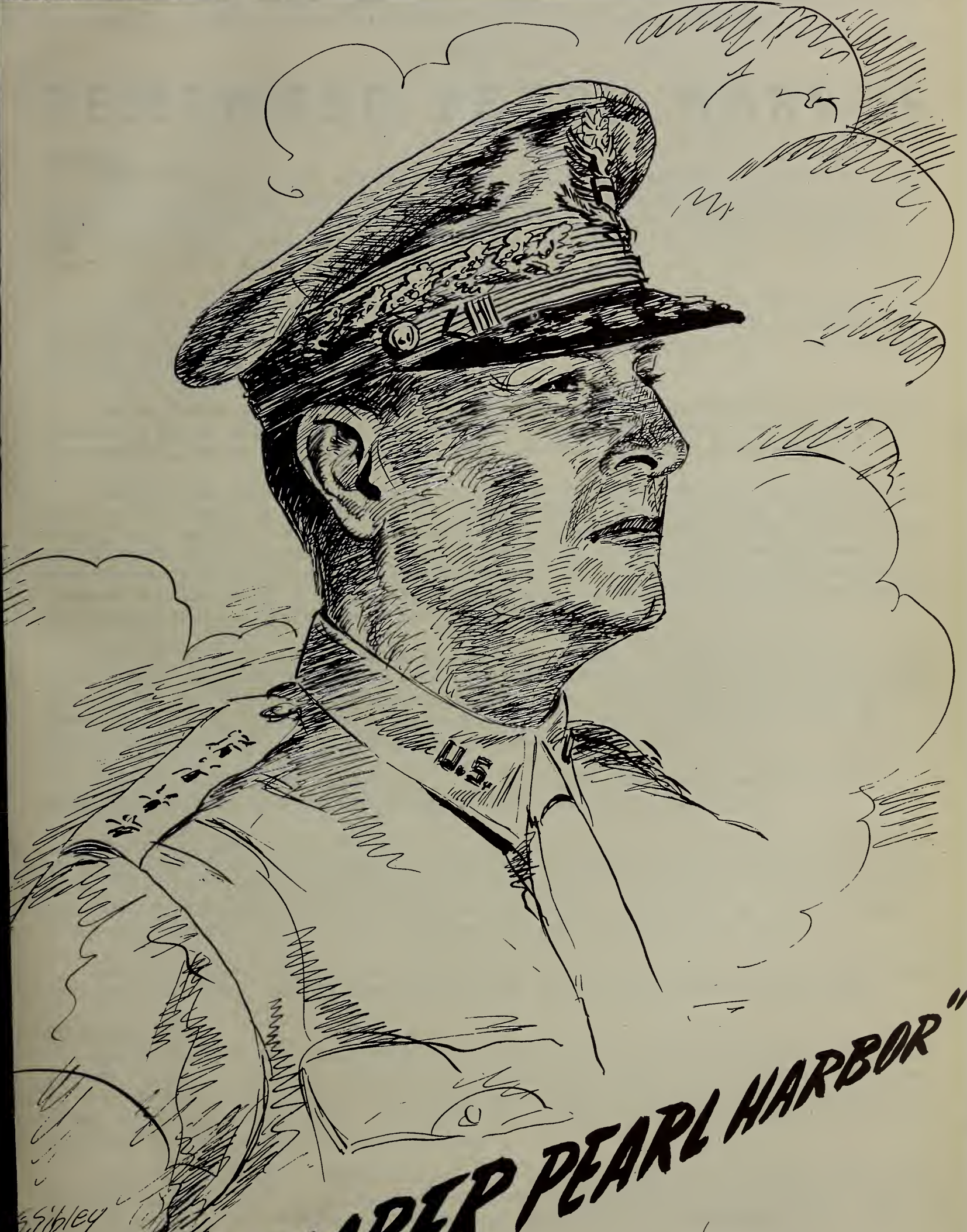

"The Coin Machines Merry-Go-'Round"

"REMEMBER PEARL HARBOR"

DECEMBER, 1941

This was the condition of this industry when on that fateful 7th day of December, 1941, the Japs attacked Pearl Harbor: A stunned, shocked America. A burning anger to fight - to retaliate in kind. Coin machines, like all else, suddenly forgotten as men clenched their fists, tightened their jaws, and swung into the effort required to wreak vengeance on the treacherous Jap.

It wasn't until sometime in Spring, 1942, that the members of this industry realized it was best to continue on until their call came. Many coinmen could not see any future for this business. All thoughts were directed towards war. This industry practically stopped functioning.

As the Summer of 1942 approached, many regained their equilibrium and once again started to guide their businesses with greater care. The industry had, during this shock-period, become demobilized. One magazine after another had deserted it.

The Cash Box came into being during this fateful Summer of 1942 in an effort to re-unite the remaining members of this industry and to help rally them onward. To bring them a medium of a quiet and confidential nature. To help coinmen continue doing business with no outsiders knowing of their dealings nor their methods, and especially not their troubles, legal or otherwise. To create a speedy interchange of information that would be completely and exclusively devoted to the full interests of the members of this coin operated machines industry.

Thruout the Summer and into Fall and Winter of 1942, The Cash Box continued to bring to the remaining members of this industry - courage, faith, and a new and better promise for the future of their business. It strove hard to get a new vision before these men. It continued to present facts, ideas, plans for the future, ways and means for all in this industry to continue onward and upward.

All this is today become history. An indelible mark deeply engraved on the minds and hearts of all who are engaged in this industry at this time.

All during 1943 - The Cash Box continued its efforts to help align the members of this industry with the promise of tomorrow. Completely at its own expense it called together the First and Second Wartime Conferences. It continued to present logic and facts. It helped to point the way for the future. It helped to lift the hopes of the men engaged in this field. Perhaps, too, it succeeded in so doing.

Thruout '44, as all who read The Cash Box will recall, many great ideas and plans have been presented. Surely these do not have to be repeated here at this time.

DECEMBER, 1944

Three eventful years have flown by. Three years that have established new ideas and new ideals. These three years have been of great moment to all who have remained in this industry. These three years have seen a newer and better coin machines man arise. A more ingenious man. A stronger man. A man better fitted for the post-war world to which he so eagerly looks forward.

A man who took old, dilapidated machines and made them attractive and mechanically perfect. Who, from old parts, renovated the instruments of his business. Whose keen showmanship not only won the respect of entertainment loving America but also brought him profit, when all despaired of profit.

A man who helped to bolster and maintain morale. Who brought relaxation to workers as well as to the members of the armed forces. Who proved to himself and to all others that America loved and wanted economical entertainment. Who helped War Bond drives with his gigantic, nationwide phonograph network. Who brought a snack of energetic food to the very doorstep of America's warworkers with his automatic merchandisers. Who has continued to march forward - ever forward.

POST-WAR TRADE-INS

One of the problems which seems to be puzzling a great many coinmen, whether they are operators, jobbers or distributors is, "What about trade-ins of present used equipment in the post-war period?"

This problem arises from the present high prices of used machines. The average seller in this industry feels when the new, post-war machines arrive, that they may be lower priced than what is today being quoted on used machines of ancient vintage. How, they ask, will they be able to arrange for an equitable trade-in price of this old equipment, which they sold at such high price, against the new equipment which may be lower in price?

This problem grows greater, when the average wholesaler in this industry takes into consideration that the coinman may and can demand that he give him a reasonable trade-in price when he is ready to rid himself of most of his used equipment to buy new machines. The wholesaler also realizes that he can't just tell an operator he will allow him \$25. for a machine for which he charged \$175. just a month previously. The divergence in such case is simply too great, and the possibility that he will lose this customer becomes too much of a certainty.

Some coinmen may believe this to be an opportunity to enter into the sales picture and allow greater valuations for used equipment so that they can pull these dissatisfied men to their side of the fence. This will naturally have a harmful effect upon all concerned. Yet it will not answer this problem. But what other answer can the average wholesaler give the man who paid him an inflated price for a machine and is then offered but a fraction of that price in trade-in allowance against the purchase of new equipment?

The average operator, too, is trying to figure just where he will stand in this picture. He wants to know whether the machines which he may purchase right up to the last minute, and which may run into large figures, will be worth even one-tenth of what he pays for them when the time for trading in the machines rolls around. He also wonders whether the average wholesaler with whom he is now dealing is making arrangements to take care of this problem.

All this brings back the suggestion urged on this industry by The Cash Box over 18 months ago, and again just a few weeks ago, that a used machines price cut-back must come into being. Such a cut-back will help make way for an equitable allowance on used machines in the post-war period. Used machines will be lower in price. Naturally, then, the trade-in price, too, will be lower. This price cutback may prove the one and only fashion in which this trade can be assured of an equitable trade-in market arrangement when the new equipment comes into being. There is enough time to arrange for a price cutback now.

It is all well and good to state that every coinman realizes that when the new machines arrive his present equipment is practically valueless. But does he? Will he then trade in used machines, many of which may not have even been amortized, for new equipment, if he feels that the prices of the new equipment against what is offered to him as trade-in allowance for his machines is inequitable? Regardless of how strong the average seller is, he must also realize that the man already in the location has some strength, too, and that he can, for a good length of time continue on with his old equipment and by so doing hold up progressive sales action.

This is one of the problems which all in this industry can decide now, before coinmen enter into heated arguments with men who will find themselves in the very peculiar position of being able to offer only a very small fraction of the original price.

Surely there are enough leaders in this trade who can see the advantages which will accrue from a price cutback at this time. Surely these men realize that this is of major importance to them. They know that the average coinman today has reached the point where he simply cannot buy some of the equipment he wants and needs due to the fact that the price is much too high for him to safely amortize his equipment in the next 12 or 18 months.

"The Coin Machines Merry-Go-Round"

The most liberal finance firms will only give 18 months after a most searching and thoro investigation of any route. Therefore, even on an 18 months basis, many coinmen report that it is impossible to take in enough to even amortize the cost of the equipment at the prices now being asked. They cannot see this equipment lasting more than 18 months on any location. The possibility of post-war production starting up once again prior to 18 months from today is too certain. A price cutback is believed by many to be the answer to this and to many other problems.

SCHOOLS FOR COIN MACHINE MECHANICS

Many months ago, when The Cash Box first proposed that a school for coin machine mechanics be created, this was greeted with what was probably the greatest enthusiasm ever yet expressed by the members of this industry for any idea ever presented to this trade.

Dozens upon dozens of letters, wires and phone calls were received commending this idea and urging that it be put into actual operation as soon as possible. A questionnaire which appeared with this first item, was filled out by almost every leading coinman in the country. All wrote that they were not only willing to contribute money to help make this school for mechanics an actuality, but that they would even be willing to pay tuition for a certain number of men who would be attracted to take the course at such a school.

A school for coin machine mechanics is even of greater necessity today than it ever was before. As this trade enters into the post-war era, its members become acquainted with the fact that many intricate mechanisms are bound to appear. These will definitely require skillful, well trained mechanics.

Electronics is sure to enter into this industry. The phonographs, music-on-film machines, amusement games, merchandisers, and almost all other equipment will be featuring highly technical ideas which the factories have learned from doing war work for Uncle Sam. These post-war machines are expected to be much more intricate in mechanical detail than anything ever before produced in this industry.

Only by creating a school for mechanics now will the average coinman be able to obtain skilled men with a complete knowledge of this type of equipment to help him continue his operations in the most efficient and profitable fashion. Without the help of such topnotch mechanics he will be held back from correct expansion. He will find his hands tied as far as future progress is concerned. It is an accepted fact that any route is only as good as the men who conduct it. And without the proper men to conduct it- of what value is it?

The average coinman also realizes how important skilled mechanics with special training in the mechanisms of this field are to him. He should therefore make it his business to arrange for schools at various points thruout the country so that such mechanics can be trained for his benefit now, and especially for the post-war era.

All large metropolitan centers can be chosen as focal points. For example, New York, Chicago, Cleveland, Detroit, Memphis, Nashville, Dallas, St. Louis, Denver, San Francisco, Los Angeles, Seattle, and whatever other such centers may prove of good value.

At such points should be gathered together the best mechanics of the distributors, jobbers and operators in the area to devote their evenings to training new men. These new men can be brought to the school with the promise of an immediate position with one of the firms sponsoring this plan, after a preliminary training period. These newmen would have to be vouched for by whatever coinman feels he can use them. This coinman would then pay their tuition expense. All would pool together to cover this expense by paying the cost of these experienced mechanics for their evening hours of work as well as the rent and other overhead of the place engaged for lessons.

These schools for mechanics can be created now, so that new men can be trained to take care of present equipment. They can later be sent to factories in Chicago to learn about whatever new equipment is presented. Many returned soldiers have a fine understanding of mechanics. Technical high school students should be invited.

This is the most simple and logical method coinmen can use at this time to get a school for coin machine mechanics started now. By getting together in any territory, coinmen can discuss the necessities that will be required, and can start such a school in operation within 30 days. Surely, all will agree to the importance of such schools all over the nation - to be prepared for post-war.

Once again The Cash Box urges the men of this industry to prepare themselves for the future. All that is required is for one aggressive gentleman in any of the nation's territories to call together all leading coinmen into a meeting. He'll be surprised at the willingness expressed for this plan.

STORM OF PROTEST ON DIRECT SALES

A HAPPY XMAS FOR U. S. NAVY STUDENTS

Demand Firms Be Named For Trade's Benefit. Many Cases Cited. Coinmen Hot.

NEW YORK—What can be termed, without a doubt, to be the biggest protest in all the history of this industry has just come to The Cash Box. The fact is that direct sales have been continually increasing to such a point that leading coinmen from coast to coast have seen fit to openly protest the actions of some of the nation's leading sellers.

On receipt of a large number of these letters, The Cash Box came to the fore and published the facts in the case. Since publication of this item last week, the offices of The Cash Box have been deluged with requests that this work be continued until certain sellers in the trade stop showing storekeepers prices of machines.

One of these men writes, "This is the greatest job you have yet done. This is in keeping with the marvelous suggestions you have already made for the benefit of this industry. By going right to the heart of the problem facing the men in this business we believe you have every opportunity of helping to cure this situation and doing it in such fashion that once and for all there will be no further notification of prices to storekeepers."

Another letter states, "This is the time, before the post-war period gets under way, when the trade can come together and stop some of the actions which have been proved detrimental to its continued good growth. A great many of our sellers in this industry have been making direct sales to storekeepers. This must be stopped."

More and still more letters along these same lines have been arriving at the offices of The Cash Box each day. The Cash Box therefore again appeals to all the trade to work with the men who are in this industry. These men have endured all sorts of hardships. They have undergone rationing, and have to overcome about every type of obstacle to help them maintain a strong nucleus upon which this industry can build for the future. These are the men, the men who are in this business today, who should be given every consideration first.

This does not mean, however, that The Cash Box, in any fashion whatsoever, wants to withhold the future growth and progress of this business. But surely it is to the advantage of the men who are at present in this business to do the right thing wherever and whenever they possibly can.

How much more respect results when storekeepers realize that this industry is a strong, integrated unit. How much more prestige from other trades when they, too, realize that this business is composed of ethical business men who want to further the progress of this industry. Business men who want to keep this business clean and make it anything but a wildcat scheme.

These are the things The Cash Box is fighting for. These are the things we fully believe the men in this industry, too, are fighting for. They want the respect of all other business men. They want prestige from other trades. They want to feel that they, too, are acceptable to their bankers and to all other industries as upright and ethical business men.

This can only become such an industry when the men in this field will it to be such. This will be accomplished only when the field gets together and shows its strength by not allowing prices to become known to storekeepers, so that the secrets of this industry remain its own secrets.

There is no other industry that lets the general public know as much about its inner workings and how it intends to maintain itself as an industry as does this business.

This is the time for everyone in this trade to soberly consider the facts. This is the time to arrange for more complete consideration for all engaged in this business. All this should, and can be done, while this trade is as yet a highly concentrated unit.

There are only a few, a very few, who believe in selling to storekeepers. The others are all against it. These others, therefore, should make it their business to eliminate prices becoming known to storekeepers. This will make the men in this business feel that they are safe and that this field really has a future in which they can invest as heavily as they desire.

Mr. Mical writes, "I am sending you a clipping from the November 16, 1944 issue of our newspaper here. Please note what operators are facing for the future. Under these conditions we just can't operate."

LEO GREEN URGES USED PRICE CUTBACK

NEW YORK—Leo Green of International Coin Machine Distributors, Cleveland, O., visiting at the offices of The Cash Box this past week, reported that he has many times broached the idea of a price cutback on used machines to many distributors, as suggested by The Cash Box for sometime.

Leo stated, "There is no doubt that a price cutback on used machines would prove of great value to all the trade. It would perfectly prepare this industry for the post-war period. Not only am I in agreement with such a cutback, but I fully believe that this can, and should be, arranged immediately."

A meeting of the nation's leading sellers is suggested to arrange for this used machines price cutback which can be easily and quickly arranged on a gradual adjustment basis.

CHICAGO, ILL.—A great opportunity faces all coinmen to help make this coming Xmas one of the happiest in the history of the U. S. Naval Training School in this city by donating old equipment for the recreation room which was created for that purpose.
