CD-ROM, NOW A REALITY!

It finally happened! After a year of patiently waiting for some kind of sign, Sega officially unveiled the long awaited Mega Drive CD-ROM at Toy Fair in Tokyo on June 6, 1991. And after seeing it in action (officially named the Mega-CD-ROM) we were very impressed. It's performance was better than anything we had even hoped for! Having seen it unofficially just sitting on a shelf the day before at the Summer CES, we weren't too excited. It didn't have any buttons, switches or other nice bells and whistles. Just a box with a couple of lights. It didn't look as good as the TurboGrafx CD-ROM.

But when Sega of Japan let us try it out, our opinions changed fast! The demo of the full screen, full motion video was unbelievable! There wasn't a trace of the typical black screen when the unit went back to access more data.

The second demo was an example of how the new processor could do rotation, scaling and zoom all in the hardware. Previously these functions could only be done by a lot of hard work in software programming. We saw the typical Sega logo come screaming across the screen and stop so fast that it compressed itself as if it hit a tree. It then rotated in all three dimensions and smoothly scaled off into the distance.

Segments of some of the upcoming Japanese games followed. A highly detailed Phantasy Star-type RPG, a quest/adventure game with spectacular intermissions and a military simulation were shown. Again, never was there a hint of blackout for the telltale access time. When Sega says they are using a new high speed laser pickup they really meant it!


And to back up all the spectacular demos, the specifications are truly state-of-the-art. Sega waited until NEC committed themselves as to the memory size of their new CD-ROM and then they went one better! Six megabits of RAM is more than adequate for the present and even the fore-seeable future! And the CD-ROM processor clocking out at a blazing 12.5 MHz is unbelievable. Eight channels of PCM sound should easily make voices sound like REAL speech.

A lot of thought and planning went into this super CD-ROM and the lucky Japanese players will get to buy their units in only a month or two! We'll have to wait until Spring to get our U.S. version.

But all this technology doesn't come cheap. Sources indicate that the list price might be around \$370 in Japan. That's a lot of money! But, considering that we're getting a second 16 bit processor in addition to a super fast CD player, the price seems a bit more palatable.



As to the questions: We believe that both the Japanese and American units will be interchangeable. While Sega could make the U.S. unit different, that is highly unlikely. First, the TurboGrafx and PC Engine CD-ROM's will play discs from either country. And second, Sega will most likely want to keep the units the same to reduce production costs. If this is the case, expect the discs to be interchangeable also.

While both the Turbo and Genesis CD-ROM's will play music discs, the operating systems in each machine are different. Discs for the Turbo (or any other CD machine for that matter) will not work on the Genesis. This, unfortunately, includes the CDTV and CD-I discs.


As you can see from the pictures of the first CD games on page 18, the CD's have a lot of Japanese text. Also these games are not the best for the U.S. market. Because of this, Sega of America has decided to hold off releasing the unit without a good supply of high quality games.)

MORE GAME GEAR CARTS!

I think the Game Gear is the best portable system on the market. I have every U.S. game and I plan to buy the tuner as soon as it comes out. Trouble is, there just aren't enough games! I could buy the Japanese carts but I'd rather buy American. Do you see any relief in sight for us loyal GG players?

MEGA DRIVE CONVERTERS

I have some serious Sega questions. First of all, I love your mag. Your coverage of sega is way beyond anyone else's. And that is why I am turning to you for advice. In one of the advertisements in your magazine I read about Mega Drive converters. These allow people with Genesis systems to play Mega Drive cartridges. I then went to a video game specialty store and they said that these converters were unnecessary as a technique called 'shaving' would do the same trick. I know you guys are pros at technical advice. What do you recommend?

(Ed. Good question Rich. Each method has pluses and minuses. The converters are basically just a simple circuit board with a male connector on one end and a female connector on the other end. This extender board raises the Mega Drive cart so that it doesn't have to extend down into the cartridge port of the Genesis. These extender boards are expensive but they are convenient. No modifications to the Genesis are necessary.

The 'shaving' of the cartridge port you mention is cheap but it will void your warranty. If you aren't careful you could also damage the mother board inside the unit. The easiest and safest method is to buy the extender board.)

UNSAFE TRICKS...

I have been getting all of your magazines for almost two years now. I literally memorize everything that you say because my friends look to me as an expert. Much of my expertise, I must admit, comes from reading your magazines.

One thing I have noticed that you never talk about are the tricks that involve popping a Genesis cart and replacing it with another game. Is there a reason why? Will it damage the Genesis? Please answer this question as it's important!

(Ed. Right after we found out about this 'trick' almost two years ago, we contacted Sega and asked them that exact same question. Their response was that they do not recommend removing cartridges while the system is on. The technical experts at Sega of Japan echoed that statement. That is why we don't print those types of tricks. You've paid a lot of money for your system and if it dies it is your loss and not that of the mag who publishes the trick. We believe that there are enough good tricks to publish and we don't have to fill space with tricks that involve questionable methods.)

BITS OR BYTES??

When I hear your magazine and other magazines talk about game memory and system memory, I hear you use the word "megabit". Don't you know that is wrong! Don't you know that the term is actually megaBYTE?

(Ed. Yes and no Mark. Either term is correct if it is converted properly. Computers, which contain and manipulate very large amounts of memory, normally use bytes while game systems and cartridges use the expression bits. Why? Because it sounds better saying a cart has 2 megabits of memory instead of 0.25 megabyte. One byte, as you know, is equal to 8 bits.)

MORE SMS GAMES!

I am a proud owner of a Sega Master System. I own over 40 cartridges and the 3-D glasses. While the Genesis looks nice I am quite content with what I own. But, what my problem is, I am finding it harder and harder to locate new games. I read your magazine and occasionally you show pictures of a new SMS cart but even then it is sometimes months before it appears in the stores, if ever! Is the Master System dead. Do you have any suggestions as to where I can get new games. Is there a wider variety

in Japan? Or how about Canada or England?

(Ed. Granted pickings are a little slim now but the people at Sega are working on adding new titles. Some are being developed in Japan but the best source for new Master System carts is England. There are well over a dozen new SMS games in the stores over there right now. If you can get an English game magazine you could order Dynamite Duke, Impossible Mission 2, Cyber Shinobi, Indiana Jones, Chase HQ, Scramble Spirits and more. The future looks even better as Pacmania, Bonanza Brothers and Alien Storm are coming out soon. Watch for a future issue of Mega Play for an in depth article on the games of England.)


H-TECH SEGA

SEGA UNVEILS MEGA-CD-ROM IN JAPAN!

Sega of Japan unveiled their long awaited Mega Drive CD-ROM drive on June 1, 1991 at the Tokyo Toy Show. Called the Mega-CD-ROM, this new peripheral, will not only increase the usefulness of the existing 16 bit hardware by being able to play music CD's and new high memory games, but it goes beyond all existing CD-ROM technology (Turbo-Grafx) in that it actually works in parallel with the base game machine!

SUPER FAST CPU!

The Mega-CD-ROM is able to do this because it contains it's own 68000 processor. Not only that, but this new chip is running at a clock speed that is over 50% faster than the one found in the Mega Drive/Genesis. The Genesis CPU runs at about 7.5 MHz while the Mega-CD-ROM chip is

running at an incredible 12.5 MHz! In addition this chip will be able to do the game rotation, scaling and zoom functions automatically in the hardware. Previously the Genesis could only do these nifty tricks in the software - a very difficult task for the programmers to build in.

HUGE AMOUNTS OF RAM

One of the reasons why there was so much secrecy about the Mega-CD-ROM was because of what the competition (PC Engine) was doing. Because NEC of Japan was also working on a memory upgrade and a CD-ROM2 project, Sega had to keep it's specs top secret. If NEC found out that Sega was going to put in 6 megabit of RAM then they would have included more. It would have escalated into a 'num-

bers game'. But with everything kept secret, NEC came out with 2 meg and Sega then announced their 6 meg.

SPECTACULAR AUDIO!

Since Sega went all out in the memory department, they didn't want to neglect the audio portion. There is a total of 512k set aside for PCM audio. There can be a total of 8 channels of sound, more than enough to reproduce great music or even voices.

NOT CHEAP!

All of this high technology does not come cheap! Sources in Japan are estimating that the Mega-CD-ROM will list for about \$370. But, since it will do more than just play CD's - it will actually improve the game system, the extra cost will be worth it in the long run. As for the U.S. the unit will remain the same but it will not be brought out until 1992. The price has not been determined either.



NOSTALGIA 1907 TO BE NEW CD-ROM SOFT!


The only playable Mega-CD-ROM game at the Toy Show was a graphic quest/mystery game by Takeru of Japan. Adapted from a computer game, this CD-ROM title puts you on a luxury liner in the year 1907. You must explore the entire ship from stem to stern, examining everything and talking to the all of the people on board. The screen is divided into two parts, with the top half being the visual portion as you would see it through your eyes, while the bottom half contains the text which includes any dialogue with the people and information about the items or clues that you discover.










Other games are in development. Virtually every third party licensee has at least one CD game but only a few were on display. One was a 'hexagontype' battle simulation, a second was an RPG similar in concept to the Phantasy Star series and the third was a quest/adventure soft. Each was only running in a demo mode and unplayable at the show. They are scheduled for a December release in Japan. Because the software is still a ways away from production, Sega of America decided to hold off introducing the Mega-CD here in the states until next year when the software is farther along in development.
