The problem is simply that there is no clarifications of the rulings made. The most pertinent question is: "What is an amusement device?" As stated some issues back in The Cash Box the greatest bone of contention between officials and members of this industry has always been to attempt to differentiate between what can be called an amusement machine and what should be known as a gambling device. According to the way the bill is in-

terpreted by the average coinman, if he operates an F. P. pin game and does not allow payouts, then this is an "amusement machine" and therefore subject to the \$10. per year tax. But, if he allows the location to pay off the Free Plays then it becomes a "gambling machine" and the tax is \$100. per year. (Now, in Louisville payoffs have been made on Free Plays and the city authorities see nothing wrong with this practise - but, the Federal Government has changed this attitude on the part of this city's officials and as much as told them that if the Free Plays are cashed in this machine is a gambling device.) In most other cities, payoffs were never allowed on Free Plays (even tho, as we all know, this was the usual practise or the take would have fallen to zero) and therefore those coinmen are going ahead in the way they always have. Also, because of the newspaper publicity attendant to the announcement of this new tax storekeepers are somewhat anxious about it, too, and have been postering coinmen to learn just what it's all about. The only thing that can be done at present is to so adjust operations to meet with the conditions of this new tax bill. Rest assured that clarifications will be made as instances arise. (We only hope that too many instances will not arise). The entire Bill is open to proper adjustments which are sure to come about in time.

WARTIME METHODS

Here are some of the methods being used by coinmen thruout the country and the methods they are asking fellow coinmen to observe for the duration. 1. Because of gas rationing more and more coinmen are making use of tarpaulins to cover open trucks. The angle is to keep machines in transport from one part of the city to another under cover just so no "bluenose" will believe that coinmen are "getting entirely too much gas." 2. Machines are not being dropped off in front of showrooms and offices and being repaired - on the sidewalk. 3. The average coinman has blocked off his display with neat window curtains or venetian blinds. 4. He has removed from his truck the words "coin operated devices" and the same from his store windows. 5. He has eliminated suggestive calendars and other such methods of advertising for the duration. 6. Collections are being made in such fashion that they are not "flashed" in the public's face. 7. From every standpoint coinmen find it much better for their business at this time to operate quietly and discreetly.

COMPLETE RECORDS

For some years now leaders of this industry have learned that it is extremely necessary to their continued good welfare to keep complete records of all transactions. Investigations now under way by Internal Revenue Department in some Midwestern cities may bring about much misery to some of those men who haven't kept step with this necessity. Many are lax about keeping records. They know the necessity of the triplicate collection book and the fact that a collection slip be left with each location as well as maintaining the tissue slip for the legal number of years by allowing it to remain in the serial numbered book and filing the book itself. Also important today are location agreements. Many routes lose much value that do not have agreements (in legal form) signed by location owners. Complete records should be zealously kept today by every coinman. This has become even a greater necessity with increased taxation.

MUSIC QUESTION

Music men - do you believe that the compilation of all records manufactured in the past 12 months, listing their titles and recording artists as well as the serial number of each record and the name of the record manufacturer, would be of value to the music operator? We have learned in our travels about the country that a great many musicops have no method of record control. One suggestion offered was the compiling of all records manufactured in the past 12 months in loose-leaf form which would be of real value to the music operator. What do you think?

Each coinman should report the number of his men who are now in the armed services and this can be taken advantage of by his association to distribute service flags to be hung in the windows of each one of the members to let the rest of the community know that this industry, too, has given a great deal to Uncle Sam.

HONORABLE MENTION

This week goes to John E. Cobb (J.E. Cobb Distributing Co., Louisville, Ky.) for we learned that he was first to start certain motor repairs to benefit the trade and that for many, many weeks kept up this work (which is extremely intricate and delicate) at practically a loss to himself. This service to the industry is one that is sorely needed and the work that John is doing is extremely commendatory.

And Honorable Mention also goes to Carl F. Trippe (Ideal Novelty Company, St. Louis, Mo.) for his efforts in behalf of the scrap drive in his city. Carl donned overalls and heavy gloves, donated his trucks and many of his men and went out and helped pick up scrap himself along with his men for the huge scrap pile that his city got together for Uncle Sam.

And Honorable Mention also goes to Charley Fleischmann (Baltimore Salesbook Company, New York) for the fine work he has done in behalf of the coinmen with collection books and his new location agreement. Suffice it to say that Charley spent many days and nights at his own expense (not his firm's) gathering together the necessary data to create the type of records the trade needed.

(Honorable mention is given to members of the industry for doing something to benefit the entire industry and doing so unselfishly.)
