

# LET'S FACE THE MUSIC

## Representative Charles A. Buckley's Bill now in the Patent Committee of the House of Representatives in Washington can K.O. the Juke Box Industry.

Ever since The Cash Box brought into the open the many problems affecting the present relationship between the coin operated music machines industry and the recording companies, leaders thruout the trade have vigorously entered into this demand for more equitable distribution and for a better business understanding between the juke box men and the record manufacturers.

### THE PRESENT RECORD LABEL

From the very start of its campaign The Cash Box has brought to the attention of the juke box industry that the records it is, and was, purchasing were definitely not for coin operated music machines. These records, each and everyone of them, carry the following printed statement on their labels:

*"Only for non-commercial use for phonographs in homes. The manufacturer's original purchaser agrees this record shall not be resold nor used for any other purpose."*

Note that by this statement the record manufacturer not only covers himself, as far as the juke box operator is concerned, but also protects himself as far as his own distributors and dealers are concerned. At least those of his distributors and dealers who may sell his records to juke box operators. In short, the record manufacturer sells the juke box operator records which he knows are not meant for the operator's use. And perhaps this is why he is driving so hard to extend and increase his sales to the home market.

### WILL PAY EXTRA FOR LABEL CHANGE

The Cash Box, during its battle to bring about more equitable record distribution to the juke box industry, has asked, time and time again, that the record manufacturers arrange to have their labels changed to include the following phrase:

*"For use in coin operated music machines."*

The Cash Box believes that the juke box men would be happy to pay an extra charge for the use of this sort of phrase on the records which they are now purchasing, and by the way, which they are popularizing for the record manufacturers to help them to enjoy greater sales and prosperity. The record manufacturers could probably, because of their close connection with the artists and publishers, arrange to make this charge an extremely reasonable one.

But just as The Cash Box continued to fight and to warn this trade that something should be done in this direction and as rapidly as possible, surely before the new post-war phonographs come into being, and so that no further obstacles would be placed in the path of progress which the juke box industry is sure to travel during the post-war period, this, too, has gone unheeded.

The record manufacturers have continued to do business with the very men whose throats they were cutting everytime they sold them such a recording, and all the time they continued to protest that they were "cooperating" with the juke box industry to the fullest degree.



## **“The Coin Machines Merry-Go-Round”**

### **REP. BUCKLEY'S BILL THE CLIMAX**

Now the entire situation comes to a grand climax. Representative Charles A. Buckley of the State of New York, in the House of Representatives at Washington, D.C., introduced a bill to amend the Copyright Act of 1909. This bill specifically states that juke boxes are giving a public performance for profit. (Exactly what ASCAP has been contending right along.)

This simply means that the records which the juke boxes are now featuring are being used for commercial purposes—for earning profits. (And this is what these records are NOT to be used for according to their labels.) Therefore, the juke box, under this contention by Representative Charles A. Buckley in his bill, is no different than any nite club where singers get out on the floor and sing copyrighted songs. Such nite spots must pay a yearly license fee to ASCAP for this privilege.

### **A YEARLY JUKE LICENSE**

This again means that the juke box, should this amendment become law, after passing the House and the Senate, will have to pay a yearly license fee to ASCAP for the privilege of using their copyrighted music which the juke box is playing for profit. And this even after the fact that ASCAP has been defeated two or three times in this country and once before in Canada by music coinmen when they made attempts to collect a license fee for this very reason from the juke boxes. ASCAP can then, BY FEDERAL LAW, obtain a yearly license fee from each and every juke box in the nation.

And the amount of that license fee would be entirely dependent upon ASCAP. Of course, the fee could not be confiscatory. Tho there is no one to state that ASCAP cannot ask as high as \$100.00 per year license fee or more from each juke box, and allow the courts to decide whether or not such an amount is confiscatory.

This would actually mean a series of law suits all over the nation. Operators in territories where the take is low, would be forced to go to court in an attempt to prove that the fee being asked was confiscatory and thereby plead with the court to have ASCAP set a lower license fee for them.

It is well known thruout the music trade that ASCAP cast jealous eyes at the victories won by Petrillo and were especially upset over the monies he is now collecting from the record manufacturers. Even at only \$10.00 per year license per juke box, should ASCAP decide that this was sufficient, the total would amount to many millions of dollars per year. And this would only be a beginning.

### **MUSIC PUBLISHERS WANT MORE ROYALTIES**

What about the music publishers? They, too, for years have been saying that they haven't been getting a fair share of the royalties from each record which juke box men were using. They, too, want more than they are getting at this time.

Then why shouldn't the music publisher, the man who actually owns and publishes the song, get a bigger royalty from the record manufacturers? Why not? And why not also add this additional royalty onto the cost of the record which the juke box operator has to buy? Why not?

### **NEW JUKE BOX RECORD LABEL**

It also means that at last, after all these months of fighting, should the Buckley amendment become law, that the record manufacturers will have to create separate and distinct labels for the records they sell to the coin operated music machines industry. The very thing they won't do now. The very thing The Cash Box has been fighting for to protect the juke box men. But, such labels will now cost this industry plenty of cash. They will eat deep into profits. They will tremendously increase overhead.

### **NEW COMMISSION BASIS NECESSARY**

And it also means that the urgent suggestion offered to this industry more than two years ago by The Cash Box that juke box operators arrange for a new commission basis of 70% of the entire collection for themselves and 30% to the storekeeper, will simply have to become fact, or the average juke box man will be operating without any real profit. That, too, will at last have to come into being. But it will come into being by forced action—the hard way.

### **GREATER GENERAL TAXATION, TOO**

The juke box industry has been fighting attempts to heavily tax it for the past five years all over the nation. In almost every state, these past years, bills were proposed that not only asked for higher license fees per year, but many also asked for a percentage of the gross collections. This latter percentage demand was overcome in almost all instances. But some of these bills are still pending, and will be brought to light when these state legislatures meet again.

### **MUST FIGHT NOW**

Therefore, with obstacle after obstacle being thrown into the path of an industry which gives promise of entering into an era of its greatest growth and progress, a halt to much of this growth and progress may

ensue, unless the members of this juke box trade, everyone of the operators, jobbers, distributors and manufacturers enter into this battle in Washington, and do the very same thing to this amendment which the lobby of the motion picture industry has already done.

### **FILMS GET EXEMPTED**

The film people obtained a special "exemption" in this proposed Buckley amendment. They claimed that if the picture was copyrighted then the music was copyrighted. It seems that the sponsor of this bill agreed to this. Therefore music on film in the motion pictures will not also have to undergo the extra licensing which juke boxes will be forced to endure.

### **NO ONE TO DEFEND JUKE BOX MEN**

Now the Buckley bill is completely directed at the juke box industry. And there is no one in Washington at this time to ask for and obtain an exception to this bill. There is no group representative of the nation's juke box business to fight with cold and hard facts. (And everyone knows that adding more overhead onto the operation of juke boxes is not the way to help the industry to greater progress and growth.)

### **RECORD LABEL CHANGE IMPERATIVE**

Furthermore, should the industry's leaders rush on to Washington, and should they be successful in also gaining an exception to this Buckley bill, **THEY CANNOT STOP THERE ANYMORE.** Now they definitely must get to the record manufacturers and arrange with them to change the reading on the record labels so that the juke box industry will be protected in the future. **AND THIS CAN BE DONE.**

If the average juke box operator has to pay a few cents more for the record he purchases, whereon the label will read that this record can be played in coin operated phonographs, he is more than willing to do so. But he cannot be left to the mercy of such organizations as ASCAP and MPPA wherein these people can arrange for yearly license fees and royalties and annually change their minds and fight for more and still more money from the juke boxes, thereby creating a situation wherein the juke box owner is actually no longer in control of the overhead of his business.

### **INDUSTRY MUST ORGANIZE**

The entire juke box industry, this great and leading division of the coin operated machines business, must now organize itself as a team to fight for its right to bring the public what the public wants, without being taxed and surtaxed again and again for the right to do so.

The Cash Box has been urging the creation of a National Board of Trade for this industry. It has also been asking for the creation of a National Tax Council, a National Credit Bureau, a Public Relations Bureau, a School for Coin Machine Mechanics, and many other necessities, simply to help better the future growth and progress of this industry. Such organizations would now be in a position to help this trade overcome such proposed amendments which are so completely against its future welfare.

### **MUST ACT QUICK**

There must be no more time lost. The Buckley bill has been in the House of Representatives for about a month. It is now in the Patents Committee of the House. It is being carefully studied. It seems that there is extremely favorable feeling regarding its passage. This industry must organize itself rapidly. It must get right down to Washington and lobby for its rights. And it must do so now.

### **REVIEW**

Once again, here's a review of what can happen, before any juke box men are lulled into a sense of security, into the idea of "let the other man do it". ASCAP can, and probably will, demand that they receive anywhere from \$10.00 to \$100.00 or more yearly license per phonograph. The music publishers can, and probably will, demand that they, too, receive greater royalties for their songs.

The record firms will be forced to pay these higher royalties. This means that records to operators will be much higher priced than they are at the present time. It also means that every juke box in the nation, regardless of what attempts may be made to bootleg records, will be enduring tremendously increased overhead. And to such an extent that in many cases the profit factor will be so slimmed down that operation may prove anything but profitable.

## SENATORS INVESTIGATING OPA

WASHINGTON - Senator Homer E. Capehart (R., Ind.) and Senator Tydings (D. Md.) have just asked for an investigation of the price fixing policies of the Office of Price Administration. The two senators introduced a resolution for an investigation, not only of OPA, but also of the office of Economic Price Stabilization.

Capehart, in a Senate Speech, said that present price fixing policies can determine whether the nation can achieve its post-war goals of full employment, high wages, profits for farmers and business interests, a sound national financial policy and the maintenance of the private enterprise system.

Capehart said issues to be determined by the investigation would include: 1) Whether the OPA bases its methods on its own notions of limiting profits or on the requirements of the price control act that maximum prices will be generally fair and equitable. 2) Whether OPA price fixing method which require the absorption of increases are squeezing wholesalers out of business. 3) Whether OPA methods are based on the real facts of current costs of material and labor. 4) Whether OPA methods are stifling production and producing unemployment.

## WANTS GAMES LICENSED

LOUISVILLE, KY. - The public's attitude in regard to pins and slots was expressed in an item from a reader which appeared in the Louisville Courier-Journal on July 4. The reader is Buck Roberts of Pleasantville, Ky., who wrote the editor of the Courier-Journal as follows: "Since the State is in need of money why not license the slot and pin-ball machines? They are being operated all over the country and the Government gets nothing out of them. I do not see any more harm in playing these machines than I do in playing the horses."

## BOWLING 'EM OVER

NEW YORK - Reports just received from seashore and mountain resort coinmen to the effect that bowling alleys are getting a terrific play this season. Coinmen claim that never before in history have the crowds patronized the bowling alleys as well as they are at this time. One resort op claims that his collections have jumped over 150% on his bowling alleys this season, and are still on the way up.

Claims are to the effect that the new innovations incorporated into the games at this time are what jumped play action. The colorful features built into these machines by the revampers are said to have brought new life to the bowling alleys and the players are flocking to them wherever they are placed.

Also interesting is the fact that there has been a big increase in the manufacture of these machines with many noted firms in the trade now building bowling alleys of one kind or another.
