"The Coin Machines Merry-Go-Round" by Bill Gersh

THE FIRST TWO POST-WAR YEARS

Since the announcement by James F. Byrnes, Director of War Mobilization and Reconversion (and by the way, who has just resigned his position because he feels that the war in Europe is nearing its end) there has been a great stir of post-war speculation thruout the industry. Many have once again started their post-war plans back into action with the belief that there will be new equipment available even long before anyone formerly expected to see new machines.

The fact that Byrnes admits there will be an immediate 15% increase in consumer goods production right after V-E day, and that this will gradually (at the rate of 5% for each of the designated periods) be increased eventually to 40%, seems to have convinced many that a sufficient amount of materials will be released to see new products come into being for all industries.

The general concensus is that even the some new machines may be constructed, as the post-war reconversion programs get under way, there will not be enough new equipment to even complete 2% of the present backlog demand in this trade. But all this is as yet speculation, and is based on whether the armed services will release their present hold on all production, thereby allowing manufacturers to go ahead with their reconversion programs.

Everywhere thruout the nation coinmen are certain that the first two years after the war will prove the most prosperous, as well as the most tumultuous, in all the history of this industry. These first two years, as new machines begin to roll off production lines, they believe, will bring about tremendous growth for this field. They are also convinced that during this two year period the rate of growth will be truly remarkable. Operators, jobbers, distributors, manufacturers, supplies and parts firms will pop up from nowhere, in the judgment of many in this trade.

At the same time they are convinced that any machine produced, as long as it will remotely resemble some of the former machines manufactured, will sell. They are sure that the manufacturers will not have to worry about the extent of their first production schedules. They claim that all they want is for the manufacturer to just keep shipping them equipment as fast as he can get it crated and into the hands of the right companies. There is no doubt, from the surveys which The Cash Box has made during these war years, that this will probably prove to be the case.

There is also a very firm conviction that the trade will begin to see the new type post-war equipment even before this two year period is completed. The average coinman believes that for the first six months to a year, after post-war production gets under way, that the trade will only see the same sort of equipment that was manufactured before this war stopped all further production. But they believe that after this period, the new equipment will begin to come to the market, and the men will really begin to get their teeth sunk deep into this business again.

Music coinmen expect to see the most elaborate music systems ever produced. Arcade owners look forward to new arcade equipment which will far outstrip anything ever before built. They also believe that the present arcade will gradually begin to assume the status of "theatres of amusement", as prodicted by The Cash Box a great many months ago.

Sound-on-film units are also being looked forward to, but this time with complete selectivity and featuring the finest performers. As far as the amusement games field is concerned, it goes without explanation that those most interested in this division believe that they will see the sort of equipment they have long dreamed about. This same is true of the merchandising and service machines fields. Therefore this trade is very optimistic over the second period, after the post-war era is well under way.

In addition to all these material facts concerning equipment there is belief thruout the industry that many new sales methods will come into vogue, the gradually

during these first two years after V-E day. When this begins to be noted, some leaders in this trade claim, it will mark the opening of the "adjustment period", as so many business men like to proclaim it. This adjustment period may lead to a great many new innovations in manufacture as well as merchandising. And this is the period that most interests the trade.

There are coinmen who export to see the birth of huge direct sales organizations (to which The Cash Box referred some weeks ago) and which, they further believe, will make operating a complicated problem. The reason they believe such organizations will arise is due to the fact that so many new manufacturers are expected to onter into this industry. These will probably be, they believe, the larger industrialists who have had a taste of this business, others who have surveyed it and those who have been studying it for sometime now.

Because of this there is a belief that closer cooperation with retailers will come into being whon this adjustment period gets under way. There will also be close tie-ins with large retailer organizations, not only by coinmen's associations, but also by individual coinmen who foreseo the advantages of getting ever closer to their customers (the retailers) by entering into efforts for their general betterment.

It has always been among the plans of many retailers' organizations to get the coin machines operators to join with them. This may become fact during this adjustment period. It will prove to be a protective measure designed to offsot the evils of the direct selling organizations.

There is also a forecast that stronger union affiliations may come into being with this adjustment period. This, too, will be due to the fact that the average coinman will require protection in his territory. He will enter into this sort of union effort so that he can continue to rule his operational set-up to his best advantage. At least, this is the general belief of the men thruout the country who have arranged a long term plan for their futures in this business.

Because of all these factors, which now appear so prominently on the coin machines horizon, there are many who feel sure that the suggestions which have been made by The Cash Box during this war period, will at last be undertaken. The belief is more or less prevalent thruout the trade that a National Tax Council will come into being for the protection of the men in this trade. Many point to the fact that a great majority of the nation's leaders have urged a downward revision in taxation. A National Tax Council will prove necessary to help this industry enjoy such revision, or even to make it possible, these men claim.

In addition, a National Credit Bureau will, of its own force and necessity, have to come into being, after this first hectic two year period has passed and the adjustment era is under way. Coinmen need some sort of credit standing to arrange for purchase of large lots of equipment during this adjustment period. A National Credit Bureau should be set up to accommodate this need. It will help both buyer and seller and make easier the course of business for all in this industry.

With the adjustment period starting growing pains of one sort or another into operation in every division of the trade there will also arise a need for a Public Relations Bureau. The growth of the trade is expected to be such that a Buroau of this kind will prove necessary to offset whatever evil publicity may result from the trade stretching out to ever greater prominence. The Cash Box has urged the need for a Public Relations Bureau for all the years it has been engaged in this business.

This adjustment period, which is expected to come into being about two years after production of equipment has been well under way, is therefore the one period that is most puzzling to the men in this industry. They believe that the first two years will be like a wild sleigh ride but after that they will reach the twists, turns curves and bumps that will make sleighing along at so speedy a pace a very dangerous matter.

They are all of the belief that if they can properly adjust themselves, and their businesses, to the new era which will arise after this adjustment period, that they will then gracefully glide along thru a period of peaceful growth and expansion.

They all agree that this trade will, at that time, gain greater national approval and prominence and may even lead the way to many new innovations never before seen in merchandising and amusement technique by this nation.

It is the firm belief of The Cash Box that much of the above is very true, but that there is one factor that a great many have overlooked, and that is the faith that is prevalent in the future of this industry. This faith will transcend all the rough, growing pains. It assures this business its greatest growth, prior and after this adjustment period.

This faith in the future of this industry, held to by so many, makes this business the most attractive of all industries for the years of peace to come.

There are many who are already entering into a period of confusion, even before V-E day has arrived. These coinmen are worried about whether their used equipment will hold up in value, as the factories begin to announce their reconversion plans and possibly even make known what products they will first introduce, when they can obtain the necessary materials with which to construct equipment.

It is therefore best to bring to the attention of such coinmen the belief of many leaders in this industry that used machines will hold up in value for sometime after V-E day.

It is generally conceded that no new equipment will be seen right after the first period of reconversion gets under way, because of the fact that there is as yet a tight clamp on all metals and furthermore because there will be a demand that war workers continue on their jobs until Japan is defeated.

Some believe that immediate large scale dumping of used machines will come into effect right after the first announcements of post-war plans for machines are issued by the manufacturers. Others are of the feeling that many coinmen will try to jump the gun and begin to clear their routes of those used machines which they feel will prove practically worthless in trade-in value. The oldest types of machines will naturally go first. After that the later types. The very last models manufactured, prior to the war, are expected to be held until production of new equipment is at such a point that machines can be easily and rapidly replaced.

There is no doubt that neither WPB nor WMC nor any other government agency will allow releases which will create confusion in this, or any other, trade. The general plan, as noted at this time, is to gradually start into reconversion of the most necessary consumer's goods with luxury andother items taking whatever materials are left.

This may mean that it will require anywhere from six to twelve months, and perhaps even more, for some factories to get into reconversion, or to especially attempt to produce completed products somewhat like the equipment they formerly constructed.

Furthermore, there is still a very tight clamp on vital metals. This means that the average manufacturer in this industry will either have to use metal parts from old machines (which would then create a more or less super-revamp job) or wait until he can obtain the metals and machines necessary to make the parts he will need for the new equipment he wants to construct.

As this period gets under way, tho, there are many who claim that dumping of much used equipment will start, more or less because of hysteria to get rid of older machines, than for any sound or logical reason. These men claim that it is but "human nature" and to be expected at such a time.

There are firms who intend to buy much of this used equipment for export purposes. They are convinced that Great Britain and other nations will immediately open their doors to receiving all types of goods should a dumping wave come into being in this nation.

Generally, tho, the concensus is that this dumping period will prove to be very spasmodic. It will stop when coinmen realize that it may be many months before they will be able to get new machines to replace what they have sold.

No coinman will want to leave locations without machines as the reconversion period gets under way. The average operator knows today that his location is all-important. He has learned, during this war period, that regardless of the age or condition of the equipment he had in the location, it continued to earn him handsome profit. Therefore he doesn't want to jeopardize locations by leaving thom without machines. Competition is already growing keen.

And, what is more, no one knows what his best locations will prove to be when the post-war equipment gets into the market. Spots which were formerly designated as "fair" and even "poor" carners, may prove to be the best money-makers with this new type machines.

Therefore, the average man in this industry, regardless of whatever dumping mood may seize him in the belief that he is better off with the cash than with some of his equipment, will probably allow this mood to pass when he realizes that his locations mean his livlihood.

"TALKING OUT LOUD"

EXPORT OF MACHINES BIG PROBLEM

DELAY FOR LONG PERIOD AFTER V-E DAY WILL LOWER DOMESTIC MARKET PRICE OF USED EQUIPMENT

NEW YORK CITY—With the war in Europe drawing to a victorious conclusion, many coiumen are casting their eye at the foreign markets, particularly that of England. A vast buyer of used equipment before the war, England is looked upon as a potential market for many thousands of machines, both new and used.

This foreign market may have a tremendous influence on the market price of equipment here as coinmen are of the opinion that they will be able to export the older machines and obtain fairly good prices. Should these machines remain on the domestic market, the used machines prices will certainly react downward.

The problems involved in shipping machines overseas may make it impossible to export for quite some time after V-E day. It is admitted that the first shipments to foreign countries will be essentials, leaving coin operated equipment far down the list. They will have to wait until shipping space is available, and that might be for quite some time.

In addition, there is the problem of securing payment for these machines. At the present time, all monies are "frozen" in each country's banks, and nothing can be shipped out without the permission of the country. These countries will want to see that this money is spent only for essential goods, particularly as they do not have too much to use for foreign exchange. Then again, these European countries admit they wish to have as many items manufactured in their countries to take care of the employment problems that are sure to exist after the end of the war.

European coinmen are sure to expand their manufacturing proclivities over what it was before the war, and we understand some of these coinmen have representatives here now working to interest manufacturers to permit them to manufacture under American patent rights on a royalty basis.

However, export of equipment may come about more rapidly than could ordinarily be expected due to the keen interest some

banking interests have taken in our business. One of the great banking institutions of England had representatives in this country studying the business a few years ago with the intention of financing pur-chases from American chases from American firms. If these bankers have a fund of money banked in this country, or the recommendations of the Dumbarton Oaks Conference providing for foreign loans are agreed upon, the problem of payment in foreign exchange would be eliminated. The bankers could draw against this fund without going thru the red tape of getting permission from foreign countries to ship money here for payment of equipment.

If the above condition exists on the arrival of V-E day, coinmen can look forward to an early export business, depending upon shipping space available. Otherwise, it would appear as if the export market will have to await government release of foreign money for so called luxury items.

CIGARETTES ON POKER TABLES BRING BLAST FROM PRESS

NEW YORK CITY—During the past month, operators using cigarettes as prizes on Poker Tables, Diggers, etc. have been criticized by the public, politicians and press. With the regular suppliers of cigarettes showing empty shelves, it has been made to appear that players of so called "gambling machines" can win a carton if he's lucky enough.

Poker Table operators are more prominently in the public eye. Altho they can obtain cigarettes on a strict quota (a certain percentage of what they used the year before) large displays of these cigarettes, and apparently handing them out to winners, is drawing quite a bit of unfavorable publicity. In Atlantic City, a week ago, a complaint brought about considerable "Heat". Newspapers carried stories of Poker Table winners who claimed they spent as high as \$20.00 to win a carton.

Due to unfavorable publicity

Due to unfavorable publicity in New Orleans, La. over the theft of some slots the press went to work on the operators. One paper photographed a Digger containing packages of cigarettes, and painted arrows at them. Under the photo appeared this paragraph "SMOKES—BUT NOT FOR SALE"—Cigarettes reappeared in the downtown business section Monday, but there was a catch, they were in iron claw machines, and smokers had to take a chance on their skill".

Poker Table operators would find it practically impossible to run without cigarettes, but it would be to their advantage if they operated cautionsly and carefully. Other types of equipment would do well to eliminate cigarettes entirely, as it might lead to the same unhappy condition that prevails in New Orleans.

NO NEEDLES — NO RECORDS

BRATTLEBORO, VT. — Hal L. March, Brattleboro, Vt. received the letter reprinted below from his record distributor Roskin Bros., Albany, N. Y. on March 28. "Upon checking your purchases since the first of the year, we note that you have failed to purchase coin operator needles from our firm. We have made every effort to supply you with popular records, and in turn we feel it is only fair to receive a fair share of your needle business. We sincerely hope you will see our position in this matter."
