WHAT DOES YOUR DRUGGIST PAY FOR YOUR FAVORITE TOOTHPASTE ?

As the new machine era approaches, many in this industry believe that the time has come for a more confidential inner industry business understanding. The belief that the members of this trade arrange now, and for all time, to come to be as completely secretive about the inner-workings of their business, is no different than what is but commonplace in all industries.

For example, there are only a very, very few, if any, in this industry who know what their druggist pays for their favorite toothpaste. There is no reason why outsiders to his business should know what this druggist pays for his toothpaste. This is one of the druggist's business secrets and should remain so. Only by complete secrecy in this regard can he protect himself as well as assure himself a legitimate profit on his investment.

Likewise, the coin machine man likes to believe that the retailer in whose location he installs his equipment, does not know what the machines cost. At the present time, there are retailers who, tho they do not operate themselves, know just what the machines which are brought into their locations cost the operator and have, because of this, been able to chisel into the legitimate profits to which the operator is entitled.

In a great number of cases this has reached the point where the retailer has purchased machines himself and cut out the operator. It is a well known fact in this trade that when the storekeeper buys direct it takes years to remove the machine from his location. The reason is that even if he earns a lot less with the machine, as it becomes old and worn and loses much of its attraction for the player, what he does earn many times equals what he formerly received on a 50%-50% basis, or whatever other basis he worked with the operator. This has always been one of the most irritating of all problems for the operator.

Many times it takes years of hard work and promotional effort to get a location to the point where the take is such that even the storekeeper himself is surprised. To lose such a location by a direct sale to the storekeeper is a great heartache. But, to know that the storekeeper has as much information regarding the price (the inside price) of the machine as he has, makes it extremely difficult for the operator to continue to obtain the sort of collections he should enjoy for the investment and work he puts into making the location a well paying one.

It is high time, then, that this industry took stock of itself and called a halt to such proceedings. There will always be those few chiselers on the outer fringe of the trade who will make it a business to sell direct to locations, earning a few dollars here and a few dollars there. There will also be one or two, or a few more firms, who will make a business of mailing circulars to locations to incite them to purchase direct. But the average man in this industry today realizes that the volume of the sales in this business are to those men who make operating a distinct and highly specialized profession.

Why, then, should the retailer know the inside prices of machines? The average man in this industry doesn't know what the inside price of the suit he is wearing cost his clothier. Nor does he know what the inside price of the tie or shirt he is wearing cost his haberdasher. Nor does he know what his druggist paid for his favorite toothpaste. Yet, the average storekeeper can tell the man in this business, who earns his livelihood operating, just what his machines can be purchased for, where they can be purchased, and even in what quantity.

In this new post-war era there is going to be enough competition for the present coin machine man from the new blood that is already entering into this industry to force him to keep his eyes wide open and be on his toes every second of his working day. Therefore, he should at least be able to feel that the locations won't be after him, too, as the new machines come into being; when they do come into being.

There are many in this trade who, tho probably without giving it too much serious thought, are helping to, or directly promoting, the further dissemination of such

price news to the retailer thruout the nation. The old story that such coverage will excite and bring new blood into this industry died long ago. It was proved a myth. It is a well known fact that salesmen and distributors who were out to create new blood created it without using any medium that fell into the hands of the storekeepers. Nor did they advise the storekeepers of the prices of the equipment they had for sale.

Surely everyone will agree that the men engaged in this trade at the present time, thruout this country, and in many other parts of the globe, will use whatever equipment the manufacturers will produce for the next two or maybe even three years. There is, therefore, no need to convert storekeepers into operators by advising them of the inside prices of the new equipment which will appear on the market. Most important, such conversion means cutting down on the number of available locations. The best thing that can be done for this industry is to keep its prices its own trade secret, and to selfishly guard that secret. Only by such action will much future trouble be eliminated.

It is also wise for this trade to carefully and logically think of its own future welfare and, in so doing, arrange to keep location owners from knowing the inside facts of its business procedure. The storekeeper, having this knowledge has never before helped the men engaged in this coin machine business, and surely will not help tomorrow. The men in this trade today have too much at stake to have the inside facts of their business made known to their locations. Their investment is not only greater than it ever was before, but the investments which they will have to make will be many times greater than what they ever before invested in new machines.

The men in this business must protect their investments by withholding, in every manner possible, information of their business and the inside price of their equipment from their locations. This protection will also prove necessary when they require a better commission basis for the future, because of increased overhead and cost of equipment. If the storekeeper knows what costs are (the inside costs) it will be impossible for the operator to make any new commission basis arrangement with him.

It is, therefore, up to the men in the industry to eliminate the dissemination of price news to the storekeepers. It is up to the men who have made this business their profession to arrange for a complete halt to any such further harm to themselves.

The best answer to anyone who tells you that such information doesn't mean anything is to point to the various locations in their own communities where the storekeepers own their machines. Also to those other locations where they have been forced to a harsh commission basis because the location owner knows the cost of their machines.

In short, if you don't know what your druggist pays for your favorite toothpaste, why should your druggist know what you pay for the machines you operate in his place of business?

JOBBER AND DISTRIBUTOR RECOGNITION

Exactly one year ago The Cash Box announced the results of a national survey it had conducted to determine just what this industry wanted in the way of jobber and distributor recognition. This survey created a sensation at the time. It was most definitely pointed toward the post-war period.

That period is here today. And the trade is in deeper ferment than ever as regards just who should be recognized as a distributor and a jobber. This is important to this industry for its members seek to respect those men who will be placed in the much desired wholesale division of the trade.

Many times, in the past pre-war era, operators were found in a great many territories who not only overshadowed the jobbers and distributors with whom they dealt, but who also were the largest users and buyers, and in a few cases, even re-sellers of the machines handled by the wholesalers.

The trade has always desired that a distinction be made between an operator, jobber and distributor. Therefore, as the post-war period rushes into full being with the likelihood that the first new machines may be seen late in 1945 or early in 1946, the members of this industry should review the results of this survey and adopt what they believe should be a determination factor for appointing distributors and jobbers.

The highlight results of this survey were as follows:

- 1) 80% of those questioned believed that jobbers should have financial assets of \$25,000 or more.
- 2) 75% believed that distributors should have financial assets of \$50,000 or more.

- 3) 72% agreed that jobbers or distributors in territories of 25,000 population or more should employ at least 2 people in their service and repair force.
- 4) 64% agreed that jobbers or distributors in territories of 50,000 population should employ at least 3 people in their service and repair force.
- 5) 70% agreed that jobbers and distributors in territories of 100,000 population or more should employ at least 4 people in their service and repair force.
- 6) 46% agreed that jobbers and distributors should employ a similar number of salesmen and trouble-shooters.
- 7) 81% agreed that a jobber should have four, five or more years of experience in this business.
- 8) 83% agreed that a distributor should have five, ten or more years of experience in this business.
- 9) 64% agreed that jobbers and distributors should issue semi-annual or annual financial statements.
- 10) 82% agreed that jobbers and distributors should have warehouse facilities.
- 11) 82% also agreed that jobbers and distributors should stock a minimum number of the machines they handle at all times.
- 12) 83% agreed that jobbers and distributors should carry a full line of parts, supplies and accessories for the equipment they handle.
- 13) 46% believed that jobbers should not be allowed to operate.
- 14) 68% believed that distributors should not operate.
- 15) 78% agreed that jobbers and distributors should be allowed to decide who is and who is not a bonafide operator.
- 16) 48% believed that jobbers and distributors should be bonded for \$5,000 or \$10,000 to guarantee all shipments they made and all merchandise they sold.
- 17) 70% agreed that jobbers and distributors should be allowed to join operators organizations if they so desired.
- 18) 71% believed jobbers and distributors should not give credit to operators without financial statements or collateral from the operators.
- 19) 58% agreed that a jobbers' or distributors' service and repair facilities should be made public annually.

From the results of this survey, coirmen will realize that there is a demand thruout the trade that those men who will be the wholesalers of this industry must be the sort of people whom the trade will look up to and respect.

There has been a movement afoot in this trade for sometime to create a national wholesalers council. Such a council is being thought about from the standpoint of creating a code of ethics for all those who will be and are wholesaling, as well as operating the equipment of this industry.

THIRD ANNIVERSARY ISSUE

"TALKING OUT LOUD"

MUSIC SALES INCREASE

Sudden Boom Attributed To Belief No New Machines Will Be Seen This Year. Prices Continue To Hold.

NEW YORK — A sudden boom in music machine sales has come to light and is attributed to the fact that the nation's juke box men do not believe they will see any new equipment this year.

Sales of routes, which seemed to fall off for a while, have picked up again and there are coinmen now ranging far and wide seeking to buy complete routes once again.

Others have been suddenly making offers to buy more music equipment. Late models are in big demand with most buyers paying present prices and more than willing to take whatever quantity is available.

Some music machine buyers are also intent on getting telephone music set-ups. They believe these will outlast the regular juke boxes. These men also feel that wired music is in for a bigger boom, after new equipment starts coming off the production lines, than ever before in its history. They point to the tremendous success enjoyed by wired music during this wartime period.

Also interesting to the music men is the demand that is suddenly coming up from new blood to get into the juke box business. Some advise that they have never before had as many new men call on them to get into the music business. They also state that these men are willing to get started with small routes of present used equipment. "Prices don't halt their buying music", they report.

In buying routes, these men state, they are releasing the later models to the trade for rapid sales. Some are holding on to older models in the belief that these will be the first units to be exported and will obtain better prices overseas.

"The export market", one music leader stated, "is probably going to be the biggest we have ever had in this industry. I wouldn't be surprised if the English market alone buys up all the used equipment we can offer. I also expect that they will match the prices being paid here to get the machines over to London."

Also interesting to the trade in this sudden boom is the fact that collections are reported to be holding up. In many communities they are reported to have increased over what was taken in this past Spring. Some coinmen can point to collections where the take is much higher than it has ever been before.

Operators near resort locations report that the demand from the resort spots is greater than it has ever been before for music equipment. They also state that many new taverns and small restaurants have opened in resort communities and that all of these seek automatic music. Some even offer bonuses to get the latest type machines in their places.

This boom is expected to continue all this year with the climax arriving sometime at the end of the year. The belief is that at that time the manufacturers will know when they will be able to get back into production. So far no manufacturer of music equipment has as yet issued any statement as to when he expects to get back into production.

PHILLY MUSIC MEN WANT TAX COUNCIL

Urge National Tax Council Be Created To Help Music Ops. Believe This Better Than Cleveland Phono Assn. Suggestion For National Phono Assn. Philly License Being Upped.

PHILADELPHIA, PA.—Delegates of the Philadelphia music association who have just returned from the Cleveland phono association meeting report that the discussion on the floor of this meet in Cleveland was for the creation of a national phono ops association.

At the present time, Philadelphia's phono coinmen are of the belief that what is most needed by the music machine men thruout the country is a National Tax Council as urged on this industry by The Cash Box.

Charley Hannum, executive manager of the Philadelphia music association reports that the license increase from \$5.00 per year to \$20.00 per year seems to be going thru, regardless of the efforts that have been put forth by the men in this organization to hold it at the \$5 mark.

"This alone", Hannum reports, "is proof enough that all phonograph men thruout the country are desperately in need of a National Tax Council. This would mean more to the nation's phono operators than anything else which would be suggested or presented at this time."

"Our city isn't the only one that is facing increased license taxation. Other communities in the nation are faced with this taxation problem. This industry needs a national headquarters where we can get the correct help and information we need to fight off this sort of heavy taxing of our business. Let's get a National Tax Council into operation as soon as we can."

Philadelphia phono men also claim that the need for the National Tax Council, as outlined by Charles Hannum at the meetings of their organization, grows greater each week. "And all this", one phono op states, "when our Federal Government claims that taxes should be brought down so that American free enterprise can continue on as it did prior to the war."

Some of the music men here also point to the fact that when this \$20.00 per year license comes into being they will be forced to a different commission arrangement with their locations. They will somehow have to recover this loss of revenue.

And this, they explain, is going to prove a very tough procedure due to the independents now in existence in their city as well as the new blood that is being created to give them competition at this time.

The demand that a National Tax Council be created is sure to meet with the agreement of all other music machine men in the country. This is the general belief of all coinmen in this city.

N. Y. MAJESTIC DIST. CAUSES STIR WITH PHONO SURVEY

NEW YORK — The Colen - Grush Co., Inc., this city, distributors for Majestic radios and records have caused a stir here among phono operators by sending out a survey sheet asking the ops to give them their ideas of what they want in an automatic phonograph for post-war.

M. M. Gruhn of this firm, when questioned, stated that the firm which asked them to make this survey was definitely not the Majestic Radio & Television Co., but was an entirely different firm.

He claimed that he might be able to release the name of the firm which asked him to make this survey sometime this coming week.

The survey is very interesting. The heading is, "Coin Operator's Survey For Post-War Automatic Phonographs". In explanation, it states, "Please assist manufacturers to produce the finest, trouble free instrument possible for post-war use by giving your advice and opinions."

It then continues with: "What improvement do you expect most in a new phonograph?" From then on it outlines the following: New cabinet, materials to be used in the cabinet, trims to be used, finishes, illumination and special features.

It asks what is most wanted in sound equipment, record changer, mechanism, coin, selector, etc. At the same time they offer a large section of the bottom of the survey sheet for any additional remarks.

Operators here became much stirred because of this survey with many immediately believing that the Majestic Radio & Television Company was preparing to enter into the automatic phono-field. Tho Gruhn has denied this, many persist in their belief that this is the fact.

Gruhn also distributes the new Majestic records here and in this regard stated, "We are leaning over backwards to give the coin machine operator the finest service and every record that we can spare."

SPARKS RETURNS UNORDERED MDSE. TO DECCA OFFICE

SOPERTON, GA. — Once again it seems that the Atlanta offices of Decca Records has overstepped itself and shipped merchandise without any order. This time the merchandise was shipped to S. M. Sparks of Sparks Specialty Company, this city, distributors for Seeburg phonos in this state.

Mr. Sparks wrote the Atlanta Decca offices as follows: "We are returning to you by parcel post today 25 Point Needles, which we did not order and which you have billed to us at 32c each, a total of \$8.00. Please send us your check for \$8.00 to cover for these needles as we have paid your C. O. D. of \$36.40 for shipment. Now if it is necessary for you to sell us needles in order to supply us with what few records you send us, we would like to know it."

"We would like to say also that the records you send us have been far from being good and very poor selection. We are supposed to have a standing order for 10 of each new record suitable for our coin-operated phonographs as they come out but we would certainly like to get a little better deal as we have had no good selections in quite a while. Of course, we are very small people and do not expect much service from you but we are distributors for the entire State of Georgia for Seeburg victrolas and the only reason we are not large users of records is because as ethical distributors we do not operate machines in competition to the operators to whom we sell. Our operating business is absolutely nothing and what few records you do send us are distributed in our office to a couple of operators who operate out of here as you have refused to put them on your mailing list."

"Some day this war will be over and we sincerely hope the time will come when you will try to give the operators to whom we sell victrolas a little decent service instead of the way you have been operating."

"All this has been on my chest for quite some time and I might as well get it off now as any time."

COSTS OF \$210 TO FORGET TO PUT PENNIES IN CIG PACKS

NEW YORK - Milton Klein of Victory Vending Co., this city, was fined \$210 in the War Emergency Court here for forgetting to insert the two pennies change in each pack of cigarettes he placed into his venders. An OPA investigator testified that the two cents change had been left out of packs by Klein's service men.

FEDERAL SPECIAL TAX DECLARATION MUST BE MADE BEFORE JULY 31

LOS ANGELES, CALIF. - Samuel (Curley) Robinson of A.O.L.A.C., this city, reminds the trade that the Federal Special Tax Declarations must be made during July, and before July 31. "Every operator should take it upon himself", he writes, "to cooperate with his locations to see that no penalties are necessary and that declarations are made on and before (July 31) due date."

A.O.L.A.C., in its bulletin which is enclosed with Curley's letter, lists the Federal taxes. For coin operated amusement devices, such as pinballs, music machines, ray guns, etc. belong in the \$10 tax category. For coin operated gaming devices, such as slot machines, consoles, etc., machines involving the element of chance, belong in the \$100 tax category. Bowling alleys are in the \$20 tax category. A.O.L.A.C. also enclose a month by month tax breakdown for those ops who will be placing machines after the July 31 deadline.

ATLANTIC CITY CLAIMS BRIGHTEST SEASON THIS SUMMER

ATLANTIC CITY, N.J. - Arcade owners here, who have already had a very pleasant taste of business, believe that this summer season will be the brightest in all their long history. They report that the boardwalk has been crowded even on the gloomiest days. All spots here have actually been surprised at the marvelous play action so far received.

N. Y. COMMERCE ASSN. ENCOURAGES SMALL BUSINESSES TO EXPORT

NEW YORK - A program designed to stimulate import and export business, and place this country in a preferred position for world trade, has been submitted by the Commerce and Industry Association of this city to Senator Claude Pepper, Chairman of the Foreign Trade Subcommittee of American Small Business.

Most interesting in this program is the fact that the Senate committee is encouraging export by small businesses. For example, Article 1 reads: "While encouraging small business concerns to spread their wings in foreign trade, Government should discourage efforts to set up their own export departments, and urge them to sell thru already established export houses."

Many coinmen are interested in exporting, the moment shipping again becomes available, and the fact that the Government will act to encourage small business men to export may prove of great value to this industry from both a protective and speed standpoint. This industry looks forward to one of its most booming developments in the foreign markets.

"DEPOSIT GRABBER" NABBED BY POLICE

ST. PAUL, MINN. - John Jack LaTuff, who used the firm name of Blue Bell Novelty Company, as well as various other aliases, in gypping coinmen from all over the nation, was grabbed by the police here, when he stepped off a train coming in from Chicago. He is now facing a one year workhouse term.

LaTuff proved himself one of the very worst "deposit grabbers" in the history of this business. (The Cash Box was jammed with complaints about him.) So were the Minneapolis and St. Paul police departments. He nicked some Chicago coinmen by using the gag that he was a marvelous mechanic looking for work (after phoning these firms collect long distance) and asked that his fare be advanced so that he could come down to Chi. Once he had the money he disappeared.

His latest actions were to phone various firms about the country collect advising that he had the equipment they were seeking and quoting extremely reasonable prices. He then asked for a deposit, usually of \$200, after which these firms were unable to locate him. It is understood that he grabbed deposits from men in Gary, Ind., Brooklyn, N.Y., New York City, Seattle, Wash., and various other centers around the country.

Newspapers here have headlined the case. LaTuff has a police record that goes back to 1923, according to these newspaper accounts. More and still more complaints are continuing to pour in to police here each day.

EXPECT SHIPPING TO TIGHTEN UP

WASHINGTON - President Truman's report to the nation that there was need of every bit of available transportation space to carry soldiers across country to the West Coast where they could be shipped on to the Pacific battlefronts, has caused concern among shippers that there may be a tightening up of all railroad shipping facilities.

The President has asked that all traveling be cut down to make way for the transfer of approximately 7,000,000 men to the West Coast. If the public will not voluntarily cut down on traveling, he threatens to take matters into his own hands and ration all traveling accommodations. As it is the railroads have been asked to cut all sleeping accommodations 50 percent.

Coinmen will have to make allowance for slowness of all shipments while this transferring is going on, is the general belief among leaders. They will also be asked to order equipment far enough in advance of the time when they believe they will require it so that shipments will come thru as expected.

All war materials will naturally be given first preference and railroads are expected to be taxed to the limit to carry both men and equipment clear across the nation.
