"The Coin Machines Merry-Go-Round"

MUSIC MEN BOIL AT RECORD MFRS.

For many, many months now the record manufacturers of the nation, especially those three leading manufacturers who are in control of the best artists, have been sadly neglecting this little coin operated music machines industry.

Not only have they been flagrantly and openly neglecting, and actually pushing this trade around, but they have even gone to the extent of trying their very hardest, at least their districtmanagers have, to keep away from the men who brought their industry out of the dumps of despair and helped place it on top, as one of the nation's most enterprising, and most profitable, businesses.

To this day, when records are discussed anywhere in the nation, whether in the press, the home or over a luncheon table by the average layman, the words that are eventually heard in connection with popular records are always, "juke boxes".

This, in itself, is an indication of how the public ties popular records in with the medium of this coin operated music industry. This is proof, sufficient of itself, to anyone, anywhere, that this is the industry that brought the record manufacturers out of their slump, and definitely helped get them to the top position which they now occupy.

Today these same record manufacturers, these same firms who formerly shipped samples of their latest recordings to all leading music operators free for test purposes, who catered and wheedled to them, who begged for their support, these same people are today neglecting this man who helped them to the top moneymaking class. They push him away from themselves as they would some sickened and odoriferous creature.

It is indeed sad that the members of this coin operated music machines industry, one of the largest and most recognized networks in the history of the musical world, have to take this sort of treatment from these manufacturers. From everywhere in the nation music machine operators tell stories of how they have been openly neglected and even mistreated by the record manufacturers's district representatives.

Oper and blasting proof is the fact that when this publication complained to one noted manufacturer that the music machine operators in a certain large southern city were not getting any new records, and hadn't been able to get any new records for over four months, since a new manager was installed in that office, these men suddenly received a batch of 200 records from this very same office which wouldn't give them anything before. In short, there always were records there - if the music operator could get them.

Furthermore, this office manager tried to coerce these music machine operators. He sent each one of them two cases of lamps which they did not order. That was his entrance introduction to his new office. The operators could purchase these lamps cheaper elsewhere. When they returned the lamps they were told that they wouldn't get any records if they weren't going to buy accessories.

This treatment from a direct representative of an outstanding record manufacturer, who after all is supposed to manufacture records and not be interested in wholesaling accessories, was an insult to the intelligence, to the cooperation, to the faith that these southern music machine men had shown him for many past years.

These men did not get any popular records. Every so often this office manager sold them a classical recording. But when this complaint went thru headquarters, and it was a strong complaint, these men suddenly did receive records, 200 of them. This proved that all along they could have been given records. This proved that they were being coerced. That they were being neglected and even pushed around. That records were being sold in their territory - but not to them - the music machine operators who sweated to help make this firm great. CH PHONE PHONE AND ADDRESS

From a midwestern city comes the story that one record manufacturers agent is selling his records to a furniture store that never before handled records. When the music men of that city want some of these records they are told to go to this furniture store, where they are forced to buy them at retail, for $65 \not$ to \$1.00 each.

This in absolute neglect of the fact that when this recording firm started to do business, just a few years ago, they first came to the coin operated music machines trade to get their first flush of business. This, in spite of the fact that these music machines men were the first to purchase these records, to popularize them, and have been buying them in quantity ever since. This, in spite of the fact, that they were receiving no better price than a retail store would get.

Now they are being forced to pay the consumer's price. They are being told that the one and only way they can get records at all will be to buy them at this furniture store. This in thanks to what these men have done to get this firm on the map, in the face of the competition it knew it had to meet from the big three manufacturers in this business of recordings. This is the thanks the coinmen in this city are getting for the cooperation they gave, the money they spent and the effort they put forth to popularize this company's products.

These are but two of hundreds of cases from all over the nation. From one New England city comes the story that to purchase one leading manufacturer's records they are advised to call on the department stores in that town. Here they must pay the same price the general public pays. This in thanks for the work that these men did for this firm when it was desperately trying to get back on its feet once again.

In this same New England section, in another city, one noted music machines operator, who owns three record stores, which the record manufacturers know nothing about, reports that he can only get records by ordering them thru these stores, not directly as a music machines operator. And to get records from one leading firm he even lends his trucks to them to help them make deliveries.

When he orders as an operator, he advises, he gets one or two or sometimes he will get three of a number, and only a few of the numbers he wants. But when he orders them thru his record stores, he gets 25 and more of each number he wants. To continue serving his locations with the records they want, he must continue operating and maintaining these three record stores.

These stories can go on page after page. They are an indication of what has, and what is continuing to be the case, as far as the record manufacturers are concerned.

There is cold, biting anger in the heart of the average music machines operator that will some day make itself extremely apparent to these manufacturors.

The average operator can remember when these manufacturers needed him and wanted him and catered to him. How they worked with him. Even to the extent where they gave him credit beyond his means.

Today, because the juke boxes of the nation have popularized records, all department stores and retail outlets like furniture, electrical appliance and drug stores are clamoring for them. The record manufacturer seems to have forgotten his old friends. He is selling to firms that never before knew what a record was or how to even handle that record.

Many in this industry propose that some other sort of record manufacturing firm be created which will work only for this trade. Others feel that there should be a meeting with the heads of the record manufacturing firms and once and for all time get to some solution of the distribution problem.

If the record manufacturers intend to continue the course which they have followed these past few years, they should be frank and honest enough to come out and say so.

If they do not know that their underlings are using these sort of coercive tactics against this industry then let them now, once and for all time, clean their own house, and thereby correct this evil method of doing business.

If they feel that the juke box industry has accomplished its purpose and done the merchandising sales job they desired from it, and is not needed anymore to help them get along - then let them say so.

Regardless of what the facts are in the case, this is the time for the record manufacturer to come forth, honestly and openly, and tell the members of this industry what they want to know - whether there will ever again be equitable distribution.


"The Coin Machines Merry-Go-Round"


This industry is getting damned tired of being pushed around by these record manufacturers for the work that it has already done, and is doing in their behalf.

LEADERS URGE COMMITTEE TO GO ALL OUT FOR HOSPITALIZED SERVICEMEN Combined Effort Will Award Industry Great Acclaim

Will Bring Greater Respect And Recognition For All.

NEW YORK—As a result of the many articles appearing here, urging this industry to greater all out effort in helping win the war, many noted coinmen from all over the nation have written in to urge that a Committee be created to bring about aid for returning hospitalized servicemen.

It is well known to all the nation that these men, who have been returned from the front line battle positions, some very badly wounded, are in need of all the aid that they can get from the general public.

Such industries as the theatrical field have won tremendous acclaim in the nation's press for the work they have done to ease the many silent hours of suffering these wounded go thru. The theatrical industry has not only sent performers right up to the front lines but each and every day, in every city in the country, they are sending entertainers right into the hospitals where the wounded need all the entertaining relaxation they can get.

This industry is in an extremely unique and fortunate position in this regard. Not only have many noted medical men agreed that "music therapy" is of tremendous aid to the wounded but that a great many of the amusement devices of this industry are actually invaluable in bringing about return of action to wounded parts of the body. For example, one noted medical man stated that a bowling alley installed in one of the hospitals has helped an untold number of boys to regain action of injured hands and bodies.

Furthermore, the equipment of this industry remains stationary. It does not just go in for a few moments and then leave, like entertainers from the theatrical field. It is a permanent fixture to aid these wounded service men. They not only relax when playing the machines and juke boxes, but they are actually cured of a great many ills. Therefore, once the machines are installed they become a definite part of the therapy division of the hospital.

With larger and larger numbers of wounded men returning from the front line battles, this is an unusually fine opportunity for this industry. It means bringing these boys back to normality once again. It also means winning national acclaim for this industry. It is certain to bring about the kind of outstandingly good publicity for this field that its members have long sought.

These coin machine leaders urge that local committees of operators, jobbers, distributors and even manufacturers be created in each town and each committee appoint someone to meet with other committees so that a national committee can be created which will gain national attention to this effort on the part of this industry.

It is also believed by these leaders that the men in this trade will find it possible to have many of their members exempted from any work or fight classification because of this. They will prove entirely too valuable. Mechanics will have to be on hand to make repairs when necessary. Committee members and all concerned with this industry will prove important in working with the medics to obtain best results for the wounded.

This may even bring about, these men believe, national medical attention to some of the equipment of this field for the general good of all people in the nation. The doctors may discover, they claim, that some of the coin operated machines are of great value to continuing good health of the public as well as these wounded servicemen and that this may place such equipment in an entirely different bracket in the opinion of authorities thruout the nation.

This great opportunity should instantly be taken up by all the industry. Every reader of this article should immediately call in his friends and get the ball rolling in his own community. This is for his own future general good and welfare and may mean his preservation as a coin machines man.

Virginia Music Op Urges Trade Create Own Firm

PORTSMOUTH, VA.—In answer to the article which appeared in The Cash Box regarding the treatment music ops are receiving from the record manufacturers, one noted Virginia music op writes.

"Am just wondering how much longer we fool operators are going to let the record manufacturers push us around like sheep. Why can't we get together and create a manufacturing organization of our own? Am certain every operator in the country will gladly invest in such an enterprise, and without a doubt we have a ready market for the product of such an undertaking."

C.P.A. Idea Clicks With Many Coinmen Many Coinmen

PHILADELPHIA, PA. — One noted coin machines distributor of this city reports that coinmen here who read last week's article on the employment of Certified Public Accountants by the members of this industry, has found that everyone of the men who come to his offices agree that this would prove to be the finest thing that could happen to benefit all the industry.

He says, "And what these men save you in income tax alone is worth many, many times what they eharge for their services. Surely they will help create a National Tax Council by teaching coinmen the value of such a council." NEW YORK — In keeping with the many items which have appeared here the proposed tax bills which have suddenly been introduced into many state legislatures are now causing alarm among coinmen.

Once again The Cash Box urges that the men of this industry get together as rapidly as they possibly can into a National Tax Council to offset some of this legislation which may close down a great many communities to various types of equipment.

Leaders are urged to propose methods for immediate creation of a National Tax Council and submit names of coinmen they believe will come together into such a body.

Gallup Reports Half Of Nation Gambles

NEW YORK — George Gallup, Director of the American Institute of Public Opinion, reports in an article appearing in the New York World Telegram, that "nearly half of the nation gambles."

Gallup stated that due to the ban on horse racing his Institute made this survey and learned that approximately 45% of the adult population of this nation gambles on one thing or another. Surprising to all will be the

Surprising to all will be the break down report on a percentage basis of what the Institute's investigators learned ranked most popular as to betting with the public. Of all the people who do some betting about 15% claim that they are ahead, some that they either break even, and the majority that they lose.

It is surprising to learn that Church lotteries, Bingo, etc., accounts for about 24% of all gambling.

Playing cards or dice for money (usually in the home) about 20%. Betting on elections or athletie events 17%.

Slot Machines only 16%.

Punchboards about 15%.

Betting on horse races only 7%. Playing the numbers game 7%.

New Frosted Foods Vender Gets In 'Times'

NEW YORK—Probably presaging the opening of the new vending machines era, the staid New York Times (January 29), devoted a three column picture and almost a solid column story to a new frosted foods vending machine which will be manufactured in Denver, Colo., after the war.

Jane Holt who is the woman's economics editor of the Times believed this sufficiently important to devote most of her daily item to the machine which is called, "Frez-O-Mat".

In an interview with Milton Rifkin of the Twentieth Century Marketing System of Denver she reports that not only will this unit have forty-two compartments handling that many different kinds of packaged frozen foods but that it can also be coin operated and will therefore make it extremely easy for the housewife to purchase her frosted foods from this machine.

Most interesting to the trade, of course, is the fact that such outstanding newspapers as The New York Times recognize this sort of equipment as part of the future merchandising fixtures of all finer stores.

Rifkin is also reported to have told Miss Holt that these units can be installed in apartment house lobbies and basements and will thereby bring frosted foods right to the door of the buyers.
