ON THE RECORDS



Record manufacturers hope to continue production equal to '42. With all shellac frozen manufacturers must get back old records to melt down for shellac. '41 was the record production year with 130,000,000 manufactured. The belief is that had things been normal this figure would have been surpassed in '42. Formerly 20% shellac went into each record. At present only about 8% being used. Record firms have biggest backlog of orders in their history. Belief is that Petrillo matter may be settled completely even prior to Congressional investigation. Manufacturers are still seeking an economical substitute for shellac. Records made of glass (which excited the trade in mid '42) haven't materialized as yet tho certain glass manufacturers are still at work on this angle. VinyLite, which is better than shellac and one substitute that can be obtained, is now being used for some radio transcription records (it cuts down surface noise even more than shellac does) but is entirely too expensive. Use of VinyLite would raise cost of records over 1000%. Quality of records will continue inferior in '43 but at least manufacture will continue which means phonos will get supplied and that is most important to coinmen.

\$2,000.00 IN 36 HOURS

One of the most heartening reports we have yet had regarding The Cash Box came from Joe Calcutt of The Vending Machine Company, Fayetteville, N. C.R.R. CLICKS

The "Confidential Record Report" has clicked. Dozens of letters received after the first issue of this most complete and chronological report of the new records and what they are earning for music men was issued (New Year Special, Jan. 5th, '43 issue) attest to this fact. These letters were not only commendatory but also offered many fine suggestions and support to help compile this report. Each one admitted that we had taken on a tremendous task but a mighty fine and important one for the welfare of the automatic music industry. (We hope that you will display the Confidential Record Report in some prominent place in your showroom for all music operators to see and be guided by it.)

RATIONING TO HELP AMUSEMENTS

The pages of newspaper publicity, the many hours of radio commentators and the statements of government officials regarding the new rationing plans for the public are now history. Rationing has become more severe and this severity will seem light in comparison by the end of '43 when even more stringent rationing plans may be adopted. Generally this means that with much more people gainfully employed, who cannot purchase the heavier products, such as autos, refrigerators, etc., and are now cut down on even food products and almost every type of luxury, while earning more money than they ever did before, with an expected 40 to 50 BILLIONS OF DOLLARS surplus thereby sure to result this year, which even increased taxation and greater savings will not wipe away, there is no doubt that there will be greater activity in the stock market by the average man and in amusements - which are not rationed. The amusement industry expects this year to be a banner one because of this fact. The coin operated machines division of the amusement industry is therefore facing one of its best years, all other things being equal, with much of this huge dollar surplus to be spent by the public in relaxing diversion.

3¢ COIN OPENS OPPORTUNITIES

The publicity attendant to the announcement of the new 3¢ coin has won much comment from members of this industry. There is no doubt that the public will consider this an "odd" coin. It is expected to be of steel base with zinc coat. This will tarnish rapidly. The size of the coin has not as yet been made public. But, it is hoped that it will be the same size as the present penny. If such proves to be true then this industry will find the 3¢ coin right down its alley. Many a present old penny game can be revived with the 3¢ coin. Many a counter game can return to the fold. The 2 penny

chute card vendors can use this single chute 3¢ coin and offer 2 cards for 5¢. Dozens of new ideas are popping up daily on what can be accomplished with this "odd" coin. There is no doubt that the public will not hold onto it for long. They will want to get it out of their pockets! The ingenuity of the men in this industry will be proven by this coin.

CUT YOUR ROUTE

This may sound harsh. But, it's practical. The angle is simply that the intelligent coinman, already noting what '43 has in store, with a possible 300,000 small businesses of every type expected to fall by the wayside according to economic experts, will find it more profitable to cut down on his route than to allow wasteful stops to abound. Outlying spots should be immediately pared off for the gas and tire situation absolutely require this action. If you have a spot in someone else's territory try to get together with him on selling or trading it so as to keep your route in one tight, centralized, economically operating unit. Only in this fashion, which may prove a bit sacrificial at first, are you assured of continuance. Furthermore, lack of mechanics makes this even a greater necessity today. You may lose a few dollars off the gross (those that increased taxation in '43 won't get) but in the long run you'll be much better off.

TWO TOUGH MONTHS

For years past the belief has been that January and February are the two tough months. That's why conventions came to be held in January to sort of break the monotony and perk up the trade with the new equipment (which usually wasn't delivered in any quantity until sometime in Spring anyway). But, this year January has started off with a bang as is attested to by the New Year Special issue of The Cash Box which was purposely announced right in the very heart of the Holiday season and yet brought out a terrific response. Prices are higher. But, even prices of butter and bread are higher, too. We feel, perhaps optimistically, but most assuredly, that January and February of 1943 are going to fool the old timers and turn into two fine business months.

DISAPPOINTMENT

We've already received a few letters advising us of keen disappointment at our announcement that we have been forced to forego our Indoors Entertainment Conference after a meeting with ODT (Office of Defense Transportation). We do hope that this disappointment will not be too general. It would not then reveal the right sort of patriotism on the part of the men comprising this industry. If you will also recall, we did state that there was still a possibility we might be able to hold the I.E.C. sometime this Spring when transportation facilities were expected to loosen up a bit. One distrib advised us that he had already gathered together approximately 50 coinmen who were anxious to attend. We heard from others who had popularized the I.E.C. just as greatly in their territories. There is no doubt now that it would have been a grand meet, but, no meet until Uncle Sam feels we can hold it without discomfort to our armed men who are constantly traveling.

REVAMPS

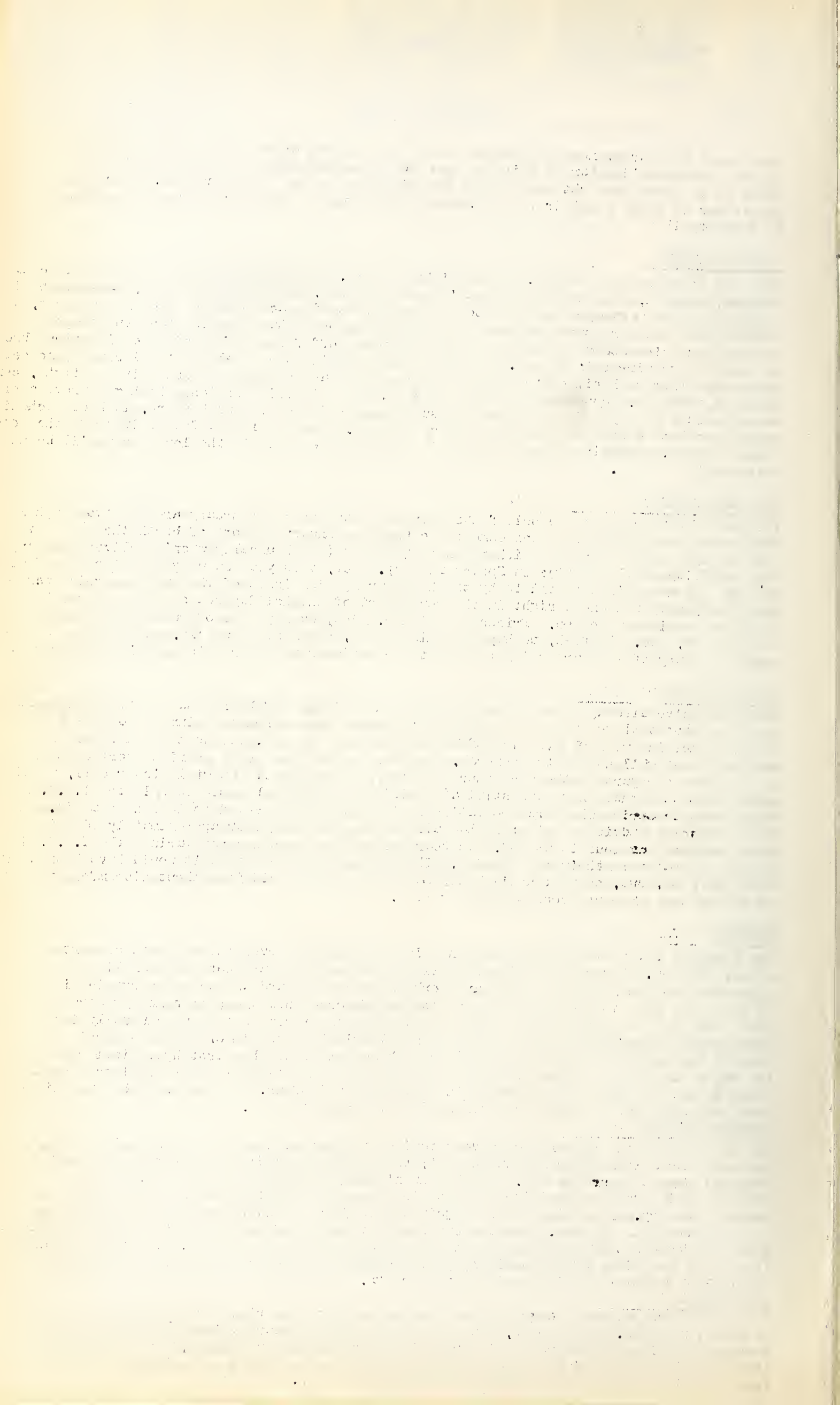
The revamper is one man in this industry who deserves the complete support of everyone of us. Far seeing coinmen realize that these men are not only gambling with their good money but that they are working extremely hard and doing everything in their power to devise ways and means to help produce new and better moneymakers out of old junk. Not only is this commendable to an extreme but is an unusually ingenious and resourceful accomplishment that should win the acclaim of all coin machine people. Some of the early revampers who took advantage of the first hysterical rush have gone the way of all flesh. Those who remain at this time seem more or less destined to continue to do much good work in behalf of all of us. Support for them at this time will mean continued better business in the months to come.

BANDING TOGETHER

Out of the hysteria of revolutionized methods of doing business in this industry today has arisen one commendable fact; that many are banding together for their future welfare and protection. Tho this hasn't as yet become very general, as it should, it still seems a definite trend on the part of many clear thinking individuals in this industry. Many distrib have joined with jobbers and ops to form routes to sustain them for the duration. In many cases we have heard of former salesmen joining operators and jobbers to form a strong selling and operating organization. If this continues, these firms will more than likely prove to be the strong nucleus for this business necessary for instant action in the post-war era.

CIRCULATION

There have been a great many thousands of pages written on just what circulation really means. We remember, away back when we first started into the advertising business, hearing one famous publisher tell a group of eager novices, "I would much rather advertise in a medium with a circulation of 2 than in a medium with a circulation of 2 million if the 2 in the first medium were buyers."
