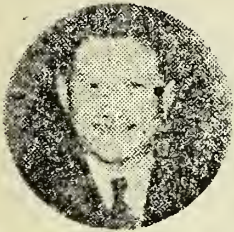

"The Coin Machines Merry-Go-Round"

RECORD MFRS. TURN DOWN PETRILLO

The record and transcription manufacturers rejected the plan of the American Federation of Musicians for settling the controversy over recordings asserting that they could not accept such a startling new social philosophy. In short, as an industry employing only a small portion of AFM union members they could not see their way clear to helping eliminate all unemployment in this union by paying the freight via a tax on each record they made. (That's alright with us coin machine men). The recording companies who signed the letter turning down Petrillo's negotiation offer "suggested" that he first obtain "Congressional authorization" for his "unemployment plan". (That's alright with us coin machine men, too). But, as The New York Times (Wed., Feb. 24th) reports, "In what represented their first public statement since the start of the controversy seven months ago, the record companies also indicated that they expected the union to solve for itself the problem of 'canned music'." (That, friends, burns me up. Burns me up because I can remember when the record industry was so low down in the dumps that it had actually fallen out of the bottom. I can remember when I called on some of the "big shots" in that industry and pointed out to them the plausibility of advertising to coinmen and get the record business back on its feet again. That was even before the modern phono came into being. And, you know what that did for records.)

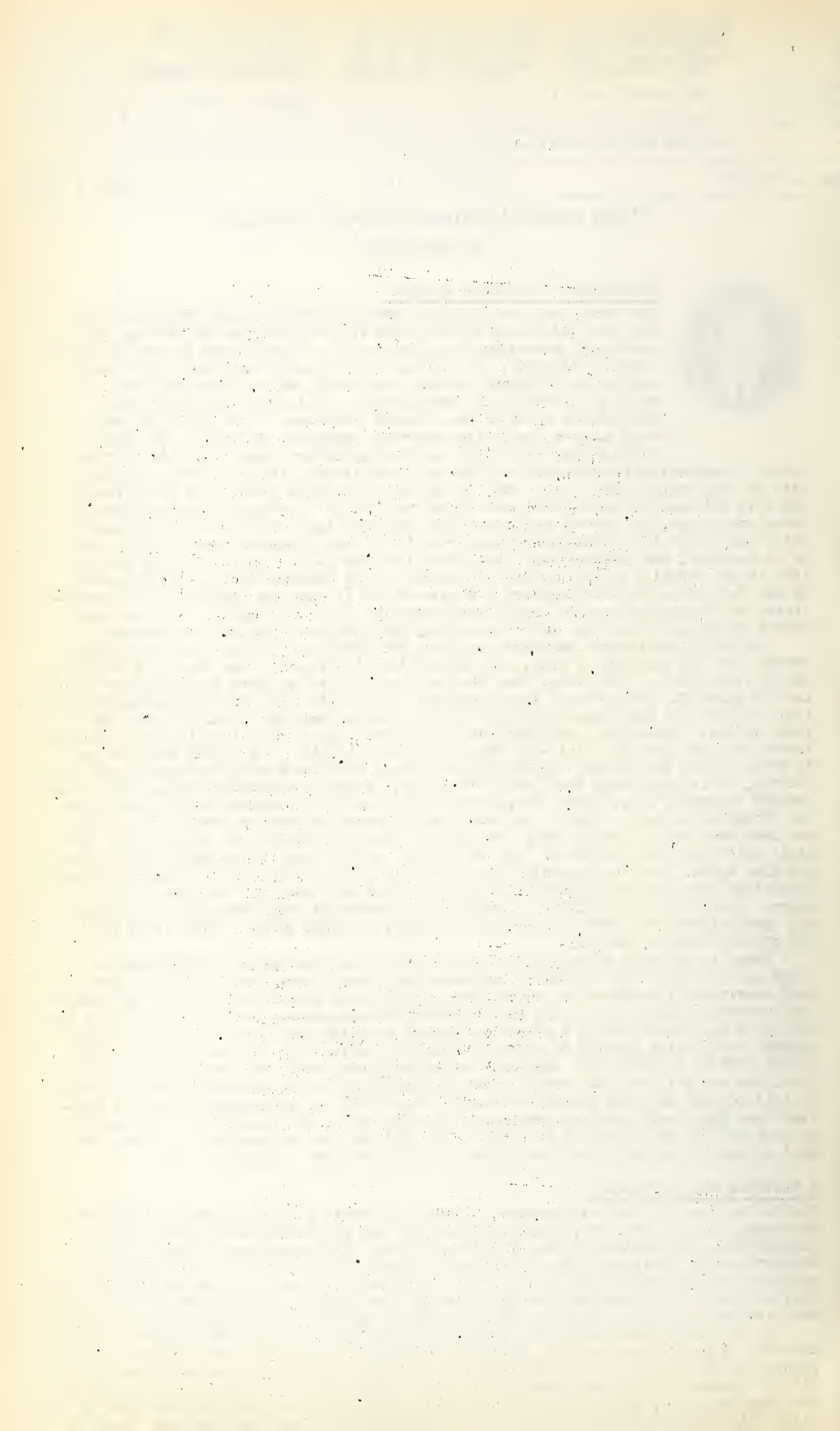
In short, the record companies now dodge the "juke box" issue. Just as we have stated time and time again, they, nor anyone else, is with us. Now they come out and say so very bluntly. In short, they are telling Petrillo to solve the "juke box" problem for himself. They sort of push us aside. They claim that they are making 80% of their records for home use. That put us down as using only 20% of all the records they produce. Maybe they feel that they should "push us aside" since the phono manufacturers did not show up at all - to negotiate with Petrillo. The letter that was sent to Petrillo and the AFM was signed by: RCA Victor; Columbia Recording Corp.; Decca Records, Inc.; Associated Music Publishers, Inc.; Empire Broadcasting Corp.; Lang-Worth Feature Programs, Inc.; Muzak Corp.; Standard Radio; World Broadcasting System; Soundies Distributing Corp. You are now back exactly where you started when this record ban came into being 7 months ago. You haven't made one single inch of progress. You still can't get new recordings. You are "in the middle" just as we have told you time and time again. Now the recording companies pull out for their end and simply divorce themselves from the problem of "canned music". And tell Petrillo that this is his worry. They forget the MILLIONS OF RECORDS you purchased from them. They just simply and openly infer that THEY HAVE NOTHING TO DO WITH "CANNED MUSIC". That it is ONLY 20% of their market, anyway.

There is no doubt we could go on for hours venting our spleen on the heads of these men who FORGOT TO REMEMBER. But, we would rather leave this UP TO YOU. The most charitable interpretation we can put on the record manufacturers action as regards the automatic phono is that they are deliberately understating the position of this industry to put themselves in a better bargaining position with Petrillo and gain more support from public opinion by stressing that the public will pay the freight. WHAT DO YOU WANT TO DO ABOUT IT? You, each individual phono man. You, each phono association. (We can tell you that Petrillo has been friendly to the coinphono. We know that he told someone he would rather see records made FIRST for coinphonos because he realized that they would give entertainment to larger groups than made for home use. We do know that he was surprised the phono mfrs. did not come to see him. We know, too, that he would much rather talk to automatic phono men than to anyone else.)

A NATIONAL BOARD OF TRADE

Now is the time for the coin machines industry to create a national "Board of Trade" from among its leaders. Now, while this industry has become smaller and more highly concentrated, the leaders of this industry, who are the subscribers to The Cash Box, can arrange for a national Board of Trade to solve whatever problems there are now and whatever problems will occur in the future. Not only will such a group eventually establish more ethical business practices for all the industry but will enable those men who definitely desire to continue in this business to do so on a much healthier basis.

In our last week's issue we asked for cooperation from all the members of this industry to benefit each other. We believe that this cooperation can best be accomplished by the creation of a national Board of Trade, composed of an executive council of directors from about seven outstanding sections of this country. These men to then appoint state, county and city directors. In this fashion every problem that arises will receive complete consideration. Only the most important problems, those of

a definite national character, will ever reach as high as the executive council. This national Board of Trade will act to help every operator, jobber, distributor and manufacturer and even those allied to this industry.

A national Board of Trade for the coin machines industry, started now, while this is a much less cumbersome task, will be ready to function efficiently and completely when this war is over. It will be able to correctly and carefully guide the members of this industry. It will be able to handle all problems connected with this industry. It will be representative of the entire industry and will therefore be able to present itself at any place where such representation is necessary. It will, most definitely, be able to adjust conditions to meet the many changes that are coming and which may otherwise hurt a great many now intensely interested in this industry.

TRUCK TIRE RESERVE

You can build up an emergency reserve of truck tires as a truck operator if you show that you have applied to the ICC for a certificate of convenience. As yet we do not know the entire details of this ruling. We suggest to those coinmen who have fleets of trucks that they apply to ICC (Interstate Commerce Commission) for clarification.

A BILLION PER WEEK IN THE PUBLIC'S POCKETS

For some issues now we have advised you that if you do not think inflation is here, you're only kidding yourself. We also told you that the government simply must tax and tax and tax away those many extra dollars that are pouring into the public's pockets. Right this minute over \$300,000,000.00 per week pours into farmer's pockets. Over \$500,000,000.00 per week into the pockets of workers. This is not counting the wage increase which has just been allowed by Economic Stabilizer Byrnes, nor does it include the overtime money that will be allowed for the new 48 hour week, nor does it include the cash that will flow into the pockets of millions of new workers that will soon be in action. In short, there will be far over a BILLION DOLLARS PER WEEK flowing into the pockets of the public this year.

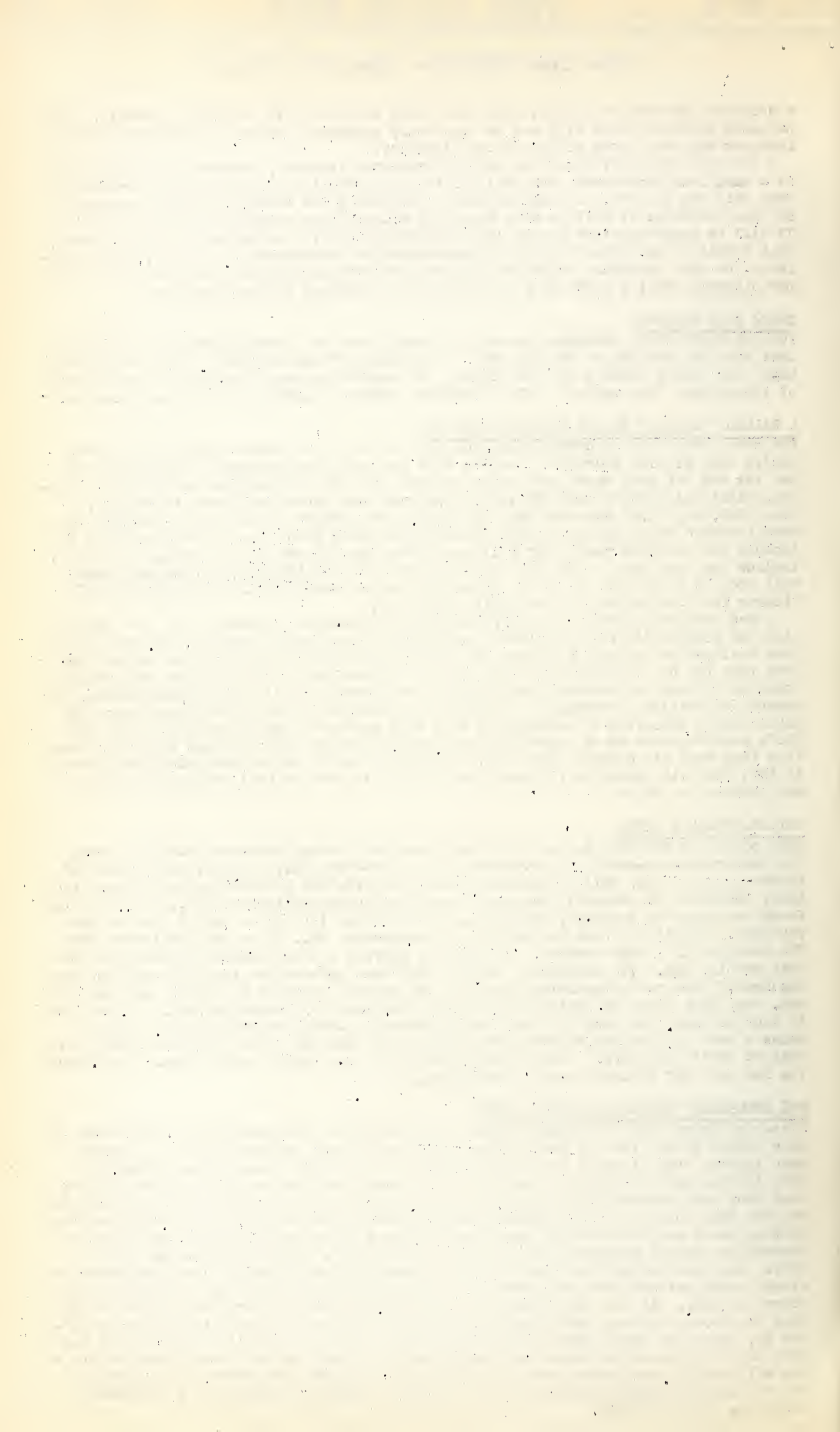
And that means that the members of this coin machines industry will have facing them the possibility of the greatest collections in all their history. The coin machines business is already in a boom and entering into even a greater boom period. The fact that the ban on pleasure driving may go national will also help the coin machines industry, which, as we stated many issues back, because of its unique portability, is capable of bringing economical entertainment directly to the public right where the public wants this form of relaxation. And, with plenty of money jingling in the public's pockets there is no doubt that coin machine men are going to get a greater share than they ever did before. Even now, while this boom is on, coinmen must plan wisely, so that they will have the finances when the war is over to meet whatever conditions and changes may arise.

PAT-ON-THE-BACK DEPT.

This past week The Cash Box received many loud and booming pats-on-the-back. Among the patters-on-the-back were: B. A few of the letters we should like to have you read. Here's one from Roy McGinnis of Baltimore, Md., "I am very satisfied that The Cash Box is a huge success. The idea is perfect - a coin machine publication for coin machine men. Its editorials are the very best information for the people in this business." 30% COMMISSION REMAINS THE ONLY ANSWER

Since our suggestion of coinmen giving their locations 30% commission at this time if they desire to continue in business on a profitable basis we have received a great many letters from all over the country praising us for this suggestion. Naturally, this is flattering. But we're amazed. We're amazed that not one of these men told us that they were starting this plan in their territory even after they agreed it was the one and only solution to the tremendous taxation they are facing, to the fact that operating costs are far over 20% more than they used to be and also that they needed a reserve to protect themselves for whatever would come - especially when the war is over. One noted coinman advised that he had certain "super-doooper" locations where he simply could not cut them down from 50%. That's fine, there must be an exception to prove the rule. If he's making money in these spots (and they are good spots) at 50% then continue to do so. But, what about the "crummy" spots where he's yanking out \$4. and \$5. per week? What about those phono spots where he doesn't get any "top"? And many more like them. Whichever way you'll look at it and whatever your arguments are - you will admit, when you've thought it all out - that 30% commission is the highest you can pay the average location owner to insure YOURSELF remaining in a profitable business. THINK IT OVER.
