## "The Coin Machines Merry-Go-Round"

### PETRILLO PROMISES PEACE

The above headline probably appeared in your daily newspaper. It brings home a prediction made here sometime ago that a compromise would be effected with the record manufacturers by Local 802, AFM, before or after the start of the Congressional Investigation. Under severe questioning and much table pounding on both sides between Petrillo and Senators, Clark, Wheeler and McFarland, Petrillo admitted that he would attempt to effect peace and that he would meet with the executive board of Local 802 on February 1st in New York, to discuss the compromise. After that it is expected he will meet with the record and transcription manufacturers and arrange some sort of royalty per record basis. This is the time for the coinphono men to come into the picture to make sure that the record manufacturers do not slap this entire charge over onto the operators. If the royalty is very small this should most certainly be assimilated by the manufacturers. If it is larger than expected some compromise deal should be instantly put into effect with the phonops. It seems that one reason Petrillo has for this compromise at this time is to go after bigger game - the movie people. He also stepped into a very irritated labor situation this time where other professional men are losing out daily and forced to enter into any type of war work to exist. Petrillo was therefore extremely careful not to raise the ire of the public generally by keeping his musicians as a separate, lofty body of men who can be taken care of regardless of the present labor difficulties. As far as the coin industry is concerned this move for peace is the best that could have come about for the operator is just as anxious to see the musician get a rightful share and the musician is just as anxious to have the operator on his side. We hope that everyone will be completely satisfied when the compromise is put into effect.

### PRICE CEILING

Tho there never has been a definite price ceiling announced out of Washington on used coin machines - there was an announcement (as reported by The Cash Box some months ago) to the effect that all service charges would have to maintain a definite price ceiling. In short, if any charge was made for certain labor or repair work, this ceiling price would have to be maintained. It was and still is believed by some that the coin machine industry was also affected by the price ceiling ruling that applied to used machinery of all types. A much more definite announcement will have to come out of Washington prior to setting up price ceilings on used equipment. This is one industry that has always existed on supply and demand and price ceilings in this case would require a very liberal interpretation.

### IRD ON F.P.

The Internal Revenue Department continues with its own interpretation for F.P. games as to what constitutes a "gambling device" and what can be considered an "amusement machine". In short, as reported here many times before - if the Free Plays are paid off in merchandise or cash - the game must feature a \$100.00 license, for it is then understood to be a "gambling device". And likewise, if the F.P.'s are not paid off, then it is an "amusement machine" (just like that). We wish that New York's Mayor La Guardia and some of the other Mayors and Governors thruout the country would also accept this interpretation. The fact that the IRD won't change this ruling is readily understandable. The ruling itself should be used to open more territory.

### PORTABILITY

Probably the most outstanding factor in the success of the coin operated machine has always been its portability. In short, the op could move it to wherever he found conditions best suited to its operation. This major fact is now proving its importance to the trade in the 17 eastern states where A, B and C gas ration cards have practically been eliminated in an effort to save whatever gas stores there are on hand at this time. (Our item in this section "Cut Your Route" a few weeks back suggesting that all outlying machines be pulled in, if needed, proved of real value to the coinmen in these 17 eastern states.) The outlying machines will not receive the play they should get, at least not in these 17 states. In the rest of the country, too, outlying equipment should be concentrated into one easy-to-get-to traffic center by the operator. The outstanding fact remains - that the portability of coin equipment has saved the livelihood of many an eastern seaboard coinman at this critical moment and will continue to save coinmen everywhere in the country.

### EASTERN ROAD SPOTS CLOSE

Immediately after the announcement that A, B, and C gas ration cards would be held down to the most essential driving many noted road spots folded. Newspapers reported how some of the best known road spots, that had served an average of 175 to 250 people on Wednesday night (the evening prior to the pleasure driving ban) had but 12 and in many cases less people in their places on the following Thursday evening. Some spots decided to remain open and let go their orchestras. There will be a demand for coin-phonos from many such outlying spots. Such installations will have to be on a rental basis. It appears now that the neighborhood tavern is in for the best business in its history (in the 17 eastern states) and coingames will get their share of the increase in these spots. (Latest report on this ruling from outlying eat spots is that as long as there is no dancing past 11 P.M. and complete meals served these "restaurants" will be okay to drive to. But general scare handed public by OPA investigators threatening to and already seizing gas ration books may take some time to overcome. Some of the New Jersey spots featured large ads explaining that OPA had agreed to this feature. It is also reported that 3 miles is limit of drive to eat.)

### \$25,000.00

Those mechanics who are capable of replacing the rare and expensive tubes by a very simple re-wiring job so that low priced and easy to obtain tubes can be used instead are proving their worth to the firms employing them. This bit of resourcefulness is already being accomplished by many. Some mechanics are even rebuilding games entirely from scratch. Others, by simple changes here and there, are maintaining amplifiers, which are gradually becoming a problem. As long as screened glass and wood cabinets can be obtained - old wire and parts - ingenuity and resourcefulness will help keep this business rolling. Pay closer attention to mechanical details. Eliminate waste.

### SWAMPED

Many weeks ago, during our visit to Chicago, we called at the factory of United Mfg. Co. where we met with Harry Williams and Lyn Durant and showed these two energetic and ingenious coinmen a copy of The Cash Box. And they subscribed. This past week we received a letter from Harry Williams. It advised us that The Cash Box was the one and only medium wherein the firm had advertised their newest revamp - "Grand Canyon". "And", writes Harry, "we have been swamped with business ever since." (The Cash Box swamped this firm with business for an expenditure which, we feel most certain, Harry will admit is many, many times less than what he has ever previously spent to popularize any of his revamps.)

### DEPOSIT RACKET

For sometime we have been debating with ourselves whether to bring to light this newest racket which has developed in the coinbiz. We were not going to hide it under a basket because The Cash Box reaches coin machine people only and if there is anything scummy around the family - let's get together and clean it out. It's our family and we want to keep it a clean family. This past week we received three more letters regarding what we prefer to call the "deposit racket". There are a very, very few certain firms with extremely small finance who insert advertisements in leading publications featuring exceptionally fine merchandise, much in demand, at extremely reasonable prices - which naturally deluges them with orders - and DEPOSITS. In most cases these firms do not have this merchandise. They are planning to pick it up here and there on receipt of deposits, which actually becomes their working capital. If they are lucky enough to pick it up you will get what you ordered, provided of course, that these firms make some sort of profit on the transaction, regardless of how small it may be. If they can't pick it up (and, by the way, they'll ship anything, regardless of condition) you will eventually, get your deposit back - but not until some time has elapsed, which is just what this sort of firm wanted, so that they could use this deposit money to continue to do business. (A long time ago we called for establishment of a Credit Bureau. Such actions will always exist until the leaders of this industry get together into a group to eliminate them and save themselves money as well as find themselves capable of doing better business without distrust predominating.)

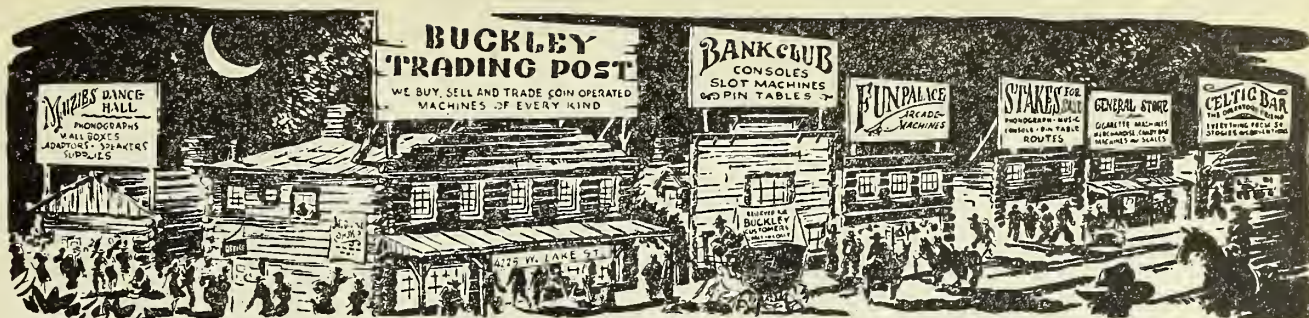

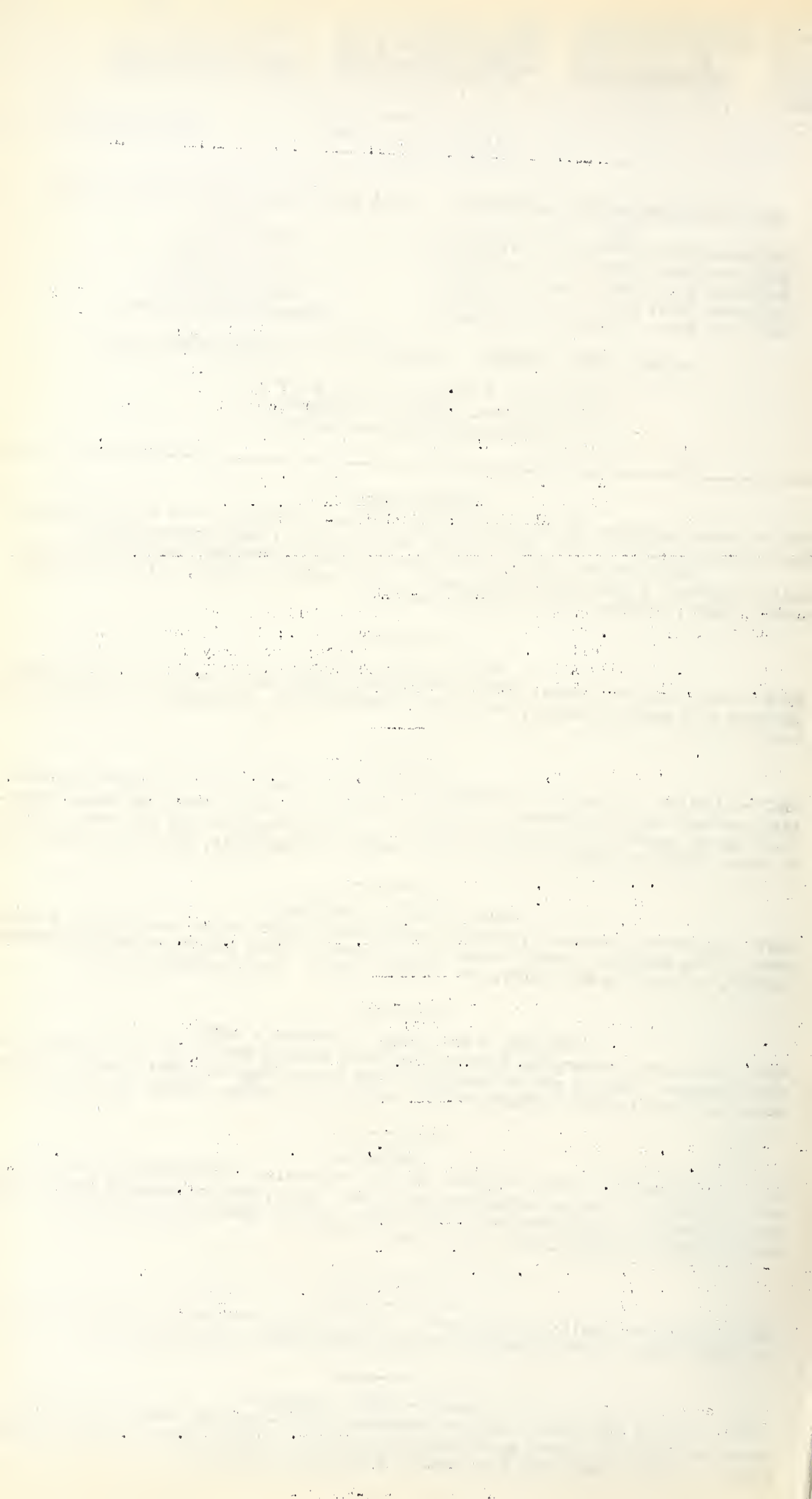

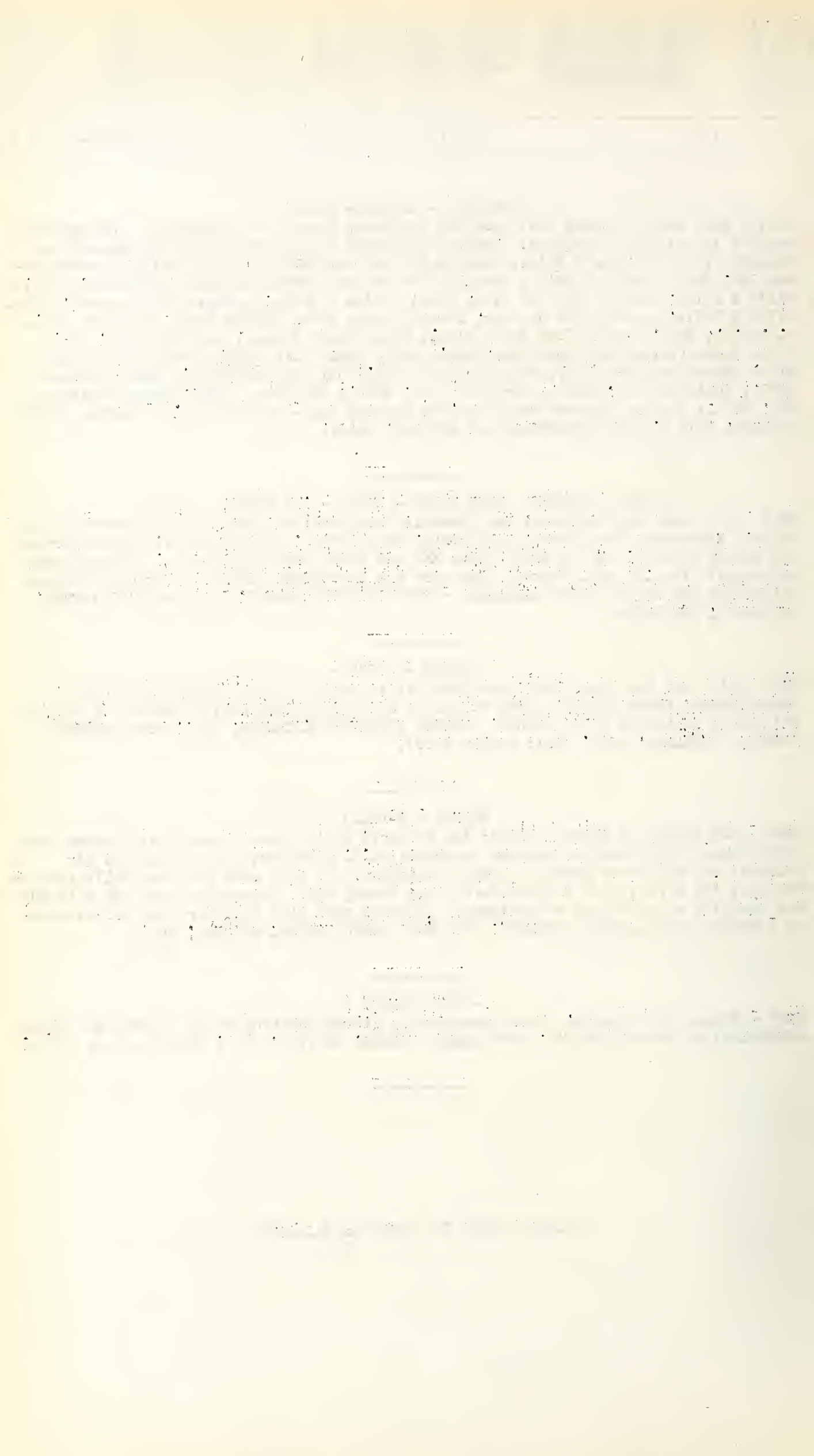

The following report describes the results of a study of the  
properties of the  $\alpha$ -phase of polyethylene. The work was  
carried out in the Department of Chemistry, University of  
Chicago, during the tenure of a National Science Foundation

The  $\alpha$ -phase of polyethylene is a crystalline form of  
the polymer which has been extensively studied by  
X-ray diffraction, infrared spectroscopy, and other  
methods. It is characterized by a unit cell with  
orthorhombic symmetry and a density of approximately  
0.997 g/cm<sup>3</sup>. The structure is based on a packing of  
hydrocarbon chains in a regular array. The chains are  
oriented parallel to the *c*-axis of the unit cell, and  
are separated by a distance of approximately 2.5 Å.  
The *a*- and *b*-axes of the unit cell are approximately  
3.7 Å and 2.5 Å, respectively. The structure is  
characterized by a regular array of hydrogen atoms  
on the surface of the chains, which gives rise to a  
distinctive X-ray diffraction pattern. The infrared  
spectrum of the  $\alpha$ -phase shows characteristic absorption  
bands in the region of 2800-3000 cm<sup>-1</sup>, which are  
attributed to the stretching vibrations of the  
hydrocarbon chains. The structure of the  $\alpha$ -phase  
is believed to be the same as that of the  
orthorhombic form of polyethylene, which is the  
most common crystalline form of the polymer.
