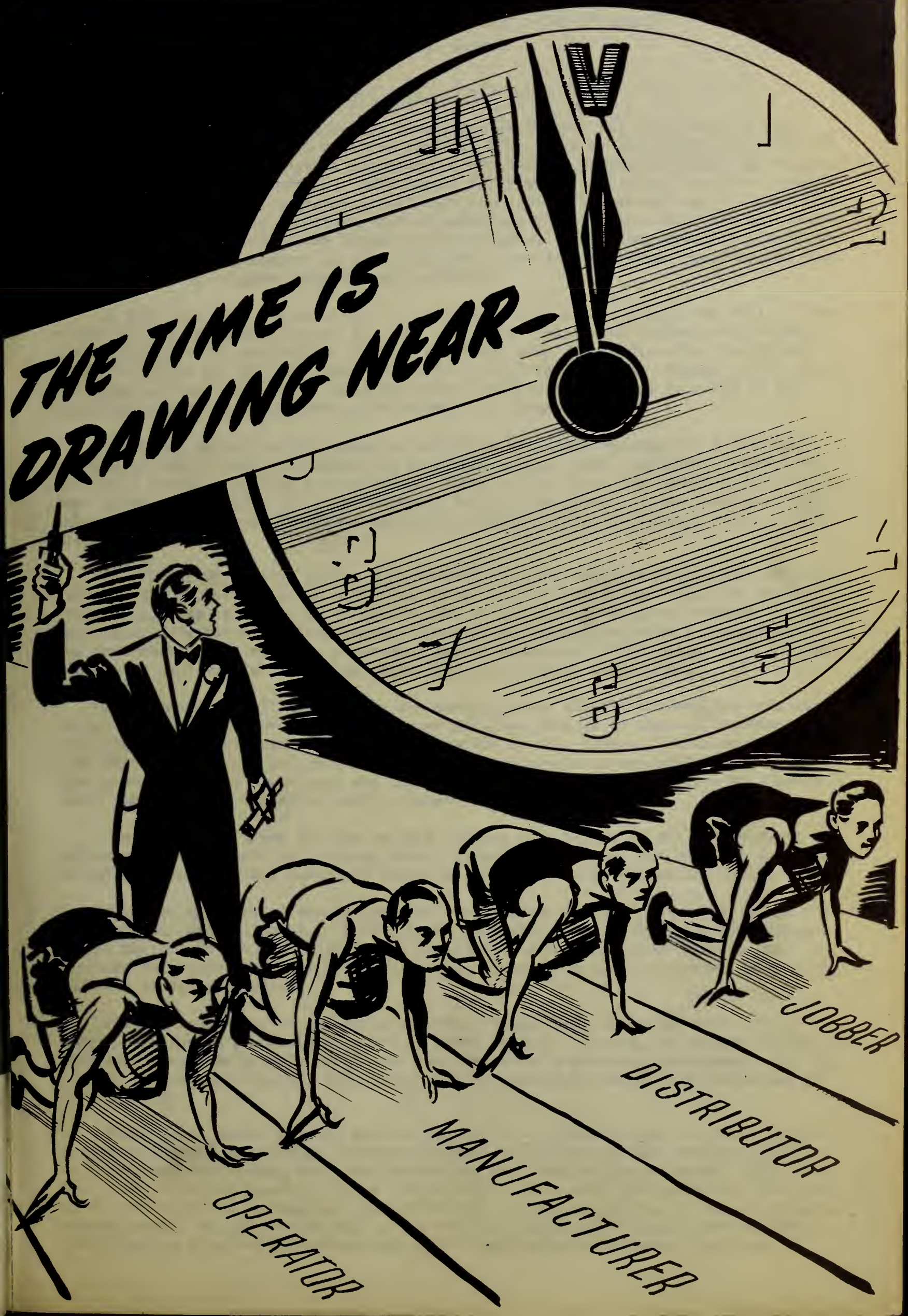






## "The Coin Machines Merry-Go-Round"

### THE TIME IS DRAWING NEAR.



Great stimulus has been effected thruout all industries by the "spot authorization plan" of WPB, which is the fourth step toward the peacetime reconversion preparation program of Donald M. Nelson, WPB Chairman. SWPC (Small War Plants Corporation) has also vigorously injected itself into the picture to protect small plants from being shouldered out of materials (if and when there are any available) by the larger industrialists. This plan, becoming effective on August 15, opens the door to earlier peacetime reconversion than a great many thought possible.

As yet this does not mean that reconversion to peacetime production will go into effect on, or even near, August 15. The list of 125 essential products which small plants can offer to manufacture is only the first step in the direction to prepare these factories for the necessary return to a peacetime program. The fact that manufacturers are now allowed to experiment with products they intend to build in the post-war period, is considered an achievement in itself.

Procuring materials with which to construct peacetime products is a tremendous problem in itself. Such raw materials as steel, copper, zinc, aluminum, rubber, etc. are still vitally required for war work. Therefore suffice it to state - the door has been opened just a tiny bit to allow small industry to glance at the possibility of earlier reconversion to peacetime production than was believed possible even a month ago.

No manufacturer would bid so high on war work, nor would he neglect his present war products production in an effort to be among the first to get back into peacetime production. The best plan is to assume that an invitation has been extended by which the possibility for an earlier return to peacetime production becomes a surety. No war work should, nor will any government agency (especially WPB) allow it to be neglected, to make way for reconversion to domestic products production.

In the meantime all this sudden and exciting news vitally affects the coin machines industry. In the first place, used machines because of lack of manufacture have risen to prices formerly thought impossible by this trade. Yet there is no doubt that OPA's program and policies for manufacturers as well as merchandisers when peacetime production once again does get under way, will be to control prices at a point where the threat of inflation will be remote.

Therefore this trade is more or less assured that prices of the new post-war machines will be retained at a normal level, allowing of course, the need for a 25% or so increase in labor and materials costs, which this wartime period has brought about.

Nor does the average manufacturer or merchandiser believe that labor unions will stop at their present point. It is a known fact that most of the unions are championing at the bit to get even higher wage scales into effect for their members prior to a return to peacetime production. This again is bound to bring a further labor cost increase to all production.

This industry must therefore be prepared to pay from 25% to 35% more for the same type machines it purchased prior to Pearl Harbor. It must, to prepare itself for this increase, also arrange to assure itself a better percentage arrangement with its average locations. This has been urged upon the trade for many, many months now by The Cash Box.

There is no doubt that the average man in this industry cannot continue to operate after the war on the same business basis as he has during this wartime period. With new equipment coming into the picture and with this equipment coming in at what will prove to be increasingly rapid intervals, the necessity for purchasing more and still more machines to maintain himself in face of the competition he is sure to get, and which will be keener than any he has ever yet faced, will necessitate the need for arranging a better percentage commission basis with his average locations.

That is why The Cash Box has been urging the trade to adopt its proposed 70%-30% commission basis. The average location deserves no more than 30% commission from any machine. This percentage arrangement (70% to the operator and 30% to the location owner) is only one of the needs sponsored by The Cash Box during this wartime period. There are also other necessities which should be put into effect prior to the opening of the post-war era.

The need for a National Coin Machines Credit Bureau has long been admitted by all engaged in this industry. Perhaps for a year or so after production once again gets under way, the trade will not need any credit arrangements. This will be due to the fact that enough financial reserve has been accumulated by the average business man so that he can maintain a cash purchase basis.

But after that period there will most certainly be a need for some sort of Credit Bureau. There is no doubt that once again distributors and jobbers will have to extend credit to operators. These men feel that if they offer risk money they should most definitely enjoy a percentage of interest on that credit in keeping with the risk taken. Certainly no financial organization will lend money without obtaining a goodly percentage of interest on its loans.

The same therefore applies to those distributors and jobbers who will be loaning money on equipment which is considered too risky for the average financier to handle. As for example: slots, consoles, pin games, etc., etc. In fact, all equipment where the possibility of legal interference is always prominent.

A Credit Bureau is therefore a necessity so that the average operator can be assured the credit he will need. At the same time the average distributor and jobber will be in position to know just whom to give credit to and how much. This National Coin Machines Credit Bureau, as proposed by The Cash Box almost from the day of its inception would be able to give all inner industry credit information. This is something that is also a great necessity. It would equal, as a service, what all other leading industries offer their trade members.

A School for Coin Machine Mechanics is now becoming of uppermost importance. This was suggested by The Cash Box a few months ago and captured the imagination and assent of everyone of the outstanding men in this industry. It is one need that everyone will most surely agree to. It is one necessity that will help make the greater growth of this industry a surety. This is, therefore, the time to arrange for a School for Coin Machine Mechanics.

In this past week's issue, and for two years now, The Cash Box has also been urging the creation of a National Coin Machines Tax Council. Not only to offset the "tax plague" which is currently biting into this trade, but to also be prepared for the future, when such a Council will prove of even greater worth.

There is no doubt that post-war tax legislators, when they see the large amount of new coin operated equipment suddenly appearing thruout the country, will most eagerly prepare to foist more and greater taxation upon this industry. Communities everywhere feel they will need even greater revenue in the post-war period, in view of the fact that so much new public works has gathered up on them. At the same time many communities are preparing elaborate public works programs because they feel that this will help offset any possible unemployment period for the returning soldiers, as well as for the masses of war workers, who all look forward to short or long layoff periods while reconversion of the larger industries is in progress.

All the suggestions and proposals of The Cash Box now become even more important and more prominently highlighted as the time draws ever nearer to a return to peacetime production. Certainly no one will deny that a National Coin Machines Board of Trade which would incorporate a Public Relations Bureau, and many other agencies of truly progressive worth, which have also been advanced from time to time by The Cash Box, is now also needed.

What a few months ago seemed to still be far distant, is today becoming an ever closer reality. There is therefore no doubt anymore that this industry must throw all its might and its energies into planning to be ready for the dawn of the post-war period.

The Cash Box is not interested in bringing too much new blood into this business. In fact, it is not interested in seeing any new blood come into this industry for at least 18 to 24 months after peacetime production becomes a fact.

The reason is that The Cash Box believes those men who worked so hard and so valiantly to maintain this industry and be its backbone for the post-war period during this wartime era, should be the first to receive consideration from the manufacturers

and should be allowed to completely prepare themselves first for the post-war era, in thanks for the marvelous efforts they displayed in keeping this industry so much alive during this wartime period.

The Cash Box will therefore remain off newstands and away from cigar, candy and drug store counters. It will continue to confine itself exclusively and confidentially to this industry, and this industry only. It will continue to help those men who did so outstanding a job during this wartime period, to enjoy the fruits of their labors when peacetime production becomes fact.

The Cash Box therefore urges those men, so that they may assure themselves the greatest possible success in the post-war period, that they adopt the suggestions and proposals which The Cash Box outlined for them since its inception.

## JOBBER AND DISTRIBUTORS RECOGNITION BUREAU

In keeping with the foregoing, and to help the trade properly prepare itself for the entrance of the post-war period, there is no doubt that the survey made by The Cash Box, a little less than a year ago, to help determine a standard for jobber and distributor recognition, should now be given its full and due consideration by all those in this industry who desire to remain, or to enter into, the sales division of this trade.

There has been much controversy among the members of the jobbing and distributing ranks of this business for a great many years as to just who was, and who was not, a member of their division of this field. Many times jobbers and distributors, who had entered into this field solely and explicitly for the purpose of conducting a wholesale business, found that among their customers were coinmen who received the same prices and the same advantages as they did.

This tended to create a lack of respect and faith in the wholesale division of this industry. It is a well known fact that the average large sized operator believes now, and believed then, that because of the volume of purchasing he could do then and can do now that he is entitled to "wholesale" prices. This is one of the most puzzling problems to be solved.

Many other internal factors also made themselves prominent in the wholesale ranks in pre-war days. Cutting into each other's territories, especially when stuck with a number of "flop" machines. Neglecting to give consideration to the man who was many hundreds of miles away and slicing prices where the games were received first so that the wholesaler in the smaller, rural communities found it unprofitable to continue. Obtaining equipment first, by being on the ground floor, and then shipping that equipment into other territory for a very small profit margin therefore, in most cases, upsetting a good market. These are only a few of the many abuses which made wholesaling a hazardous business and forced many wholesalers in self defense to enter into operating.

There was little respect then and very small prestige gained by the average man who entered himself into the wholesale ranks of this industry.- simply by renting a store, putting up a good deposit, and making a public announcement of this fact.

The music distributors, because their factories recognized their importance, won prestige and respect from the trade and could continue on in profitable fashion. Most of the merchandise machine manufacturers arranged their own sales forces to cover the nation. But when and where they appointed distributors, these wholesalers received the complete respect of the trade in their areas, for these manufacturers carefully protected and guided them. Both the music and merchandise distributors were therefore able to maintain efficient service and sales forces.

Branch office arrangements among certain jobbers and distributors were anything but welcome to others who had worked hard to build some area as a sales center, and find themselves suddenly faced by this sort of competition.

Therefore, in full benefit to the operators who will do the buying and who will want to have respect for and complete belief and faith in the wholesalers with whom they choose to deal, and at the same time, for the benefit of the jobbers and distributors themselves, so that they, too, will have some sort of Bureau to which they can appeal and bring their problems for fair and impartial solution - a Jobbers' and Distributors' Recognition Bureau - is certainly a necessity for the post-war era. This Bureau should be created now.

## MFRS NEED 2 YEARS TO FILL BACKLOG DEMAND

**Trade Leaders Believe More Than Two Years Required To Fill Present Backlog For New Equipment. Used Machines Market To Continue Prominent For That Period.**

NEW YORK—In reports received from leaders from all over the country and just compiled, the consensus is that more than two full years of complete all out production will be required from the manufacturers to fill the present backlog demand which has gathered up for new equipment of all types.

These leaders are also of the belief that in view of this fact, the used machines market will continue on as prominently as it has during this wartime period. None of these men are of the opinion that the trade will see any wholesale return to production of coin operated equipment this year.

They explain that the music machines market alone will require all out speed production of all the manufacturers engaged in this field to even fill the needs of the men now engaged in this business. They claim that additional return of former music machine men and also entrance of new blood will zoom demand even beyond the point now apparent.

Amusement machines men are of the belief that regardless of full time all out production on the part of the amusement machine manufacturers, they will need much more than two years to fill demand they now have. Some of these leaders claim that they can take complete factory production for months and not completely fill orders they can obtain overnight by phone. They state that in addition change of models will be required and that this will greatly hinder speed production.

Analysis of the entire situation, regardless of WPB's announcement of the possibility of return to peacetime production by those factories who have the manpower and materials available in their area and will not in any fashion whatsoever affect the war effort, is that the used machines market will continue on as prominent as ever even while new machines production is in process.

## POST-WAR CIVILIAN DEMAND 102 BILLION

BOSTON, MASS.—Demand for civilian consumer goods will probably reach over \$102,000,000,000 in the first year after the war, giving business its first \$100,000,000,000 year in this category alone, according to Sumner H. Slichter, Economics Professor at Harvard University.

In addition, industry may find it necessary to spend 75 billions of dollars building up plant and equipment to meet unprecedented demands for a multitude of items shunted aside during this war.

Professor Slichter explained that one of the favorable items was the huge amount of monies now in savings banks. He also stated that business has accumulated over 34 billions of dollars in liquid assets during these three past years. He expressed the view that 20 million to 22 million persons could be absorbed into the labor market after the war without upsetting the national economy.

As an indication of the size of the post-war market he said there would be a national shortage of 3,500,000 vacuum cleaners, 7,500,000 electric clocks, 20,000,000 radios, 5,000,000 electric refrigerators, 10,000,000 irons, 3,000,000 washers and 4,500,000 electric toasters.

This huge labor market of 20,000,000 to 22,000,000 bodes extreme good play for the coin machines industry as well as continued profitable action because of the huge expenditures that will come with such a labor force.

PHILADELPHIA, PA.—Roy Torr, noted merchandise machine distributor, this city, offers a name for this trade which he believes will fill the bill, and which will eventually become closely associated with all in this business.

"At the same time," Roy states, "Horn & Hardart's Automat restaurants have spent a lot of money selling the people on 'Automat Restaurant' and not 'slot machine restaurant'."

The name Roy suggests for this industry is, "Automat industry."

## 2 MILLION NEW CARS

WASHINGTON, D. C. — About half as many autos as were being produced in this country before the war will be authorized for manufacture as soon as Germany falls, and they will go on sale to motorists at prices about 25 percent above pre-war levels.

WPB will propose to the auto industry a slash of 50 percent in output. 2,000,000 new cars will probably be allowed for the first year's production.
