

Note that some companies are showing their products in meeting rooms and hotel suites rather than on the show floor, and advance appointments may be necessary.

(Every effort has been made to ensure this list is as complete as possible, but if you know of a company that was omitted, please contact *Game Player's*.)



Dragon Warrior III from Enix for NES

ACCLAIM (Nintendo Booths 7141-7158, McCormick North): Acclaim is showcasing Wizards & Warriors 3 for the Nintendo Entertainment System (NES). Other NES games on display are Double Dragon III: The Sacred Stones, The Simpsons: Bart vs. The Space Mutants, Trog, Smash TV, and Arch Rivals. Game Boy titles are The Punisher and Bart Simpson in Escape from Camp Deadly. Acclaim SuperPlay Plus hand-held games are Terminator 2: Judgement Day, WWF Royal Rumble, Smash TV, and The Simpsons: Bart vs. the Space Mutants.

ACCOLADE: (Booth 6838, McCormick North): New PC games being previewed are *Mike Ditka Power Football*, *Les Manley II*, *Elvira II*, and a new driving simulation. New Game Boy titles on display are *Asteroids* and *Missile Command*. *Mike Ditka Power Football*, *Turrican*, and *Test Drive* are available for Sega Genesis as part of Accolade's new Ballistic line of 16-bit videogames along with *Hard Ball* and *Star Control*. *Turrican* is also being introduced for Game Boy.





NES titles are *Ultimate Journey*, *Toxic Crusaders*, *Rocketeer*, *Frankenstein*, and *Legends of the Diamond*. *Dick Tracy* is being shown for Game Boy.

**BEESHU** (Booth 6834, McCormick North): Among Beeshu's complete line of controllers, there are new products for NES, Sega Genesis, NEC TurboGrafx-16, PC, Apple, and Commodore. Included are the Zipper, the Zinger, the Zoomer, and the Gizmo for NES. The Ultimate Superstick for NEC TurboGrafx-16 is also on display. Hot Stuff, the

**BONDWELL** (Hospitality Suite, Swiss Grand Hotel): Along with its line of QuickShot controllers, Bondwell is introducing its Super NES-compatible SuperCom 2 and its airplane control stick Intruder series.

**BRITANNICA** (Ad Lib Booth 7046, McCormick North): Educational software includes *Compton's MultiMedia Encyclopedia for Windows 3.0*, also available on CD-ROM, and *The Berenstain Bears Learn About Letters*, a word game for three-to-seven-year-olds. Other education products for children are also displayed.

BRODERBUND (Booth 6231, McCormick North): Broderbund is focusing on the latest adventures of Carmen Sandiego in Where in America's Past Is Carmen Sandiego?. Other PC software is Playmaker Football and The Treehouse, an educational game designed to teach children about music, science, math, and language. Also being showcased is Broderbund's first CD-ROM entertainment software title, Where in the World Is Carmen Sandiego?.

**BULLET-PROOF SOFTWARE** (Nintendo Booths 7141-7158, McCormick North): Bullet-Proof is displaying its puzzle games *Pipe Dream*, for NES and Game Boy, and *Hatris* for Game Boy. Other software titles are *Chip's Challenge* for NES and the multi-player *Face Ball 2000*, for Game Boy.

Mickey's Dangerous Chase, Who Framed Roger Rabbit, Mega Man in Dr. Wiley's Revenge, and Snow Brothers are on exhibit for Game Boy.






