



Adventure games, thinking games, RPG's and action oriented games were needed to keep the existing players interested and also to expand the user base into new age groups which were virtually untapped because of a lack of appropriate software.

That was earlier this year and just now we are beginning to see what Sega had in mind. We are excited about the new games coming out this Spring and hopefully you will find something that appeals to you.


Name your game category and there will be something for you. No matter what your age or game playing ability, you'll have to check out Sonic the Hedgehog. Spiderman and Fantasia are other adventure games that bring new ideas, moves and play mechanics to this genre. For the first time you can dive into a real military simulation with the Warrior of Rome. Abram's Battle Tank and 688 Attack sub offer other versions of this theme. Quest games are starting to appear with Dando, King's Bounty and Onslaught on the way. The sports games are entering their second generation with PGA Tour Golf, Jesse Venture Wrestling Superstars, Hardball and R.B.I. 3 coming soon. Powerball breaks new ground with a futuristic soccer-football combo. Puzzle game lovers will want to look for Junction or dive into some of the old classics like Pac Man or Space Invaders.

And this is only the beginning! Although Sega is tight lipped about what will be coming out in the all important second half of this year we ought to have a few exclusive previews in the next issue.



(ed. You're right Don, Sega had neither on display at WCES. From informed sources at Sega neither was shown behind closed doors either. Does that mean the products are on hold? Not really. Actually TERA is complete and next issue we'll hope to have a 'hands on" report for you! One thing everybody should know about TERA is that this is mainly meant to be a system for Japan. Over there the IBM or Mac are nowhere near as popular as they are here. TERA is a good way for IBM to get a foothold in the Japanese market. Sources indicate that it should be on sale

in Japan sometime in the second half of this vear.

Our contacts in Japan also report that the not-so-secret CD-ROM will appear there, in final form, 'under glass' sometime this summer and tentative plans slate it for a year end on sale

date. That is, of course, in Japan. The U.S. introduction will probably be a few months later.)

Well, it's not quite the size of the Genesis yet. What you would be buying is the sitdown version of Sega's new 'System 32' - Rad Mobile! Check out our Hi-Tech Sega section for all the specs on the king of the arcade machines!

As to the home version? Don't hold your breath! Is Sega working on it? You bet! Would they admit to it? No way! Is it coming soon? No!

According to a company spokesperson (at SOJ) the new system 32 was brought out for two reasons: 1) Arcade players have been asking for more and more realistic simulations, and these games are just not possible on the current 16 bit machines. 2) To make a clear differentiation between the 16 bit games for the home market, and those found in the arcades.

The second point is why we won't

see a home Giga Drive for several years. It's fun to dream though. If all



SYSTEM 32 SPECS FINALIZED; WORLDS FIRST 12 MEG GENESIS SOFT!

SYSTEM 32 BLOWS AWAY COMPETITION!

Sega of Japan has just announced the final specifications on their new 'System 32' hardware. The first game to incorporate this new technology is Rad Mobile, and the machines are presently being shipped to the arcades in Japan.

Based on a new 32 bit CPU, the System 32 has more than five times the capacity of their older 'System 18' board. More specifically, the System 32 contains a 32 bit CPU running at 16 MHz plus an 8 bit sound CPU operating at 8 MHz. For memory, there is 8 Mbit of RAM and 125 Mbit of ROM.

The screen resolution has not been significantly changed from previous configurations and specs out at 320 lines horizontal by 224 lines vertical for the standard resolution and 416 lines Horiz. by 224 lines Vert. in the high resolution mode.

There can be a maximum of 300,000 pixels per screen and up to 8,000 sprites can be moving around simultaneously! Each sprite can use up to 256 colors and this equals a simultaneous use of 16,384 colors.

The sound has not been neglected as 22 channels are available - 10 PCM and 12 FM, all in stereo of

course.

With such a powerful processor new tricks can now be performed. Since this is a racing game, these tricks involve simulating natural phenomena such as fogging, blurring and fade-in / fade-out.

As an example, when driving very fast, the roadside objects now scale gradually and also increase in delineation. In foggy weather, these objects become blurred and difficult to see. In rainy weather, the rain droplets slowly accumulate on your windshield and obstruct your vision until you turn on your wipers!

ACCOLADE DEVELOPS WORLDS FIRST 12 MEG GENESIS CARTRIDGE!

Accolade has just broken the 8 megabit Genesis cartridge barrier with the announcement of a new soft called Star Control. This game will utilize 12 megabits of memory and will also herald in a new premium line of Genesis games under the Ballistic name.

Previously Accolade had released Ishido for the Genesis and Jack Nicklaus' Turbo Golf (cart and CD) for the TurboGrafx.

Like the other carts that Accolade released, Star Control is a game converted from one of their computer products. Star Control, released in July 1990, was first made for the IBM PC and compatibles and then converted to the Amiga line. From this Amiga version designer/pro- Accolade, wanting the best possigrammer Paul Rieche 3 and his staff ble product for their new Ballistic spent 4 1/2 months to create a line, gave Rieche the go-ahead to Genesis cart. Since the Amiga version was a two disk game (about


12.8 megabits), major compromises would have to be made to fit the game into an 8 meg cart. do whatever was necessary to maintain the high quality of the original game. Rieche suggested that 12 megabits would be needed and Accolade agreed.

With this larger amount of memory to work with Rieche was able to port over the Amiga version completely intact. The graphics match pixel by pixel and the only compromise was in the audio. The Amiga version has digitized sound effects and BGM. The Genesis version has digitized sound effects but synthesized BGM. This freed up some memory so Rieche and crew went back in to tweek the game play and add new features! Besides playing better, the cart will have more scenarios and the player can explore more areas!

But what will 12 meg cost? Accolade has stated that the cart will retail for only \$69, about \$10 less than the 8 meg Strider!

GAME GEAR IN STORES!

Sega's new, economically priced, color handheld portable game machine - Game Gear is now in the stores. However, due to limited quantities, the GG presently will only be sold in two test markets - Los Angeles and New York.

The suggested retail price is approximately \$150 and that includes the basic system (without batteries), a wrist strap and the game Columns.

Also, immediately available are an AC adapter (\$12), a DC power converter/adapter (\$27), a Gear-to-Gear link cable (\$11) and a rechargeable ni-cad battery pack (\$52).

Sega officials have stated that the VHF/UHF tuner will be available, but not until sometime in fall. Although this tuner in now available in Japan (and it works fine in a U.S. GG) the FCC has very specific requirements that have to be met, and getting this FCC approval will take some time.

As to specs, the GG falls in between the Lynx and Turbo Express. The screen resolution checks out at 160 (H) x 142 (V) lines and, while not superb, it does boast vertical resolution almost 40 percent better than the Lynx. It's this difference that allows the GG to support a tuner. The guts of the GG is basically a Master System - a Z-80A 8 bit processor running at 3.58 MHz.;





The U.S. version of the Game Gear (shown with the optional tuner) is now in the stores.

64Kbits of main RAM; 128Kbits of Video Ram; 32 on screen colors out of a palette of 4096; and 5 channels of true stereo sound.

With specs so close to the SMS one would expect an adapter to quickly appear that would reduce the SMS cartridge pin spacing to match that of the GG. Almost. Sega has tried it and the rumored SMS cart to GG adapter works, but a large portion of the game falls off the screen, making the game unplayable. Any such future converter would require additional electronics in addition to modifying the pin spacing.

As for games, Sega is initially relying on mostly Master System conversions. Five titles will be available immediately - Super Monaco GP; G-Loc; Psychic World; Mickey Mouse and the Castle of Illusion and Dragon Crystal. G-Loc is new and the only shooter in the bunch. Rather than overload the system with a lot of shoot-em-ups, Sega plans to add variety by bringing out several quest/adventure games, a few puzzle games and a couple of action games. Their new games - Revenge of Drancon (really just a new name to the older SMS Wonder Boy cart), and Leader Board Golf are coming in May, and Joe Montana Football plus Shinobi in June, are examples of the wide range of carts Sega has lined up for us.

But Sega is not going into this alone. In Japan, virtually all of the

Mega Drive licensees either have GG softs out, or in the works. In the U.S., the licensees are ready to launch carts here, but they first want to see how the initial sales are before jumping in.

Besides the planned U.S. GG releases, there are over a dozen Japanese softs already in the stores and over two dozen more scheduled for release! Like the GameBoy, the Japanese GG carts work in the U.S. system! Older, well known titles like Pengo and Pac-Man are out and more like Chase H.Q.; OutRun; Alien Storm; Fantasy Zone G; Space Harrier 3; Golden Axe; Alex Kidd; VS Kung Fu; and Haley Wars are being worked on.

The first batch of U.S. and Japanese carts tested out OK. Don't expect Genesis performance at SMS prices though. The games play well on the small screen and the adventure games are on par with many of the SMS titles. The AC and DC adapters are well worth the money as the average life of the required 6 AA batteries is only from 3 to 5 hours. But this is no worse than any of the color portables. The one feature that really does sell the unit though, is the tuner. Being able to, one minute play games, and then switch over to watching your favorite show the next, is a very big plus for this system!

With all these features on its side, this is definitely one portable worth looking into!
