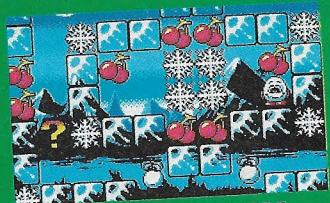

# CHAMPIONS

Sports fans may like to take a gander at **Champions**. Released by Krisalis, the package is a compilation containing three critically acclaimed sporting games. They are *Jahangir Khan World Championship Squash*, *Manchester United* and *World Championship Boxing Manager*.

**Champions** will be available on ST and Amiga at £19.99, the PC at £25.99 and the Commodore 64 at £11.99.



## ACTION SIXTEEN

During January Digital Integration is set to release four titles on its budget label, Action Sixteen. The first three will cost £7.99 and all feature different styles of gameplay.

**Jupiter's Masterdrive** is a manic one or two-player racing game, first released by UBI Soft.

**Sir Fred** combines hack 'n' slay action with arcade adventure as the

hapless knight, Sir Fred, attempts to save his true love from an ugly dwarf.

**Mystical** is a vertically-scrolling shoot'em-up and was originally released by Infogrames. It sees you assuming the guise of an apprentice sorcerer as you blast your way to greatness.

The final game, **Rotox**, will appear on the Action Sixteen Premier label and will cost £9.99. A superb puzzle-style game, Rotox was released to critical acclaim by US Gold in 1990.

## DRIFT

Keep your eyes peeled for Digital Integration's March release. Titled **Drift**, the game is a superb role-playing adventure that takes place within a range of planets, in a huge solar system.

Your objective is to combat crime and civil unrest by setting up your own military outfit. Various intriguing missions are set to test your skills and reactions. More news and pics as we get 'em.

# TOP LEAGUE COMPILATION

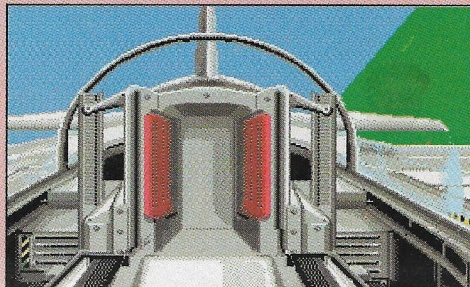
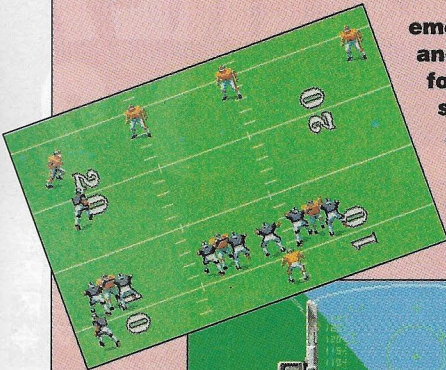
UBI Soft continues with its flair of putting together top quality compilations. This time it's the turn of the **Top League Compilation**, a package which boasts no less than five chart-topping games.

**Rick Dangerous 2** was programmed by Core Design and released on the Microstyle label. Featuring an Indiana Jones-style character this platform game soon became the benchmark for the entire platform genre.

Spectrum Holobyte's **Falcon** featured the combat avionics of the F-16, and with its link-up feature became a firm favourite. Mike Singleton and the Maelstrom team's **Midwinter** combined arcade-style simulations with intense strategy, to bring a new kind of adventure game to the home computer.

**Speedball 2** saw the re-emergence of the Bitmap Brothers with another brutal sports sim that set the pace for all that followed. Finally, **TV Sports Football** saw Cinemaware catapulted into the big time; a first-rate American football game it still ranks alongside the all-time greats.

The **Top League Compilation** is to be released by UBI Soft around Christmas time for the ST and Amiga, with the PC version to follow later in the year.



## WING COMMANDER II

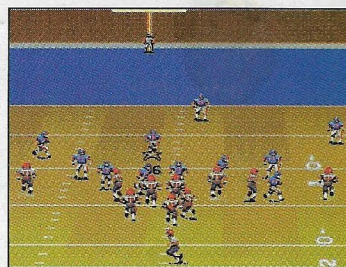
PC owners have been spotted drooling over Chris Roberts' **Wing Commander II**. Word has it that Origin and Mindscape have started on the Amiga version.

Whether this is the case is still to be confirmed. If it is true, Amiga owners can look forward to some real stunning graphics.

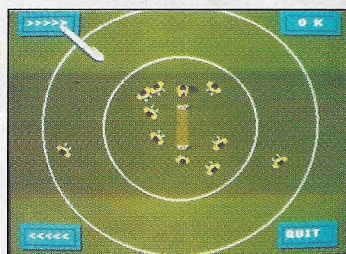
## JOHN MADDEN

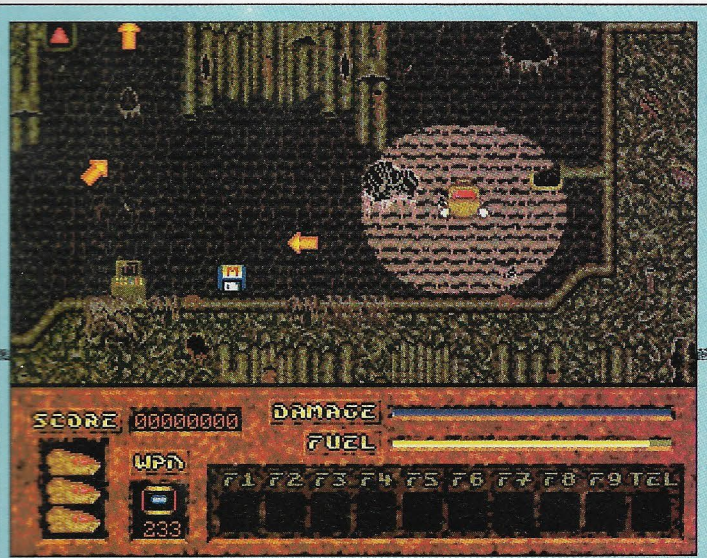

One such planet is Cavitas, a land ridden with strange caverns. As the first explorers discovered the planet they found themselves in the middle of a terrible meteor shower. Running for cover they hid inside a huge cave where they found remains of an ancient alien colony.

Their own craft was wrecked in the storm and so the settlers salvaged enough parts to make a single-seater ship. Now you must venture into the very heart of the planet in an attempt to uncover a means of escape. A huge shoot'em-up come exploration game, *Cavitas* will dock soon.

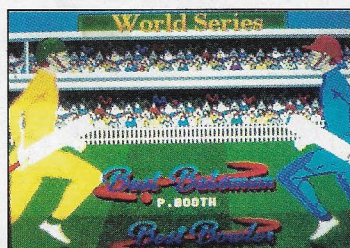
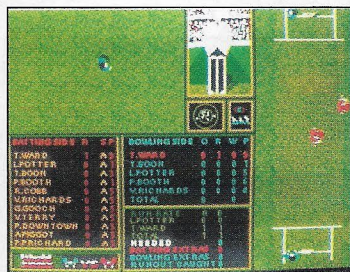
Following on from the success of its 1 meg cricket game, Soundware is set to release *World Cup Cricket*.

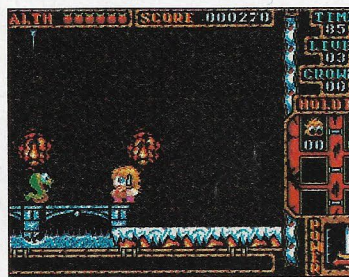


## KID GLOVES 2?

News has it that Millennium is planning to release *Kid Gloves 2* in the early part of next year. However, *Games-X* can reveal that this sequel is non other than *Little Beau* which was produced by Digital Magic and never released.

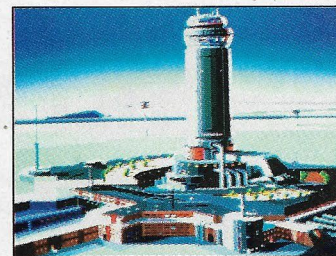
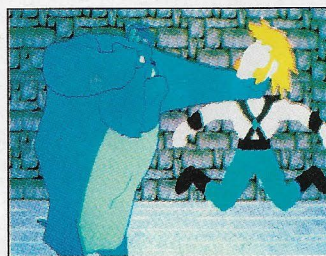
At present, you can win a *Lynx* on Radio 1's Jackie Brambles' Drive Time show, but that's only the tip of the iceberg. Atari has signed a deal with *Go Records* who publish for Jesus Jones, The Farm, Beautiful South and EMF who are all mad keen game's players, and at the February computer show, a different band will be appearing every day.

An indication of the growing popularity of the *Lynx* is that 50 percent of Atari's massive stand at the show will be designated to the hand held.

## ETERNAM

If you thought the highly-popular action adventure, *Drakkhen* was big, then you're going to be totally lost in the sequel, *Eternam*. Even by modern adventure standards *Eternam* is a huge world to explore. Gameplay is in the first person perspective in an amazing 3D environment.

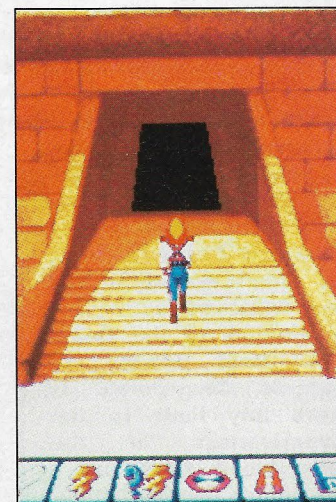
Technically, the game is remarkable with cartoon-quality animation and literally thousands of sprites moving across the landscape.



It is aimed primarily at an adult audience, which is highlighted by the curvacious and scantily clad Tracy – gosh these French game designers are naughty!

It's not a game which reaches out and grabs you in the first five minutes, but like the layers of an onion the engine slowly peels off to reveal various objectives and clues.

To be published in mid January, *Eternam* will first be on PC, with 16-bit versions being planned. It is also expected on CD.





# BULLFROG'S BOB

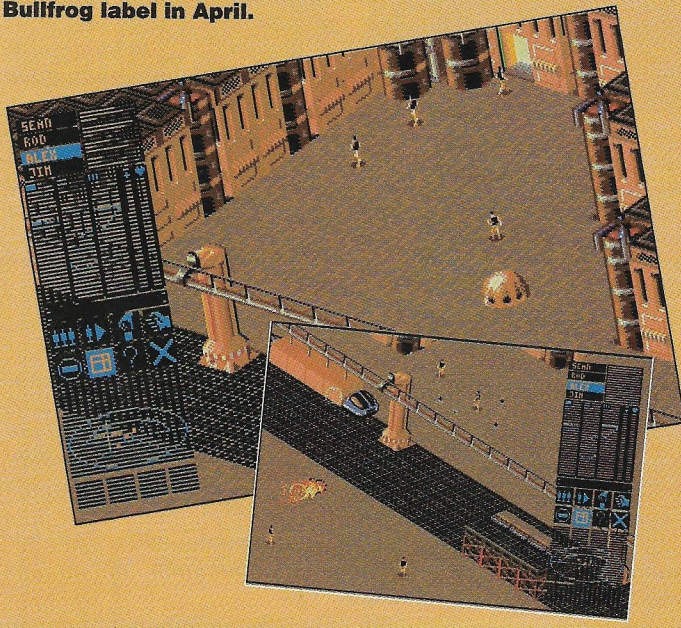
**B**ullfrog is turning its attention to what must be the most original game concept ever. The working title is simply 'Bob' and in a recent *Games-X* interview chief Bullfrog, Peter Mollineux described the game as "A genetic simulation."

Set in the near future, the game poses you as the head of a corporation that has developed computer chips which insert in the back of the head - don't try this at home children!

These chips contain programs such as 'Eternal Sunny Day' whereby a person can go around on a dull wet day thinking that he is basking in warmth and sunshine - hmm, could catch on!

Other chips place you in environments such as a rock concert or another is called Orgasm, which is pretty self explanatory, thank goodness! Your mission is to become the biggest commercial corporation in the world.

The game will be released on the Bullfrog label in April.



# TILT D'OR

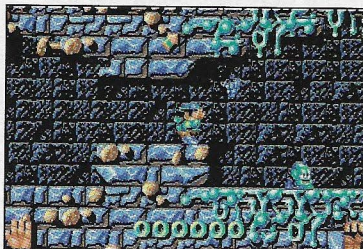
**T**he Tilt D'Or awards, some of the most prestigious in the French computer game industry, have just been announced.

Mindscape won Game of the Year with Wing Commander II, which also won most realistic Cinematic Style Game. Another victory from Mindscape was Magic Pockets, which was voted Platform Game of the Year.

Many of the awards were given to French designed games and the best car racing game category was won by Lankhor's Vroom.

Other awards to the Brits included Best Flight sim for EA's Chuck Yeagar. Domark's 3D Construction Kit won best Construction Program. Civilisation from Microprose won best Strategy Game - I didn't realise it had been released yet.

Shadow of the Beast won Best Floppy to Console Conversion. Is there any limit to the inventiveness of the categories? All in all a good show for the Brits.

**T**he Bitmap Brothers partnership with pop publishers Rhythm King Records has proved to be so successful, the Brothers are keen to make similar deals elsewhere in the world.

In Japan they are to release games in conjunction with PCM, a company known for bands like Tama Kabuki, Rocks, and the Bananarama of the Orient; the Go Bangs (whose rendition of the Locomotion defies belief).

Gods kicks off what's expected to be a series of sub-licences in Japan, including titles from the past and the future, such as Chaos Engine.

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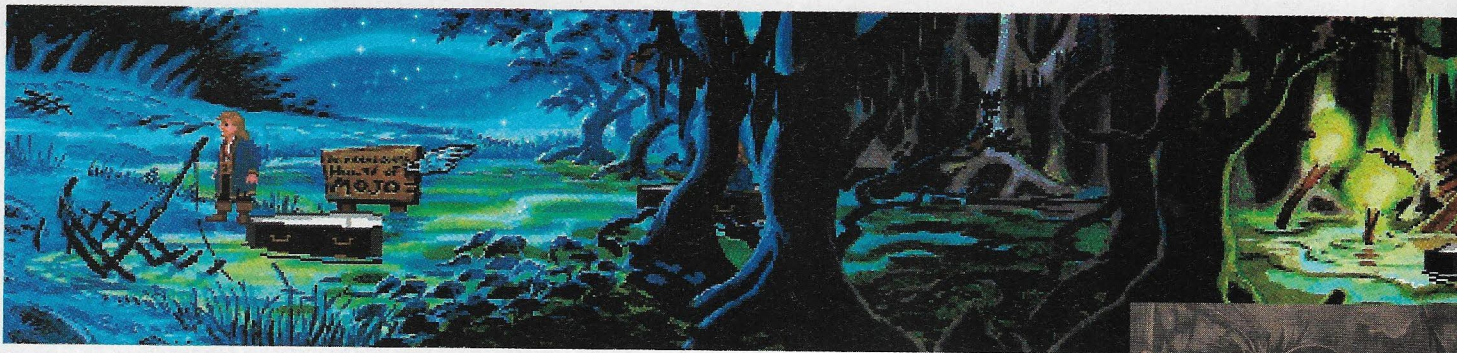
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**T**he original Monkey Island is my favourite game of 1991, so I waited for the release of the second right from the moment rumours began to circulate.

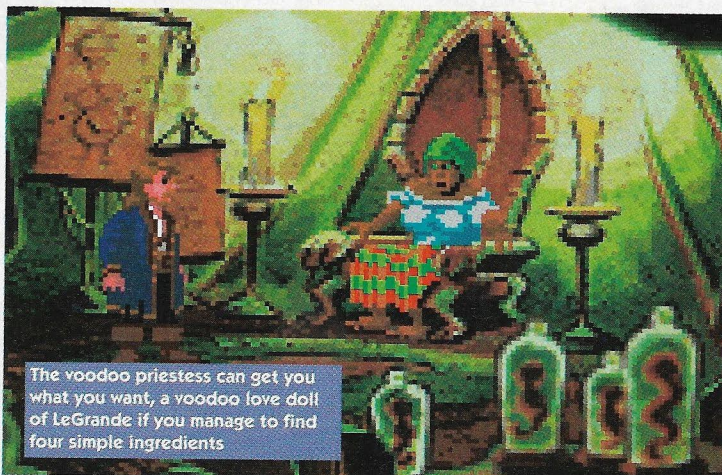

Your first meeting with LeGrande will result in you becoming poverty stricken without a penny to your name. Now you'll have to set about getting some money, which means a good honest day's grafting.

As before, the game is split into parts, each a mini game in its own right and as you progress through the game you'll have to perform various silly tasks. Each also makes up a vital section of the



story-line with loads of complicated and extremely funny puzzles for you to try and solve.

These include the decidedly gross such as taking part in a pirate spitting contest.

This requires you to gurgle and swish the saliva around the insides of your mouth before choosing the correct sound to make when letting it fly.

### HOORAY FOR LUCASFILM

This time the kind people at Lucasfilm have given two versions of the game. A normal one for people who are experienced in this type of game, like my good self, and an easy game for beginners to adventures.

However, the back of the box says, and I quote: "Optional easy mode for beginners and magazine reviewers." The cheek!

After the success of the original this is bound to do well in the sales coming up after Christmas. Does this mean that Lucasfilm will decide to splash out on a third game?

You control a team of four characters, all of which combine differing races and professions. You even have the option to choose whether they are left or right-handed, (no ambidextrous characters in this game).

If you prefer you could equally attempt the quest with less than four warriors



although it is strongly advisable that beginners use their full quota.

The layout of the screen makes the game very simple to play. The icons for movement and combat are placed on the right of the screen along with the four character sheets.

On the left is the main view window where most of the action occurs, and to the left of that are icons for saving the game and changing the preferences.

Clicking on the character icons with the left mouse button reveals the statistics and inventory of that warrior.

There are 14 spaces in your backpack to place equipment, plus a location for both hands and various segments of the body which can be protected by wearing armour.

Each player possesses three characteristics: health, stamina and magic. There is also an energy bar represented by the central screen figure.

Every time the character loses energy by not resting and going for long periods without sustenance, the bar will fall. When it reaches zero your stamina will drop until you eventually wither away.

**Sleep:** Clicking here allows your team to regenerate energy by sleeping. Don't forget to ensure you have enough food, otherwise your players may not awaken!

**Backpack:** Each character has a rucksack which can hold up to 14 objects, making a party total of 56 items. Extra goodies can be worn or held



**Stats:** The characters are determined by three statistics which illustrate efficient they are

If a team member should kick the bucket a heart will be left behind. Picking this up will allow you to restore the character as a sprig of life or death.

The scrolling too is very smooth, making the whole appearance one of immense quality. With excellent sonics, loads of explosions, laser sounds and a very fast backing track, your adrenalin is sure to be kept pumping.

On the down side this is just a little too hard; the action hots up too quickly to keep the average gamer happy for long and getting past level one alone proves to be just too much.

This is a shame because it is one of the best shoot'em-ups I've played for a long, long time.

Keep repeating these moves and you shouldn't loose too many hit points

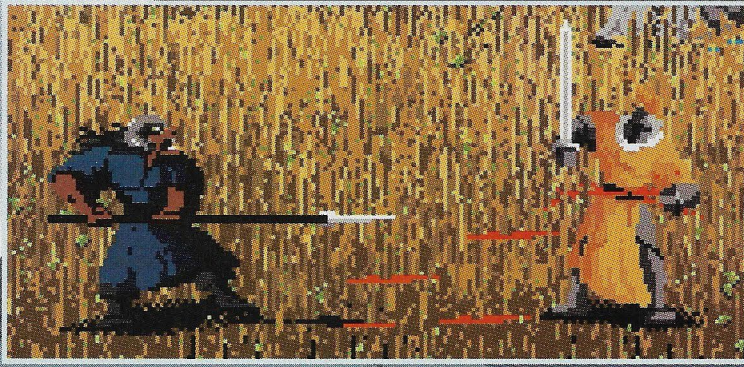


### MUDMEN

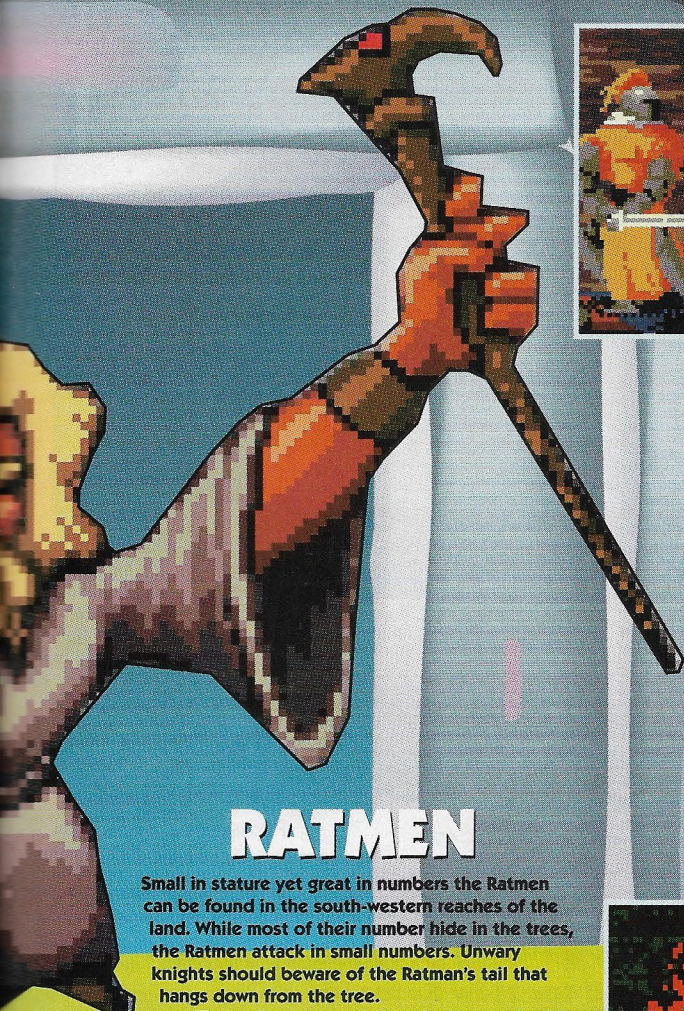
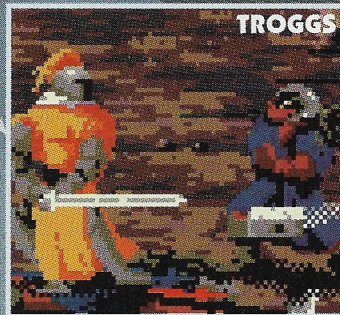


## TROGGS

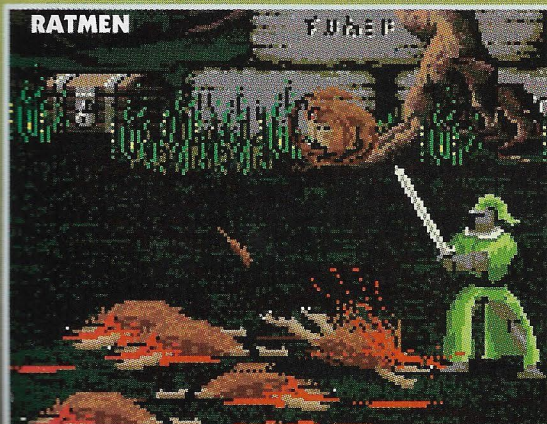


## RATMEN

I can highly recommend this to anyone with a tight budget, or anyone who has experienced one of the Dizzy games before! A definite contender for a Christmas stocking filler!



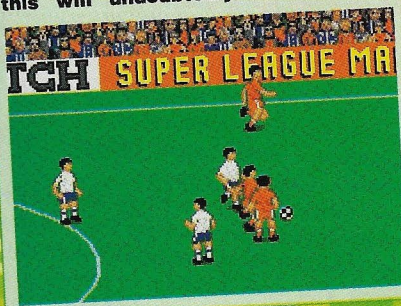

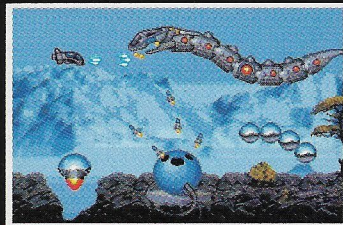
Project X is a horizontal, occasionally vertical, scrolling

Team 17 came up with the idea for Project X after examining similar games on the Amiga as well as undertaking research into what the public would like.

The Amiga is a powerful machine and the people involved wanted to push it right to the very limits.

Between the various levels there will be an incredibly fast scrolling bonus stage. As to what these bonus stages involve is as yet unknown, but they certainly promise to be special.

There is also a hard dance soundtrack playing throughout the game, coupled with sampled effects and speech. The programmers have kindly included an 'Old-timer Mode' which replaces the loud soundtrack with some softer tones.

As with Alien Breed, Team 17 is producing this game for 1 megabyte Amigas only. This didn't seem to halt the success of Alien Breed which has done very well in the charts.

Project X from Team 17 is due for release around the end of January and we'll be reviewing it then.

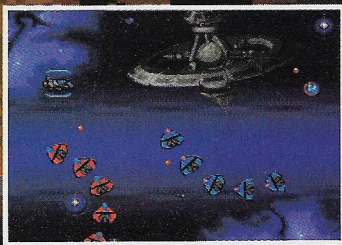

The old cells that make up the prison form ideal hiding places for would-be assassins. Play Alcatraz with a friend and make sure you cover each other.



**P**elicans once inhabited the island of Alcatraz, an American Indian term for the large-billed bird, in their thousands before an impenetrable fortress prison was constructed to detain the most ruthless criminals in the US.

Now the island stands as a museum. Inscribed on one door is 'Al Capones cell'. Another says 'Burt Lancaster's cell during the filming of 'The Bird Man From Alcatraz', and one even states, 'This cell detained Clint Eastwood - but not for long!'

A distinct and strong atmosphere permeates Alcatraz, the game, thanks to the highly-talented artist, Jo Fianne, responsible for the graphics in Hostages.

The project has taken more than 18 months to complete with design team 221B, who has recently completed Hero's Quest, taking on much of the production work.

### CORRUPT TO THE CORE

Many years have elapsed since the island played host to hundreds of undesirable guests. The museum has long since closed down due to unsafe construction.

Now, with the dawn of a new century, the island emerges as a drug factory and money laundering unit, run by one of the world's richest men, the drug baron, Miguel Tardiez.

Tardiez is drumming up so much power that the government fears a coup. Secretly, it assigns two crack commandos to infiltrate Alcatraz, destroy the drug making factory, set

light to the money and take Tardiez prisoner for the trial of the century.

An impressive intro sequence takes you from the lights of the city to the dark, cold and seemingly deserted island.

The small boat reaches the shore and stealthily the commandos run towards the barracks building which now houses Tardiez's guards.

A searchlight picks out the men and bullets scream through the air.

Controlling the commandos you must dodge the missiles and shoot all enemy on sight.

Once in the barracks the commandos can plant incendiary devices and throw grenades, leaving destruction in their wake.

The most important aspect of the mission is to find papers which prove that the island is being used as a drugs base before setting time bombs to destroy the money rooms and drug making factory.

The hunt then switches to the evil Tardiez himself. He is hiding in one of the cells in the prison block protected by his men. Vigilante guards make access through the main doors impossible.

Throwing their grappling hooks skyward our brave commandos climb to the roof.

However, searchlights illuminate the darkness and using the joystick you must therefore avoid being picked out against the black wall.

Once in the cell block Tardiez is found cowering in his cell. You must quickly make your way through the maze-like cell block and reach the beach where a helicopter is waiting.

Fail to reach the chopper in two hours, and you'll have to fight through the outside sections once more to return to your boat, dragging Tardiez dead or alive behind you.

The action is there, the atmosphere is strong, gameplay matches the strong presentation, and Alcatraz looks set to be a worthy

Like its predecessor, Hostages, Alcatraz sees you taking on some of the world's most fanatical terrorists. As we can see from this shot it looks as though you've got the situation well under control

successor to Hostages. What sets it apart from other action adventures is the different gameplay perspectives.

Very original and innovative, Alcatraz is scheduled for release on Amiga and ST in February '92, published by Infogrames.



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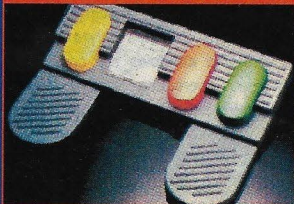
