THE NEW TAXES

The glad tidings were received at the last minute one week ago Saturday that the Senate speeded thru the big 1942 revenue bill. According to all reports at hand at this moment - the amendment that provides that trade-stimulating machines will pay \$10. per year, has won tremendous approval from all. This means the re-birth of the counter games. There are at this writing thousands of these great, little monomakers buried away in jobbers' show-rooms in operator's warehouses waiting to get back on locations where they have many times doubled their cost. If all this stands up when we get the final dope then it means that pin games will pay only \$10. per year as well as counter games with phonos also in for \$10. per year. The \$100. tax for slot machines and gaming devices will remain. Now the word is that diggers (which were reported to be in the \$10 category) will come into the \$100. classification. The final action of the joint committee will have to be awaited and so until then let's keep cheerful for it sure looks like no one in the coinbiz is really going to be hurt by the new taxes.

N.Y. TIMES ON PETRILLO

Said the New York Times in an editorial on Judge Barnes' curt dismissal of injunction asked by D. of J. on Petrillo's A.F.M.: "The Dept. of Justice is correct in declaring that Mr. Petrillo's policy in times of unemployment attempts to force employers and the consuming public to pay for a private system of unemployment relief, while in times of rising employment it tries to relieve members of the union from the competitive necessity of learning how to do a different kind of job. Hundreds of thousands of workers in other lines are now being forced to change the nature of their work. Why should musicians alone be exempt? At a time when people are being forced to give up civilian services that they really want, why should they be forced to employ civilian services that they do not want?... Once the country has clarified its mind on this subject it should not be difficult to change the state of law that makes Mr. Petrillo's private dictatorship possible".

MORE ON PETRILLO

This is one matter that musicops (who have been frightened by Judge Barnes' curt dismissal of D. of J. injunction) should not believe for one moment is simply of interest to them alone...or even to musicians only. If Petrillo can get away with this one, every union in the country will attempt the same and make consuming public pay for private unemployment relief. This case goes far beyond the pale of coinphonos or radio transcripts. Every large employer is watching this case very carefully. Dept. of Justice is far from discouraged because of Judge Barnes' dismissal of injunction - as new action (actually aided by Judge Barnes) on part of Thurman Arnold indicates. D. of J. will put everything it has into winning this case - otherwise there will result the greatest labor union upheaval in all American history. P.S. (Conversations with music publishers and "off-the-record" confabs with record executives indicates that whatever happens records will continue to be made. Bitter as the pill may be to swallow, the record companies will accept a compromise with Petrillo if they have to.)

5 TIRES

Your passenger car can now only have 5 tires. If you have any more, these must be sold to U.S., O.P.A. announced. Ceiling prices will be paid promptly for the extra tires, new or used, and trucks of Railway Express Agency will call at your home and pick up tires free of charge to you - to take them to designated warehouses where they will be appraised and a check, war bond or stamps will be mailed to you in payment. Gasoline ration cards will be issued to private passenger cars only after serial numbers of all tires have been listed and you certify you have no more than 5 tires for your car. (In the East, where gas ration books have already been issued, this certification will be necessary for continued use of these books.) Falsification of the tire statement carries a penalty of \$10,000. fine and a maximum prison sentence of 10 years. Retail ceiling will be paid for tires turned in. Remember - this ruling applies to passenger cars only.

ARCADE LAWS

In Cincinnati someone dug deep down into archives and produced a \$100. per day license ruling. In Detroit there is question whether the license need be taken out at all because of the type equipment

being used - especially where no rifle range with bullets are used. Before signing a lease and spending money to renovate and outfit spot - have a capable attorney check deeply into city's laws - or some politico may suddenly shake you down to your boots - after lease is signed.

WHAT'S A POLITICIAN?

Time magazine (Oct. 12 issue) dug up some cute ones concerning just what a politician is: Writes Wm. Shakospeare in Hamlet: "A politician...one that would circumvent God." Said Wendell Philips in 1864, "Politicians are like the bones of a horse's foreshoulder not a straight one in it." And Francis Bacon in 1605 had this definition: "It is as hard and severe a thing to be a true politician as to be truly moral." Aristotle in 350 B.C. stated, "The good of man must be the end of the science of politics." and the famous Horace Greeley stated in 1860, "I never said all Democrats were saloonkeepers. What I said was all saloonkeepers are Democrats." And Otto Von Bismarck in 1863 had this wry expression to make: "Politics is not an exact science."

SMALL BUSINESS

U.S. Dept. of Commerce estimates that only groceries, restaurants, bars and liquor stores will escape a constantly dwindly volume of sales among retailers. This again proves the tremendous importance of coin machines for retail outfits to help maintain them for the duration.

CELLAR & ATTIC

Watch for the op who will bring the next big hit to the trade. Because of desperate need for some change in his equipment to help stimulate and retain play action, some unknown little op will be the one who (in his cellar or attic workshop) will make the change or complete changeover or revamp some game - that will be the basis for the "big idea" of tomorrow. That's how all great games were born. It's the old, old adage about "necessity being the mother of invention" - which has always been the prod to get the progressive man to using the grey matter with which he was gifted to develop the products necessary to his continued good welfare. (Encourage these boys, even if their ideas seem screwy to you. Always test them out on location.)

PINBALL

Pinball demand is growing greater every day. Latest models have disappeared. Many others of later category are fast disappearing, being grabbed by those who have faith, while others linger in doubt. Even the old games are now getting attention from the trade. Many are arranging for revamps. Work now being done by the revamp factories is winning a tremendous amount of praise everywhere. Watch pinball demand grow even greater - reaching its apex sometime early spring of '43 - when even the oldest type games will be dragged from cellars and placed on locations.

PHONOS

Demand for phonos has not slackened one bit. Contrariwise it has increased. With this division now the backbone of the industry - outranking even the vending machine in its stability and international recognition and most certainly in profits - phono prices will go even higher and will prove answer to continuing leadership as soon as record problem is ironed out. Once this record problem is settled (and this is not too far away) upswing will be so prominent (because of national publicity) that it will zoom phonos to greatest heights in history. This national publicity will be the greatest free national advertising campaign that phonos will ever or could ever possibly get. It will affect public to point where greater interest in phonos will result.

SLOTS

Slot ops report that placement of machines at present rate can be attributed to demand from locations themselves - than from any other factor. Location owners, with their ordinary business at dangorously low ebb as far as obtaining regular merchandise is concerned, are paying overhead with slots. This fact is realized by city, state and national officials. To maintain themselves for the duration retailers will demand coin-games and will battle local politicians who will attempt to stop them from getting these because coingames are now vitally necessary to their business continuance.

PROPHETS

A great many coinmen seem to suddenly (and from out of nowhere) developed a prophetic streak. It is interesting (naturally) to listen to both the pessimist and the optimist among these prophets. The greater majority tend to be optimistic (which is as it should be) yet a certain minority have come to the fore with a deep streak of pessimism predominating. "No more freight shipping", they say, "All games will be scrapped for their metal. No more records. The U.S. is going to close this business down so that people will instead buy more war bonds. Etc., etc., etc." Some of them can even go on for hours. They have no definite facts to back them up. No facts on which they even base their prophecies. When pushed for their source of information their usual answer is that they know someone who knows someone who knows the brethor or uncle or aunt of someone who heard this somewhere. Next time one of these "new prophets" in coinbiz starts babbling away at you excitedly - insist on him giving you the facts and source of these facts. Or else, tell him to shut that big mouth of his from now on.

THE CREDIT BUREAU

One of our subscribers from Philadelphia surprised us on Tuesday by coming in to discuss our ideas about the Coin Machines Credit Clearing Bureau which we first proposed, after a ten year lapse, in our October 27 issue. We found this interested coinman unusually well versed in the intricacies of credit bureaus generally. "But", as he admitted to us, "in the coin machines business many different problems arise." The long and short of it is that this coinman traveled this distance to see us because he fully believed that a credit bureau was extremely essential to the good and welfare of all engaged in this industry.

In addition to this personal visit, we received many letters from subscribers everywhere in the country asking for further details. We have been extremely frank in the answers we sent these men. At present we feel that our subscribers should list their bad accounts (with complete data regarding these accounts) with us so that we can build our opening file as a "protective file" to benefit all subscribers. In short, by knowing these bad accounts we are able to protect others who may be contemplating deals with them.

The Cash Box has been acting as an "information center" ever since its inception. One Pacific Coast coinman (this past week) advised a New York advertiser that he could obtain the one-third deposit he required by coming over to our offices for he had mailed the money to The Cash Box, so that we would protect him. Another coinman from Charleston, W. Va. phoned us long distance (Wednesday) asking for information regarding an A.B.T. Rifle Range. Another from Norfolk, Va. phoned about obtaining .22 cal. shorts. And so it goes, all week long. In addition, coinmen constantly phone, wire and write us prior to sending deposits, whether the seller is trustworthy. This latter question is by far the one we have to answer most. That is why we now suggest a credit bureau so that we can make this sort of information more speedily available to all of our subscribers.

"The Cash Box is in a unique position to be of vital value to everyone of its subscribers," one leading coinman wrote us. We feel that one of the best ways we can help is the creation of the Coin Machines Credit Clearing Bureau. Subscribers will then have a central confidential point for all information necessary to their good and welfare. A few moments of your time now, listing your bad accounts, may save you hundreds of dollars at some later date.
