


"The Coin Machines Merry-Go-Round"

30% COMMISSION IS ANSWER TO TAX PROBLEM



Practically every coinman is still working with his locations on a 50% commission arrangement. At the same time he is attempting to continue with the same type of service he always gave, regardless of the fact that today gas and tires are rationed, help is scarce and expensive, overhead generally has tremendously increased, taxes are piling one on top of the other, depreciation is greater than it ever was and all parts and supplies are going up somewhere into the inflationary sky, when they can be obtained. In general, the expense of running a route in '43 is just about 20% greater than it was in '41.

Well, then, why not stop kidding yourself? The next fellow in your territory isn't any too anxious to take on any new locations. There are no new machines or even large quantities of used machines in the market to frighten you with loss of locations. You will also admit that you, yourself, aren't any too anxious about grabbing any more locations. You probably don't care if you remain "as is" for the duration. Well, then, why in the world, with all these additional expenses, with all the headaches and heartaches you are facing, why not, at a time like this do something that will help you for tomorrow and for the future? Why not cut down to 30% commission to the merchant? This is one of the best chances you'll ever get to do so.

Don't just try a gradual cut. It won't work. The merchant will stand for one, maybe two cuts, but, no more. Do it all at once and get it over with. Start with spots you're not too interested in anyway. I feel that you're going to be pleasantly surprised if you do this diplomatically, intelligently and practically. And, if you do it right, you'll first call together all the others in your territory, hold a meeting, show them the increased expenses and taxes that they are facing, show them where they are paying even more than 20% additional to operate today and get them to cooperate. Remember too, that these new license fees and taxes are only a beginning. Your locations are paying higher prices today for their regular lines of merchandise and they'll pay the difference in your line, too.

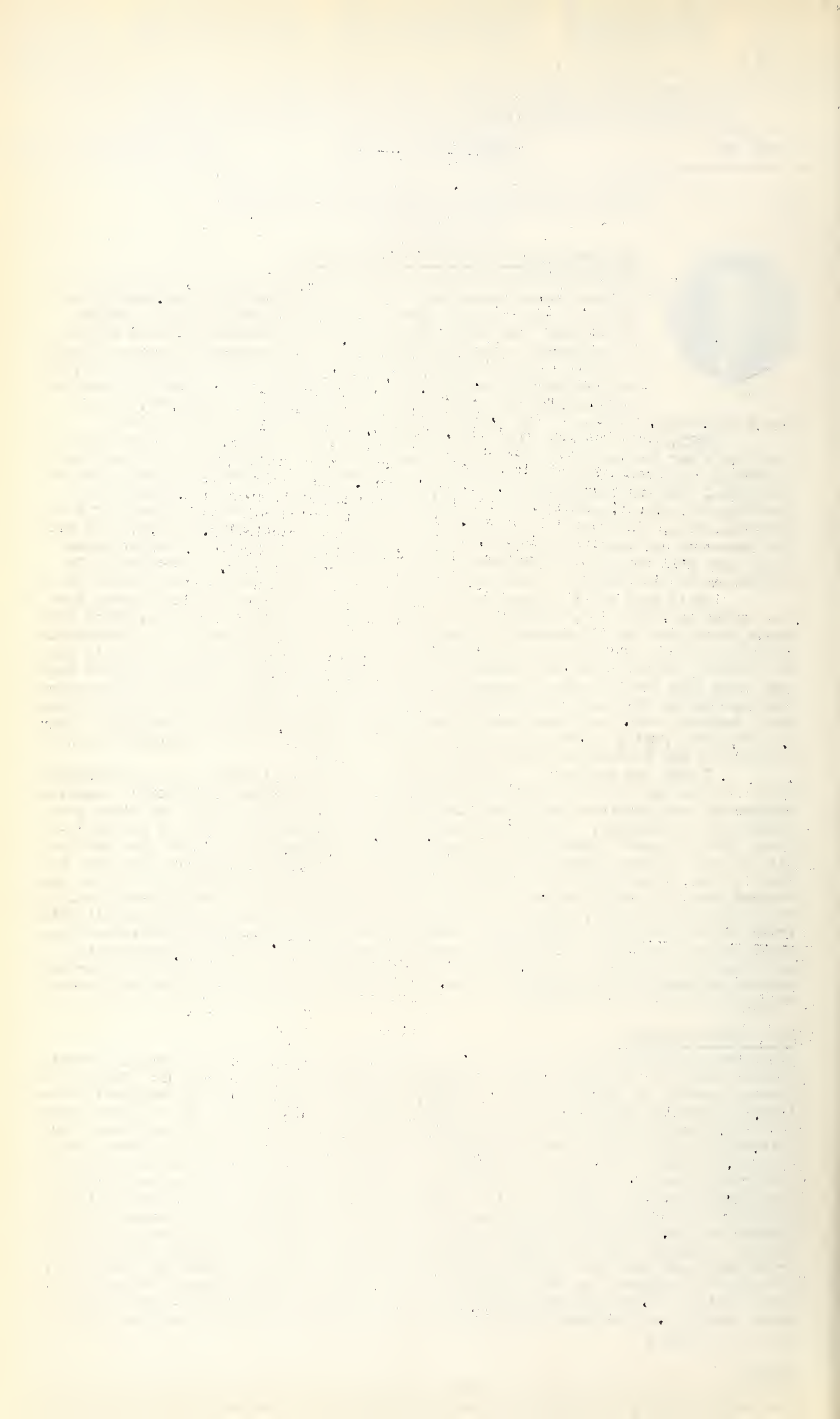
I KNOW you can do it. I also believe that you will agree with me IT MUST BE DONE. I also feel certain that you will agree that the Federal Government's taxation program on coin machines was an open invitation to every city, county and state government to do likewise. Therefore, rant and rave and tear your hair, if you so desire. But, if you're smart, you'll start cutting commissions, for this open invitation to even greater taxation of your business by the Federal Government was also a boon to you. It gives you an opportunity that is the one and only way out of the increased taxation problem without attempting to fight your local taxation agencies. If you attempt such court fights at this time you'll simply incur the enmity of all citizens who are willing to pay greater taxes to win the war and who will therefore consider you in a very poor light as a patriot. But, you can still keep from losing money and help yourself for tomorrow and for the future, too, by getting together now, cooperating now, and cutting the necessary 20% from commissions now being paid locations to preserve your business.

MOVE THAT CIG VENDOR

Move that cigarette machine out of a non-essential location, if you can, into what can be termed an "essential" spot. Cigarette rationing is on the way in. Harley Jefferson, head of the tobacco section of WPB, told the convention of the National Association of Tobacco Distributors at the Hotel Commodore in New York City this past week that there would be rationing of cigarettes and tobacco by the end of this year. Mr. Jefferson claimed that he would oppose the rationing of cigarettes and tobacco products as it would not aid the war effort. He termed cigarettes vital to the morale of the armed forces and civilians. (Estimates at this meet indicated that over 235 Billion cigarettes were produced in '42. The figure is expected to reach 250 Billions in '43.) Regardless of Mr. Jefferson's statement about "opposing" the rationing of cigarettes, move that cig vendor of yours to a much more "essential" location. And do it now. Remember that the Federal Government believes that cig machines are doing a grand job. And they are. Therefore you really have some good support to start with. Now carry it further. So that regardless of whatever rationing program may be instituted you'll be fully prepared by being able to present an "essential" set of locations whereby your machines will obtain the necessary quantity of cigarettes to protect your income.

ARCADES

We wonder do you realize that the arcade equipment shortage is the one and only reason that arcade growth, to the greatest record proportions in the history of this industry, is being held up. Tho the number of arcades started to tremendously increase late in

'41 their growth would have been more than doubled this year were it possible for all those who desire to open arcades to obtain the necessary equipment to do so. We have met with and spoken to a very large number of coinmen in the past few weeks regarding the arcade business. These men were very anxious to get into this field. The arcade equipment shortage held them back. They weren't at all worried about the big prices being asked for arcade machines. They were chagrined by the fact that even at these prices they could not pick up the machines necessary to start an arcade in the proper fashion. It is a lamentable fact that we would probably have the largest number of arcades in all our history and perhaps even see the birth of many new business ideas for the future were we able to supply the present demand for arcade equipment.

TAX GREMLINS WORRY SHREVEPORT

We are in receipt of a letter from a Louisiana subscriber telling us that Shreveport's coinmen are worried by the "tax gremlins". They pointed out to this subscriber that they will be paying \$175.00 per pinball per year because of City, County, State and Federal taxes. We suggest that those men read the opening article in this issue, And ACT ON IT!!

INVITATION ACCEPTED

We received another invitation to address a group of coinmen. We're going to accept it even tho it means a trip of some hundred miles. It seems, according to the subscriber who extended the invitation to us, that he had visited with this city's leading coinmen and while discussing various problems with them had shown them some of the items which have appeared in past issues of The Cash Box. These men were so impressed, he writes us, that they asked him to invite us to speak at their next meet. Making us some sort of a "star attraction", so to speak. We're going. And we're going to talk straight from the shoulder. We hope to leave those coinmen with a lot of good thoughts to better conditions for all concerned.

PRICES

Prices are climbing skyward with a vengeance. As we predicted in our "1942 Market Report" which appeared in our New Year Special issue, this would continue to be the case until sometime in Spring when prices would establish an all time high. Late model consoles and slots have climbed to unprecedented heights. As far as the late model 1-Ball Free Plays are concerned, these are almost unobtainable at any price and prices being offered for these at this time as "used" machines are greater than what they listed for originally as brand new games. Also note that the latest model 5-Ball F.P.'s have also practically disappeared from the market. Even the so-called "secondary numbers" have started to go away up in price. This is as yet slow getting started but, it will gain momentum as the later machines disappear and the result will be that coinmen will be completely satisfied with these "secondary" 5-Balls for their locations. Opening of such towns as Pittsburgh, Pa. which came about this past week (and probably followed by the rest of Pennsylvania) will eat into existing stocks of pinballs.

Prices of tubes are impossible to control anymore, tho generally, the supply is still good. Much hoarding of machines, supplies and parts has also been greatly responsible for price increases. Many types of parts are becoming extremely difficult to obtain. Such an item as 30-Wire Cable is practically extinct in some territories. Used cable of this type, in piece lots, is now being sold and commands a very heavy price.

Even with all this the trade haven't as yet tapped many good sources for income. The counter games still await the touch of some genius to place them in the \$10. per year tax category and thereby open a vast, new field for revenue. Diggers are still being overlooked by many. Remember that diggers with a "silver dressing" are tremendous money getters. Much other equipment should also receive better promotion.

The trade is a bit too intent at this time in what the other fellow suddenly demands. Branch out. Be more individualistic. Get into action with the sort of equipment the other man may be neglecting. The opportunities are there today. Remember, too, that as the weeks go by and the warm weather begins to arrive that we shall probably be facing the highest price period in our history. Also remember that certain types of resorts are going to open this summer regardless of gas and tire and other rationing and that these too, will want machines.

Only by a complete expansion into every possible type of equipment can we bring about some sort of price stabilization for this industry. Your steadiness at this time, your lack of profiteering, your fine example to others, you, yourself, and only you, can help keep prices down to a reasonable level.

HERE'S PETRILLO'S OWN PROPOSAL

You, as a subscriber and reader of The Cash Box know that for a great many weeks now we have been intensive in our effort to bring about a complete settlement of the recording ban as far as coin operated music equipment is concerned. You also know from articles printed here that we are not interested in transcriptions or in radio or in any other industry - but the coin machines industry. You also know that The Cash Box came to the forefront three weeks ago and asked that every single phono operator in the country help us in our effort to bring about a settlement with Local 802, American Federation of Musicians. You, who have been reading the articles here also know that The Cash Box, at its own expense retained an attorney in New York to help us in our effort so that we would not overstep the legal line.

Friday afternoon, from his AFM headquarters at 1450 Broadway in New York City, James C. Petrillo of Local 802, AFM, stepped forth with his proposal for a peace plan. Mr. Petrillo will be meeting on Monday at 2 P.M. (just when you receive this issue of The Cash Box) at his Midwinter executive meeting of the Board of AFM with the following concerns to determine whether his plan can bring about a peace: National Association of Coin Operated Phonograph Manufacturers, RCA Victor, Decca, Columbia, Muzak, World Broadcasting System, Empire Broadcasting System and Minoco Studios.

His plan (tho not openly termed as yet) is to obtain a fee from every coin operated phono playing records made by the members of AFM and also a "piece" from every record manufactured. He divides the "juke boxes" as follows: the regular "juke box", telephone music, soundies. In short, as you can note here, Petrillo has made a very close and keen study of what the term "juke box" actually implies. He has proposed as follows: "The federation shall receive from the manufacturer (of records) a fixed fee for each side of musical recordings made by members of the American Federation of Musicians, such fee to be agreed upon by negotiation. "Juke Boxes": The federation shall receive annually for each juke box used a fixed fee, such fee to be agreed upon by negotiation."

A great many problems will enter into these discussions - whether this is breaking the "wage stabilization" agreement and whether Washington will consider it so. Other problems will also enter into the negotiations which will start Monday at the offices of AFM in New York City which it is the hope of this entire industry the phono manufacturers will carefully weigh in regard to what the operator needs. It is our belief that these men, who know our industry and its problems and are guided by the leading distributors, jobbers and operators, will fight like the very devil to make sure that the operator is not taxed out of business.

A bigger problem will be for the operators themselves. There is no doubt now that the record manufacturer will have to pay an additional sum on each recording. But, will he slap this onto the cost of records today (which have already gone up from what they were in former years) and will this therefore be a "hidden tax" in addition to the yearly fee paid on each individual phono to the AFM - if such is agreed upon. There will be something to watch and to watch for carefully.

Petrillo's "out" is as follows, and as reported in the New York Times, "Mr. Petrillo said that the money received from the record manufacturers and 'juke box' operators, in the form of a fee on each disk sold and on each phonograph in operation, would go to a special fund administered by the union's national headquarters and would be spent as follows: For the purpose of reducing unemployment which has been created in the main by the use of mechanical devices, and for fostering and maintaining musical talent and culture and music appreciation, and for furnishing free, live music to the public by means of symphony orchestras, bands and other musical combinations."

The Cash Box is strictly and solely and completely interested in the welfare of the automatic music equipment operator. Its plans have always been to work out ways and means for the operators to better benefit from their businesses. It is the sincere and earnest hope of The Cash Box that if and when these negotiations are completed that they will be of complete benefit to the automatic music equipment operator from the standpoint that he will get the best possible deal that can be made in his behalf. We have stated many times in the past, "it is easy to kill the goose that lays the golden eggs". There is no doubt that the term "goose" is most appropriate in this case. As we have stated time and time again - there should exist a national organization of automatic music equipment men not only for this job which is now being done, but, most important for the detail work that will follow this "peace" when it comes into being.
