"The Coin Machines Merry-Go-Round"

AWAKENING

Having just completed an extensive trip it was exhilarating to note the air of great optimism which has suddenly prevailed this industry. Leaders are of the belief that the entire field will soon be back in bigger and faster action than ever before. It was also most pleasing to find that a great many firms were seriously and sincerely preparing for the post-war era. The belief is to the effect that this industry will be among the first to profit from the awakening of all American industry after the war.



It is also extremely stimulating to the members of this industry to know that their leaders are at this time rapidly advancing plans for their future welfare. Most of these men have their own ideas upon which division of the industry they will concentrate their greatest efforts. This feeling of optimism, this sudden awakening which has come to the trade, most certainly means that this business will be among the first to take advantage of the opportunities that will arise in the post-war era.

This awakening is also much due to the great earning power which all coin operated machines have demonstrated during this war period and also to the fact that they stood up so well in public opinion for their amusement and merchandising and service value, thereby creating a greater niche than ever before for themselves in America's industrial empire. The coin machines business can most assuredly be stated to be well under way with post-war plans and also well on the way to the creation of a bigger and better and more prosperous industry when the war is won.

NEED FOR UNBIASED APPEALS BOARD

Because of the scarcity of equipment at this time creating an unusual market condition, and also because of the fact that this business is working at a speedier tempo than ever before in its history which has caused many to neglect better business practice, there has resulted a crying need for an unbiased appeals board to bring about adjustment of many problems resulting from this present wartime situation.

Such an appeals board could most naturally be created as a division of the proposed National Coin Machines Board of Trade. Such an organization, because it would have to be non-partisan, non-political and non-profitable in character, would be best capable of handling all appeals. Further, because it would actually be a Board of Trade division in every sense of the word, it would thereby be best able to correctly execute the judgments required.

Better and closer understanding must eventually come about in this industry. To help bring about such better understanding a complete clarification of all business methods should be made. Sellers should specify just what they have to sell, its exact condition, whether it is or is not ready for shipment, or whether it must first be taken off location. Also whether it will or will not be crated and whether any extra crating charges will be made, as well as just how many of the item is on hand, etc. Buyers, too, should be more explicit. They should explain the methods they use and how soon they pick up machines and also what they require from a machine.

This business of seeking "suckers" to sell to at extremely high prices is rapidly becoming a thing of the past. It will probably disappear entirely when the manufacturing get into production again. There are no "suckers" in the strict sense of the word. Because one certain individual will pay higher prices than another for certain types of machines does not by any extent of the imagination make him a "sucker". The only real "sucker" we know of is the location owner who buys his own machine.

Because of this there is a demand today for something which can be termed an "appeals board". A group of carefully chosen men who will decide the right of each man to do business in the most ethical fashion and the wrong or the right of the individuals involved in certain transactions. We do not like to see men lose money because of lack of understanding. We do feel that men who go into deals without making definite agreements beforehand should not be made to entirely suffer the consequences of being such poor business men. We do believe that where a man has worked with complete honesty that he be given a fair and square deal.

Gradually and surely the so-called "sucker" is being eliminated. Those who believe that the "new blood" who will enter into this business after the war can be considered "suckers" have yet much to learn about the new business practises which are being created of their own necessity each day. Those who feel that they are grabbing sucker money by selling poor equipment at exorbitant prices to little known operators in out-of-the-way spots will only learn to their future sorrow that they missed a chance to have a customer who would probably bring them real profit for years to come. Those who feel that use of certain publications is to obtain "sucker sales" have as yet much to learn about business generally. The "sucker" passed out with Barnum. The country today is interlaced with organizations to protect the unwary from the wily. That is why the demand for an "appeals board" has arisen in this industry.

OPEN LICENSE PUBLICATION

The open publication of the licenses which will be obtained by coin machines men from the federal government is being looked forward to by certain newspapers and individuals thruout the country. Of greatest interest to the press in such centers where so called coin operated "gambling machines" are not allowed to operate are the names of those licensees who will obtain the \$100. license. It is believed that it will be just about 60 days before these lists will be available. As is generally known the federal government refused the pleas of the coinmen who were last in Washington not to release these names to the public and the press. In certain cities where the press may have little to occupy their attention, complete lists may be openly published, some coinmen believe.

Here is an extremely delicate and poised problem for the trade. It is believed among many that in the long run publication of such licensees will not hurt collections. Others are of the opinion that this will hurt coin machines operation and may even start crusades in certain sections. It is natural to assume that even if the name of a location (purchasing a \$100 license) is published in the local press that it is not going to affect the regular business of this location, tho the location owner may not like to see his name so published. The only sad probability is that by such open publication some publicity seeking politico may decide to go all out and do a lot of yelling to help his own cause more than anything else. This always sounds good to the blue-noses, and especially before election time. In such cases it will most definitely be up to the good will which this industry's members have won for themselves with the public in their communities to forestall any drastic action.

To give some idea of how the press in certain cities awaits the federal release of those licensees who will purchase the \$100 license is this very small item buried away in The Chicago Sun (July 2, 1943) which is captioned, "Autoists Without Stamp Face Fine". The headline reader entirely passed up the real "meat" in this item and even the reader of the first paragraph could only find reference to the fact that any Chicago autoists found without the \$5. federal use stamp tax on his car would pay a \$25. fine, according to Carter H. Harrison, federal revenue collector for this district. But, the very last sentence in this small item reads, "Harrison also announced that it would be two months before figures became available on how many people in this district paid the \$100. federal tax for operation of an illegal slot machine."

In short, here was one of the leading newspapers in the city of Chicago already shooting out to get information on the \$100. licensee for what this paper called, "the operation of an illegal slot machine". Similar items are reported to have appeared in other papers thruout the country. Formerly the average paper would give much more space to such news. Today, with the war going as it is, these papers haven't as much time nor space for such items. But, certain publicity seekers do have the time.

It is an extremely difficult task to predict where the open publication of the \$100. licensees may lead. Were there a better understanding amongst the public of just what is and what is not gambling equipment the publication of these names would be greatly minimized. That is the big job that really faces this industry. We must get the public to understand our equipment from its legal interpretation. Until such time it is easy for the average coinman to understand that this is most certainly not the time to relax vigilance but rather be more prepared and more vigilant than ever to overcome any action which might be taken to hurt his future welfare. The Cash Box once again, at this time, repeats the caption which appeared on its "Cointoons" page in the July 13 issue, "Beware - It Can Happen Here".

"The Coin Machines Merry-Go-Round"

NATIONAL SALES

The average firm in this industry has gone completely national in sales policy. Instead of catering exclusively to local trade, the leading wholesale firms in this industry are today carrying on a national sales program which is remarkable in the fact that it has opened the entire industry to a new type of sales competition and has also tremendously shortened distances.

Visiting with some of the leaders in the field during the past two weeks we have learned that they are doing more business hundreds of miles from their own cities than they ever did before in their own territories. We also find that the prices in various territories control the sale and distribution of the merchandise in this field. Wherever operators are willing to pay higher prices machines will be shipped in preference to confining them to a single territory.

This has had its effect on general sales policy and also on complete nationalization of the sales efforts of many firms now engaged in this industry. It has also given firms thousands of miles apart a clearer and better understanding of each other's needs. It has opened the path to a new type of post-war business. It is bound to bring about the finest national distribution methods when this war is over. It will mean a new era from the standpoint that by better understanding among each other the men in this business will have come closer together and are thereby certain to raise the standard of business ethics for this industry.

NO BOX NUMBERS

As is known to all subscribers of The Cash Box this medium will not accept any advertisements featuring "box numbers" instead of firm names. We believe that such advertisements, in the majority, are attempting to hide their actual identity only because they are not prepared to openly present themselves to the trade. In some cases, where territories have gone down, firms that wanted to clear the equipment that was banned, were forced to assume box numbers as much as they didn't like to for fear that the authorities would see their firm names and crash down upon them. (This was the case when New York City and the state of New Jersey closed on certain types of equipment.) But, in the case of The Cash Box this is not necessary. This medium remains confidentially confined to the active members of the coin machines industry exclusively. We have been commended on this feature a great many times and have been asked to once again repeat this fact so that the newer subscribers to The Cash Box would also be acquainted with it.

THE GALS AGAIN

Many times during the past year, The Cash Box has suggested that this industry give more of its attention to the women players of its equipment. As explained time and again this does not mean that coinmen need decorate their equipment with frilly lace nor offer nylon stockings as high score awards, but that equipment be so located that it prove attractive to the gals. So far it has been a remarkable fact that this industry finds the majority of the equipment it features meets with the gals' approval. Now, more than ever, will this prove an important profit factor.

Frank R. Wilson, assistant secretary to Jesse Jones of the Department of Commerce, reported a few weeks ago at the wartime conference of the Special Libraries Association in New York, that the 2,800,000 male majority which this nation had in 1910 is being whittled away at the rate of 100,000 a year according to the census figures. "Sometime this year", Wilson stated, "regardless of our war casualties, this nation will pass from its traditional role as a 'youthful' nation and become one of the so-called 'older' nations. A characteristic of a youthful nation is a preponderance of males in its population", he explained.

Every year from now on the Dept. of Commerce believe that 100,000 women will be denied the opportunity to marry. They will, of necessity, assume a large part in activities associated with making a livelihood, and will therefore prove of great importance to business generally. This, coupled with the fact that so many of the women now at work will not want to return to domestic life when the war is over, is going to create a labor problem for this nation. And as is already well known, with women in control of the larger percentage of the finances of this nation, thru inheritance, etc., the gals become ever more important to all trade.

FALL SPECIAL ISSUE
