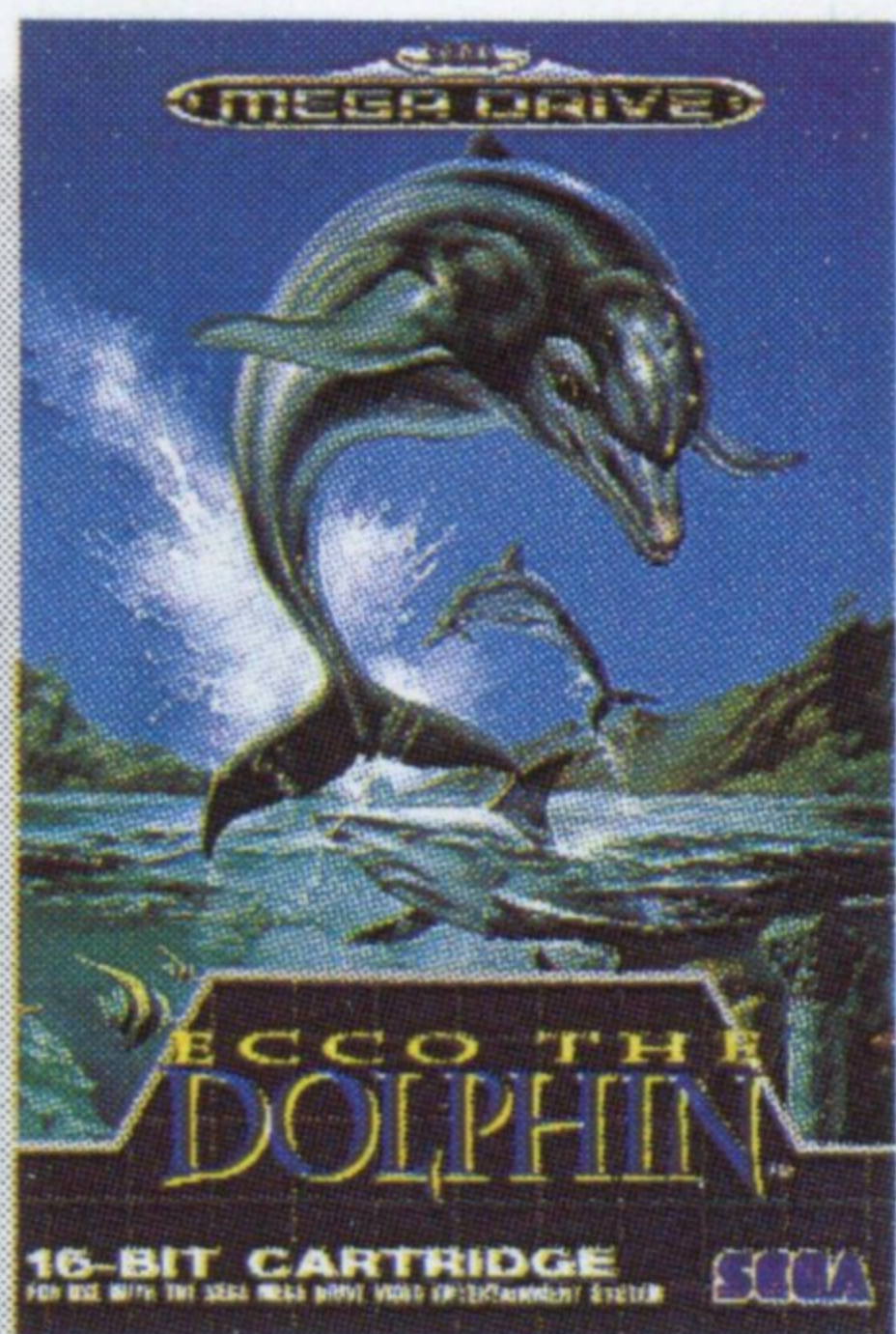

While playing Ecco can use his sonar to create a map which helps him search out precious pockets of air and hidden dangers. 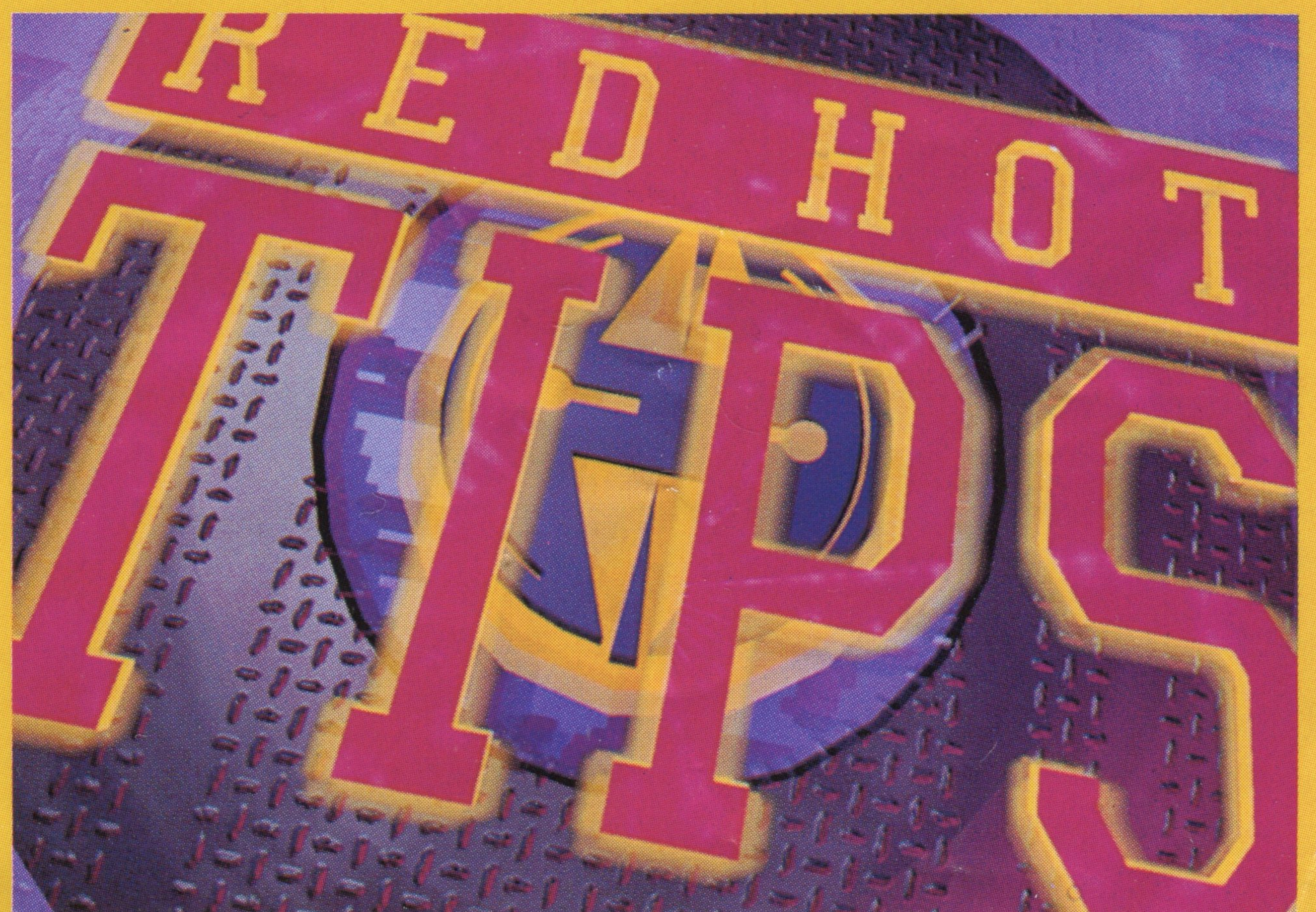
