# Are We Having Fun Yet? You Bet!

They say time flies when you're having fun. Well, we must be having a great time at GamePro, 'cuz this is the April issue and we're just now able to bring you a report from the 1991 Winter Consumer Electronics Show (CES) last January. Actually, for us it IS January, but that's the magazine biz (and don't let anyone tell you different!).

So, we dragged ourselves in from the Las Vegas desert. We dumped all the press packets we collected into a huge pile on the floor and dived right in! When we came up for air we had enough stuff to put together ProViews on some cool games and to pack the Cutting Edge, ProNews, and the Short ProShorts sections with info. We even landed a few Previews for you, too!

Just like the shark in "Jaws," the Nintendo 16-bit system was lurking in the shadows of the show. According to Nintendo, an American version of their Japanese 16-bit Super Famicom will land in the U.S. this September, give or take a month. But until the "Super NES" arrives, we'll cover the Japanese versions of 16-bit Nintendo games in Overseas ProSpects, beginning this month.

However, that gives Sega a window of opportunity to hustle in some great Genesis stuff, and they are! Scope out the Joe Montana Football and the StormLord ProViews this issue.

The 16-bitters may be coming, but that doesn't mean 8-bit games are falling out. No way! We've got Double Dragon III, The Simpsons, and Base Wars for the NES, and Ghouls 'n Ghosts for the SMS.

Some of the games we brought back from the show aren't even completely programmed yet, so how about a little PreView action? Take a look at Battletoads for the NES, and Bonk's Revenge, T.V. Sports Basketball, and T.V. Sports Hockey for the TurboGrafx-16.

Nintendo says there are a little over four million people with Game Boys in their pockets, so check out Tour De Thrash and Burai Fighter Deluxe.

Finally, it looks like color handheld systems are getting ready to make a big splash this year. Sega's Game Gear is set to take off, and the Atari Lynx is sporting a new look. See the Cutting Edge for an update on these systems, their new games, and more.

GamePro will parade some neat stuff past you in the next few months so stay tuned. We've got enough gaming hardware and software here to last a while - till the next CES show in June, anyway.

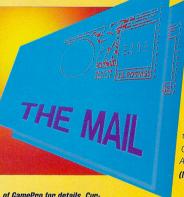

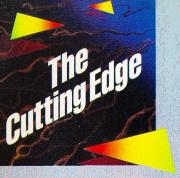

# **CE at CES**

There was plenty of Cutting Edge action at the 1991 Winter Consumer Electronics Show, By now much of it may have filtered through to you, but here's a recap of the things that pushed our turbo buttons.

# A Bit About 16-Bits

The big non-news at the show was the 16-bit Nintendo Super Famicom. The Big N had a snazzy showroom and demo set up and the unit and its games looked as good as you've seen in GamePro (see Overseas Prospects this issue). Nice show, but all Nintendo would say is that the American version is due to arrive here in September...or October...probably.

Rumors about Atari's 16-bit machine, codename: Panther, were also buzzing about the video jungle. But like the Loch Ness Monster, Bigfoot, and other mysterious beasts, few people have actually seen a Panther, Nice tidbits include the fact that the unit will run at 16 Mhz compared to the Sega Genesis' 8 Mhz and the reported 12 Mhz of the Super Famicom, that it will play Lynx games, and that the unit's debut will coincide with that of Nintendo's 16-bit unit in September...or October...probably (see the above paragraph).

Expect all 16-bit rumors to get real by the Summer Consumer Electronics Show in June.

# Sega Goes Small with the **Game Gear**

Sega made a big splash with its little handheld - the Game Gear. The \$149 Game Gear gets its processing muscle primarily from a Z-80A processor much like the Sega Master System.

The GG's a neat little rectangular package (8.1 inches long by 4.3 inches wide by 1.5 inches high) that features smooth, curved styling in the same groove as the Genesis and the new SMS. The unit has a 3.2 inch backlit color LCD that displays 160 by 146 pixels in 32 on-screen colors

in to a special Cutting Edge Game Gear feature in the next month's GamePro.)

Sega promises 20 Game Gear games for 1991, but at the show eight were playable, two were imminent, and the other ten were as yet unnamed. The Sega Faithful ought to recognize Castle of Illusion Starring Mickey Mouse, Columns, Joe Montana Football, and Super Monaco GP right off the bat. The new carts include G-LOC, an intense aerial combat game from the arcades, Dragon Crystal, Psychic World, Revenge of Dracon, and Leader Board Golf.

# The Lynx Shrinks

A new Atari Lynx is on the prowl, and it's a little leaner and meaner. The new black cat is really a compact version of the original color handheld unit. The shortened size makes it more comfortable to hold, but it's operationally identical and softwarecompatible with the original system. You get the same 16-bit graphics engine, a 32-bit audio processor, a 3.5 backlit LCD screen, and a double row of fire buttons.

Each Hall will contain several Electronic Personal Orientation Devices (E-PODs), Gamers climb into the E-PODs and step into virtual reality. They can play any one of six games against a computer or each other. For example, fly a Sopwith Camel in a WWI dogfight, blast off into a Star Wars-type adventure, or stick to Mother Earth with a travelogue to foreign lands. Bullet-Proof VR is 1½ to 2 years away, but we'll fill you in as soon as we can.

The Super Famicom is up and rolling! NCL (Nintendo of Japan) has reported that the first batch of 300.000 Super Famicom units sold out in three days. Like any hardware system, the Super Fami-

com is only as good as the software that drives it. If the initial game releases are any indication of things to come, expect the Super Famicom to be around for a long time.

This month we continue our software previews with a closer look at four of the initial releases for the Super Famicom: Final Fight (the #1 Super Famicom game in Japan right now) by Capcom and Pilot Wings by Nintendo.

A "punching and kicking free-for-all" best describes Capcom's arcade hit. Final Fight has been translated to the Super Famicom almost perfectly (it's minus the two player mode). It's no wonder it tops the Super Famicom cart chart in Japan.

This isn't a typical "fly a jet" type of simulator. rather, a chance for gamers to get the feel of skydiving, hang gliding, soaring in a biplane, and blasting around in a rocket pack. The cart features several levels composed of different combinations of all these flight skills.

The first thing you notice about Pilot Wings is the magnificent graphics. For example, when you skydive you get the same view you would if you really jumped out of a plane. You can flip and turn in mid-air, just make sure you keep an eye on your ground target or you'll end up in the water. Hitting air targets awards you bonus points if you can glide through them during your descent. Once you open your chute (the computer indicates the best time to pull the rip cord), you must compensate for wind currents and your speed of descent. With practice, you'll hit the target almost every time.

Flying a biplane is slightly more challenging. You have to land the plane on the runway carefully. Damaging your aircraft nets you major penalties. Check out the sweeping landscape as you circle to the right or the left.



A smooth landing is your key to racking up noints.

The rocket pack combines the skills you pick up during skydiving and in the biplane. You need to fly through three air targets, ascend to a certain height, and slowly drop down on top of a target. Miss and you're penalized big time.

If you master the biplane, the rocket pack, and skydiving, you pass the second level and you get to try hang gliding.

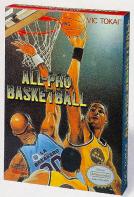

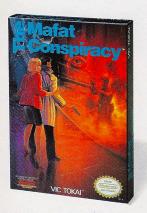

# Black and Blue Belt Recommended

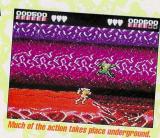

It's been a regular
pigskin smorgasbord
these past couple of
months. There's been ma-

jor football releases for every game system: TV Sports Football for the Turbo-Grafx-16, NES Play Action Football for the NES and the Game Boy, and John Madden Football for the Genesis.

And now comes Joe Montana Football, the long awaited Sega football simulation for the Genesis. Joe told us (via TV commercial) that the Sega programmers were taking their time with this one – wanted to do it right. What he didn't tell us was that this cart has undergone a complete facelift since it first reared its head at the 1990 Summer Consumer Electronics Show.

#### .Ine Gnes Genesis

Sega took their time producing Genesis Joe and the quality shows. A crisp, clear digitized voice welcomes you to the game as soon as you turn on the cart and images of Joe flash across the screen.

Joe Montana Football features a realistic offense – your running backs have to hit the holes and follow their blockers, you must "lead" your receivers (throw the ball ahead of them) to avoid interceptions.

On defense you can lay a bonecrunching hit on an opponent to jar the ball loose. You can also be called for pass interference if you hit a receiver before the ball gets there.

There are 16 teams to choose from, based on the playing abilities of their 1989 NFL counterparts. You can also choose the length of the game (from 10 to 60 minutes), whether there will be penalties, and the type of game you'll be competing in (regular season, Sega Bowl, or two minute drill).

#### Left on the Cutting Room Floor

Joe Montana Football started out with a horizontal screen layout so you could see a larger portion of the field at one time.

The PC and the Sega Master System versions kept their side-to-side perspectives, but this plan was scrapped for the Genesis.



PROTIP: If you're a beginner, select a strong team such as Los Angeles (Raiders, not Rams), San Francisco, New York, or Buffalo.

Other features that were in the orignal plan but never saw the light of day were: a League Play and "Save League" feature, two-player cooperative play, audibles at the line of scrimmage, instant replay, and the computer's ability to learn your playcalling tendencies.

Some of these features just didn't fit into the program, others were scrapped because of impracticality. But Joe Montana Football probably looks the way it does because John Madden Football was so great.

John Madden Football, for those of you who haven't seen it, uses a vertically scrolling field, and it works well. Joe Montana Football now uses this same view.

#### Joe vs. John

So which is better, Joe or John? If you're a football fanatic, both games will score a touchdown with you. Some key differences between the two: John lets you see all three receivers at once on offense, in Joe you have to hit a button to view one of your other receivers. John's manual is full of valuable gameplaying info (e.g. every player is rated in four categories). Joe's passing plays are more exciting because tipped passes can often be caught by other players. In a regular game the Joe Montana computer is easi-

er to defeat than a similar game against the John Madden brain, but the Sega Bowl final game on Joe Montana is the toughest of all (because it cheats, but more about that later).

#### The Niner Massacre

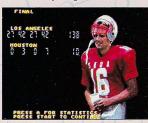
One of the grueling tests we subjected Joe Montana to was the obligatory "How good is the computer" trial. This is something you probably go through when you get any sports game. The more challenging the computer player is, the more life you'll get out of the cart.

PROTIP: Block a punt by selecting the player in the middle of your front five. Move him slightly to the right before the computer team snaps the ball, this way the computer blocker will miss your charging player. When the ball is hiked, charge forward and hit the B button to put your player's arms in the air. If you line up with the punter, you'll often block his kick.



PROTIP: If you have a speedy left linebacker (like LA does), your best defense against the computer is Nickel formation, double coverage. When the ball is snapped bitz in through the middle and hit B to put your player's arms in the air. You will often tip the pass or sack the quarterback.

We decided to take on the world champion 49ers with the Los Angeles Raiders. To say this game was a blowout



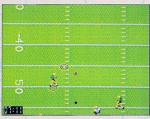

would be an incredible understatement. After one quarter, the Raiders led the Niners 44 to 0, and it got a lot worse!

After a 60 minute game, the Raiders whipped the Niners 200 to 25. Yes. you read that right, 200 points and a total of 1,349 vards on offense...scarv! However, during the Sega Bowl it was a different story.

PROTIP: Bombs away! The con team is heavily susceptible to the long pass during a regular game.

We said earlier that this game "cheats" during the Sega Bowl and we meant it. If the computer decides it wants to score, there is very little you can do about it, no matter how good you are. Seven of your men won't be able to bring down their ball carrier.

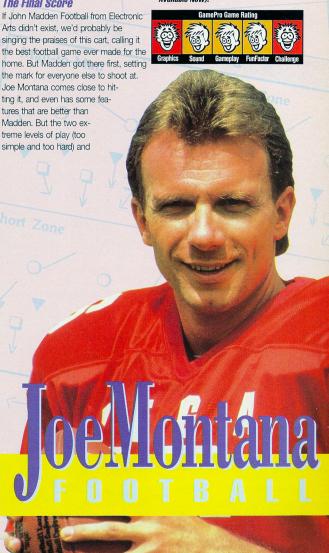
Beating the computer during the finale is almost impossible. The only way to succeed is to outscore the computer, and then not leave it enough time to march down the field for a final score. He who has the ball last is usually the winner.

#### The Final Score

If John Madden Football from Electronic Arts didn't exist, we'd probably be singing the praises of this cart, calling it the best football game ever made for the home. But Madden got there first, setting the mark for everyone else to shoot at. Joe Montana comes close to hitting it, and even has some features that are better than

the lack of team charts in the manual really detract from the overall quality of the game. Let's call Joe Montana Football for the Genesis a definite playoff contender. but with limited Superbowl possibilities.

PROTIP: Try to destroy the eggs containing blue gargoyles before they hatch!



#### PROTIP: Hopping goblins are easiest to avoid if you simply crouch and let them hop over you.

What makes the game interesting is that you can't rescue the princesses in a linear fashion. For example, obstacles and monsters may force you to journey far to the right towards the end of the level to rescue one princess, and then backtrack to the middle of the level to free another, and so on.

As you advance to each new level you'll discover that the princesses are more difficult to rescue and that the enemies are more numerous and relentless. You have until the Moon is high to complete each level or your game ends.

#### On the Wings of an Eagle

The StormLord, however, is in no hurry. He kind of heel-toe's it through each level, but you can pick up the pace by catching a ride with Reizarb the eagle. Just stand on certain magic stones and he flies you to and from different areas of the level.

You take care of business by casting magic stars and tossing swords, but the real key to success is learning how to make clever use of the multitude of special objects you find scattered throughout the land such as Umbrellas. Winged Shoes, and Honey.

My friend and I have been attempting to defeat "Dark Force" in Phantasy Star II for the last three months, but to no avail! Please help!

#### Answer:

To beat Dark Force your party must consist of yourself, Rudo, Anna, and Amy. Make sure your guy is at least 35th level so you have the Megid Technique. Make sure Amy has Nasar and Gisar. Good weapons to have are the Nei Sword for vourself. Nei Shot for Rudo, and Nei Slasher and AC Slasher for Anna, No. weapons for Amy since she must be the Healer.

When you fight against Dark Force first set yourself on Megid and Amy on Star Mist (if she has any, otherwise use Nasar or Gisar). When you use Megid it takes half of your party's energy, so Amy must heal everyone. Hold down Button B so you can plan your strategy in between rounds. When you run out of Megid, use your Nei Sword. When Amy runs out of Nasar, have her use Gisar and keep fighting. You can use this same technique on Mother Brain.

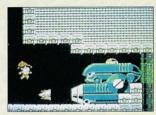

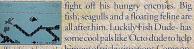

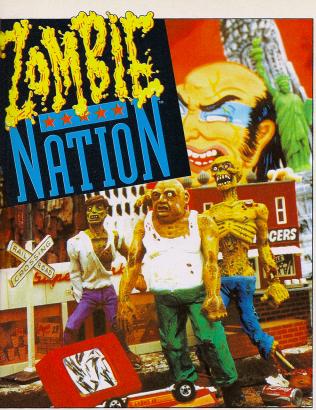

#### **Nintendo Drops Exclusivity** Clause

Nintendo of America has dropped the exclusivity clause from its licensing agreement with third party developers for its new 16-bit SFX system. Until recently, Nintendo had required a two-year period of exclusivity for all NES software. By dropping this clause from all developer contracts, licensees can now manufacture the same title for any video game system without waiting two years. Maybe the Genesis version of Sunsoft's Batman will finally come to the U.S.

#### **American Video Entertainment Sues Nintendo**

Software producer, American Video Entertainment (Pyramid, Krazy Kreatures) filed a \$105 million suit against Nintendo of America and its parent, Nintendo of Japan, charging both companies with violations of antitrust laws. These violations, according to Richard Frick, general manager of American Video, include using a secret lock-out system which rejects American Video's cartridges. According to the complaint, Nintendo failed to inform its buyers that only Nintendo cartridges would play in their machines and represented to Courts of the United States that cartridges manufactured by any independent could be used in Nintendo consoles.

#### Bandai Buvs Dreamworks

Nintendo licensee Bandai America has reached an agreement to merge with Sega Genesis licensee, Dreamworks. Currently slated Dreamworks titles. Jesse "The Body' Ventura Wrestling Superstars and Wings of Wor will still be shipped as scheduled, No word yet whether or not Bandai will bring some of its NES titles over to the Genesis.

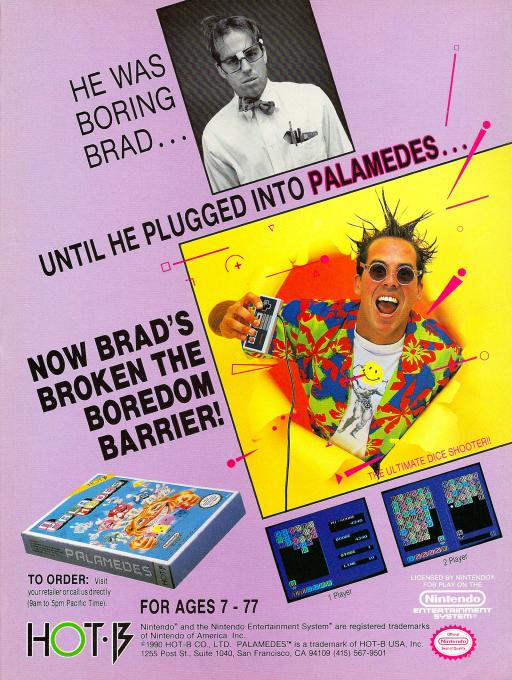

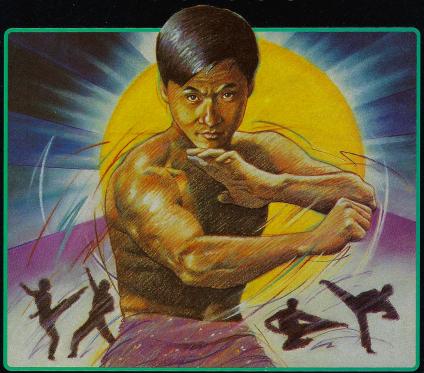

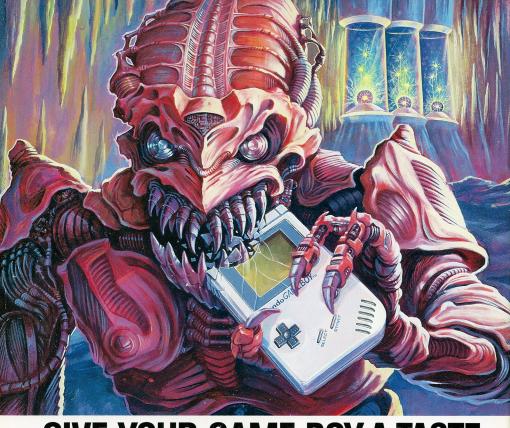
