"The Coin Machines Merry-Go-Round"

COIN MACHINES INDUSTRY - TOMORROW

Leaders in this industry who look ahead are attempting to gauge just what the effect will be on the trade when the soldiers and sailors, who were former members of this industry, return to its ranks once again and probably bring back with them, to also enter into this business, some of the many friends they will have made while in the service.



These boys will have received an extremely liberal world traveling education. North Africa, Europe, Asia, all the continents will be as familiar to most of them as will their own home towns. No longer will they think of Casablanca as a mystic city many thousands upon thousands of miles away. They now look at distance by the "time" it takes a speedy plane to fly and not by the "miles" covered. These boys are going to have a very different idea of this world and trade generally. They are also going to have a better understanding of speed, distance and especially a clearer knowledge of the time element. They will have learned how to act as a team and therefore how to get most out of little.

These men are going to be the lifeblood of the coin machines industry - tomorrow. They are the ones who will eventually guide the destinies of this and all other business. Their youth, their new outlook, and the many lessons and experiences which they will have had, are certain to inject a new stimulation into industry which will, without any doubt, require those men now engaged in this business to step up the tempo of their present action to meet the speed with which these men have learned to act.

There is also no doubt that as returned soldiers they will feel that this nation owes them the advantages which they were forced to neglect and for which they gambled their lives. And will perhaps, upon re-entering this industry, demand greater consideration and liberality and understanding from local and national authorities. This is extremely important. The returned soldier entering into the ranks of the coin machines industry will, by the very fact that he was one of our victorious army, help bring greater respect and consideration to this industry.

Yet, all these are but the elementary considerations which the leaders of this industry are thinking about at this time. They believe that the returned service man is going to be the one to foster not only greater respect and better business methods but make this industry an international business which will win for it greater financial backing. This, too, as we all realize, is of great importance. The necessary financial backing to make this industry greater than it ever was will require the best sort of business men and the finest sort of business ethics.

The returning soldier will find in the coin machines industry unusual opportunity. This industry can greatly benefit from his entrance into it. Already some of the outstanding jobbers, operators, manufacturers and distributors are planning to make room to receive them. Among these soldiers are destined to be the leaders of tomorrow. This is the "new blood" that this industry will need to keep it away from any possible stagnation point.

It isn't just the creation of a new operator that makes "new blood". The percentage of fatalities of men newly entering into this business is staggering, to say the least. With thought of the future in mind, with the need for an injection of new blood stimulation, this industry, at least many of its better minds, are carefully considering the employment of returning soldiers. These will be the men of the future. The men who can make this industry greater and more prosperous than it ever was before. Who can, with the public's good will behind them, cause this industry to reach that peak of prestige no other "new blood" has ever before brought to it.

REVIEW L'AFFAIRE PETRILLO

For sometime now The Cash Box, since its first spirited editorials, has kept silence regarding the now famed L'Affaire Petrillo, as we like to designate it. (It reminds us of those French "incidents" which started with but a word or two and almost caused the collapse of the nation.) So did L'Affaire Petrillo begin, too. A word or two from James Caesar Petrillo and the men engaged in this business and in the radio and record manufacturing industries were squelched.

As far as the coin machines industry is concerned (which is the one and only and exclusive concern of The Cash Box) L'Affaire Petrillo is becoming more serious each day. The fact that this past week a report came thru that a conciliator was to be appointed in an attempt to work out the differences between Petrillo and the record manufacturers made very, very little impression upon us.

The further fact that we hear the record manufacturers never before gloried in such great prosperity also makes little impression upon us. Because these manufacturers have been able to clear away millions of old records which were stored away in warehouses as "flops"; the fact that they have no contracts working with recording stars at this time and that this is saving them many thousands of dollars; the fact that the resultant scarcity of recordings has created a terrific demand and that they are cashing in by pressing old masters and selling them to the larger retail outlets; the fact that they told Petrillo in their now famous letter to him that the "juke box" was his (Petrillo's) concern; the fact that they are today manufacturing records that are, to say the very least, anything but good, but which can be attributed to the fact that such a tiny percentage of shellac is being used; the fact they do not seem to care to settle L'Affaire Petrillo in a hurry because they are enjoying a tremendous sales boom and couldn't manufacture any more records anyway, so that Petrillo even if he were getting something from each record wouldn't be getting much; the fact that they feel that because of these unusual wartime conditions they can hold out as long as Petrillo can and perhaps even longer; the further fact that they are telling the men engaged in this industry that they are trying their best to bring about some sort of a settlement and throw all the blame to Petrillo; and many, many other facts that add up to absolute zero does not produce records for operators of automatic music equipment.

With all these facts before the average music man it is still most conspicuous that no one has gone to bat for the music operator. There hasn't been a single meet with Petrillo of any group directly engaged in this coin operated music machines industry to hear what he has to say. We have been told that certain operators and association heads believe that is not their affair. "Let the record manufacturers settle it" they say. Some even are of the belief that things are better now that they can't get records (for they claim to be earning more for themselves) than ever before. This still does not solve the problem for the greater majority. Here is someone who came into the automatic music picture and took a wallop at it and succeeded in hurting it terribly. The fact that he did so far succeed leaves the way open for others to try a wallop or two. (ASCAP is trying now.)

This time The Cash Box leaves the matter before its many readers thruout the nation and asks them what they believe should be done for their benefit as regards L'Affaire Petrillo.

WAR DOUBLES AVERAGE INCOME

One of the most outstanding reasons for the present greater earning power of coin operated equipment can be directly attributed to the fact that the war has doubled the average income. Whereas the average monthly earnings of the nation as a whole was \$47.92 in July, 1940, it is now \$85.03 in April, 1943. (These figures have just been released by OWI.) As OWI further explains the average monthly military expenditure from this earned income in July, 1940, was \$1.50 per person and today it is \$53.52.

Yet with all this removal from his average income, the average worker has much more money to spend than at any other time in the history of this nation. This doubled income has created a great many more seekers for amusements of one type or another in an endeavor, not so much to spend off excess earnings, but to obtain the necessary relaxation due to the fact that the work is so much more taxing to the average individual. The coin machines industry, because of the economical entertainment it offers, has fitted perfectly into the present scene. It has not only won a larger following but continues to take the smallest share of the average entertainment expenditure and yet finds that on the whole its earning power has been tremendously increased.

As the average monthly income continues to rise, due to the fact that such items as refrigerators, automobiles, radios, etc., are not being made and are therefore not purchasable, the coin machines business will continue to find its earning power constantly increasing to take part of the overage which comes about with such inflated salaries.

That is why The Cash Box has constantly urged its readers to create a financial reserve for themselves which will prove most necessary when the war is won and new equipment (probably more expensive equipment) will be brought to market. This is one of the most unique and profitable eras in all coin machines history. Those coinmen who are carefully guiding their businesses and just as intelligently accumulating a post-war reserve, will be the ones who will benefit most from this present doubled average income.

DOWN TO 40% COMMISSION

For some months now The Cash Box has explained why the coinman should cut down to 30% commission to his average location. He will find upon close accounting investigation that his operating costs have risen approximately 20% and that with additional taxation it is absolutely necessary for him to get the average location to accept 30% commission so as to assure himself continued profit and a possibility to accumulate a strong financial reserve.

It was also explained that there were certain locations which, because of the big take being enjoyed, could be continued on a 50% commission basis. But as was also pointed out these were far in the minority and that the average location did not deserve more than 30% commission at this time. By scaling down the average spot to 30% commission the effect would not only be for today but would also be far reaching for the future.

This past week we were in receipt of a letter from a noted midwestern coinman who advised he has called together all the coinmen in his territory (as proposed by The Cash Box) had read them some of our editorials on the 30% commission plan and also explained the need for a 100% agreement for all present to scale down to this 30% commission basis as a solid unit.

He now reports to us that the meetings were highly successful. The men did not believe that an instantaneous drop to 30% was necessary. (This was also many months ago proposed by The Cash Box. The suggestion was made that in some cases to fit the peculiarities of certain territories the drop be gradual, but that in most others it could be made at once.) The men at this meet did agree however, he writes, to get down to 40% commission. And today, he continues, this is working out beautifully.

He also reports that tho their plans are not to cut down again very soon they are already discussing the additional 10% cut and when to bring it about. This will place an entire territory in the midwest on a 30% commission basis to the locations. These men are seeing real profit at 40% and will naturally see even better profit at 30%. They will have well prepared themselves for the post-war era so that when the new equipment does come out they will be able to continue to operate at 30% and pay off their machines so much faster and thereby so much more rapidly enjoy profit.

The Cash Box, most naturally, takes pride in this event. But it does not pat itself on the back because of it. It feels that this is but a successful start to something which has been necessary for this industry for a great many years. To insure the profit factor for this business for tomorrow this 30% commission to the average location should be placed into effect by agreement among all coinmen in each territory.

If each reader of The Cash Box will do as this midwest coinman did and call a meeting in his place of business of all the local coinmen and explain the necessity for bringing the average location commission down to 30% not only for today, but also for tomorrow, and succeed in so doing, then The Cash Box will feel that it has accomplished a very fine purpose and has helped to make this industry strong.

THOUGHT FOR TODAY

As a reminder of the lead editorial that appeared in our July 13 issue entitled, "It Can Happen Here", we bring this saying of Benjamin Franklin, "Let us beware of being lulled into dangerous security...of being weakened by internal contentions...for these are circumstances which give confidence to enemies." And once again we want to recall to all coinmen that because there has been very little (if any) adverse publicity in regard to coin operated equipment for sometime now, that blue-noses, politicians and publicity seeking officials can turn about rapidly, and IT CAN HAPPEN HERE.
