

Amstrad recently took a group of journalists to Paris to announce the launch of three new machines - the GX4000 console (which takes ROM cards only and has 64k memory), the CPC 464 Plus (which features a built-in cassette deck and has 64k memory) and the CPC 6128 Plus (which has 3 3-inch disk drive and 128k of memory). LOOKS GOOD

The three new machines all feature the same risternal and hicketure, which is based around the old Amstrad computer boards. But they ve been brought up to date with the addition of a 2k custom chip which juyes super-amount hardware scrolling capabilities, hardware spritted juy to 16 ja and, most importantly, lets you display 32 colours on-screen at the same time from a lette of 4066—which is the same as an Amiga.

SOUNDS GHASTLY

Annoyingly, the sound is the same as the old Amstrad and Spectrum computers, but is now produced in stereo via a new sound driver chip. It's a crying shame that a better sound chip wasn't introduced, as this would have given the machines a real audio boost. As it stands, the sound chip is very limited, and the sort of noises it produces are tinny, harsh and grating.
