"News from the Underworld"

• LONDON'S UNDERGROUND

London City probably got Europe's biggest and oldest Underground subway network. Despite of that, we still see only very few flicks of pieces done on the famous London's «tube»... which doesn't mean nothing's going on anymore ! It seems that a handful of crews still dare to face the danger : DDS crew (SHUTO, RATE, SUB, YEAH, FUME, FIG...) GFS CREW (SNAG, MEF, PIES...), BNB (EINE...), AWE crew (DODO, FLIES, JAPH, LAZY...) are the main & most active writers, who share themselves a system of 11 different subway lines + 26 lay-up's and yards. Nevertheless it's getting harder to paint the subway week by week : 10 to 15 foot high fences with razor wires, security guards, cameras, heat-movement sensors along the trains and the graff squad ready to raid at any moment, these are the usual obstacles you have to deal with to get the piece done ! ■

• MANGA ZONE

This summer, the city of Paris experienced a new and original kind of artistic exchange : a few writers from Paris invited themselves to Tokyo (Japan) in order to test their graffiti skills on the local steel, while writers from Tokyo came to Paris to check out the Eiffel Tower, and of course the world's famous «St. Lazare» train line. The result is there : trains got hit in both case ! The main difference : subway & train pieces in Tokyo got buffed 10 minutes later, while the train pieces in Paris ran up to one week... ■

• HELSINKI WARS

Some of the craziest and fiercest styles of Europe come straight from Helsinki... but nowadays Finnish writers really have to fight to achieve their graff missions... Since the beginning, Finnish people hate graffiti : there are no legal walls, no commissions, no authorized graff events there : it's a real war going on between the writers and the authorities. While the kids use cop-names in their pieces («Mika Kaski», «Petri Lokka»...), the cops themselves cross out the pieces of the most active bombers, writing over the real names of the writers ! this year many joys of the city have been talking to the police, which led to house

searches, anti-graffiti campaigns in newspapers and even jail sentences for the most wanted guys. Of course all trainyards are now highly guarded, and the buffers are even cleaning the walls on the lines... But the FM, FTC, CDC guys and many others won't give up... To all snitches out there, and to the pigs in blue (who read XG for sure) : FUCK YOU ! ■





"T.e.r. Terrorism"

Contrary to Paris inhabitants, most of the people who live in the French countryside don't need to take the train everyday, so writers didn't come naturally to trainbombing; many of them remain mostly interested into destroying their own city, rather than the regional T.E.R. train system. Meanwhile, some writers caught the train disease, and now need a regular steel injection... the TER network is the remedy!






