"The Coin Machines Merry-Go-Round"

A VERY MERRY, MERRY CHRISTMAS TO ALL YOU MERRY GENTLEMEN

To all of you, merry gentlemen, a very merry, Merry Christmas. To all of you who are working harder than ever before to insure yourselves, your families, your friends, your country, continued liberty and happiness and peace, we wish you, one and all, a very merry, Merry Christmas. And we feel, tho somewhat sobered by the thought that this is War Christmas II, that all of us, here in this great and grand country of ours, should bless the

fact that we still have the opportunity of proceeding with a life of liberty and happiness and work (and even sweat and tears) to make this country greater than it ever was so that there will be no War Christmas III, nor any War Christmases again - ever.

THE SEASON FOR It is a fact that at Christmastime there is little will in most of us MERRY-MAKING to continue with our work. Somehow Christmastime has become to all of us a time for merry-making. A time for gathering with our family

and our friends and sort of easing out the old to greet the new. But, this is a War Xmas and so back to work we shall go. To prepare to greet the New Year with spirit, with resourcefulness, with ingenuity, with intelligence, with tolerance, with understanding and with all the fortitude that we command to assure ourselves and all the rest of the country a successful year. Just as war work is important. Just as the continued purchase of War Bonds is important. Just as rationing and all other sacrifices we must make are important - let us remember that planning for the post-war business world is also very important. So important in fact that a large commission is now at work doing this very thing to insure this country continued prosperity after the war.

GUM DOESN'T Just a short item out of Washington. But, an important one to you who STICK ANYMORE use tab, ball and stick gum. The item reports that gum just doesn't stick on retailer's shelves anymore. It also reports that gum is being sold faster than the makers can produce and ship it. Even the production of gum is almost at the same high level as in '41, the shortage is acute. Chicle, as you know, is hard to get. The armed forces are chewing away for all they're worth - gum - not tobacco in this war. And with sugar rationed, too, the public clamor for gum. Gum has risen from a per capita consumption of 39 sticks per person in 1914 to 130 sticks per person in 1941.

SHIPPING CONTINUES The problem of transportation continues to harass some of those men who haven't paid close attention to the fact that deliveries have slowed down considerably on all types of merchandise, not only coin machines.

As suggested many weeks ago, the one and only best method for insuring yourself having machines on location at all times (or in stock) is to anticipate your needs as far in advance as possible. As yet there are no real transportation difficulties. Shipments via truck and railroad and even plane are still coming thru. While the problem of transport has affected all industries, none as yet, have been seriously halted. At the present time carloadings are at peak. The railroads report they have a sufficient number of box (closed) cars and that their real problems are tank and open (flat) cars.

CONSOLIDATE SERVICE AND REPAIRS

One of the major problems facing the trade for sometime now and which will become even more acute as the War Manpower Commission under Paul V. McNutt gets into action, will be mechanics. There has been a howl heard clear across the country in the cointrade regarding the shortage

of mechanics. The real problem will come about in the months to follow. Therefore, it would be of tremendous value to all concerned at this time to consolidate service and repairs wherever possible. Where there are still a goodly number of mechanics available it would be good business as well as good judgment to allow these men to repair machines for all in the territory. In short, just as auto repair places are now consolidating with many types of cars going to one central spot, this same method should now be made effective in this industry so that a centrally located repair center will be available and will be of service to all concerned. By consolidating repair facilities coinmen will find that they will be saving money and insuring their continuance on a more efficient basis.

UNCLE SAM GETS \$10.

The answer to the pin-ball games tax problem is being settled by most coinmen who are taking out the \$10. license. Of course, where affidavits are being pushed under the moses of location owners by Internal

Revenue Department men in some sections of the country, coinmen must remember that they will definitely have to adopt the "no-payoff" idea. The greater majority of storekeepers will not take a chance of offending their Uncle Sam. Therefore, tho it may hurt to

some extent, coinmen must definitely make up their minds (especially those coinmen in territory where the \$100. license may close them down) that if they adopt the \$10. tax angle they will have to stick to it. Some loss in take will most likely result in the beginning.

This was expected by the men in this business who visualized that the same effects curtailment had upon all other industries would eventually have its effect in this trade. Therefore, the tightening up process, brings The Cash Box into greater prominence. It allows the trade, at much less expense, to continue present activities.

WE BRING 'EM Someone wrote us this past week asking how we were able to give a free TO LIGHT ad along with the low cost of the subscription to The Cash Box. The main reason for our plan of giving free space was to have those men who have equipment they feel of too little value to advertise, to bring this equipment to light, so that all the trade could benefit from it. And this is just what is happening. For example, one of our good subscribers in Minneapolis told us when we were there, that he had had some old arcade machines in his basement he just wouldn't advertise because of the prohibitive advertising cost to sell these. But, realizing that it wouldn't cost him anymore, since he was already a subscriber to The Cash Box, he advertised them using the free space to which he is entitled each issue. Ho was not only amazed at the results but has since continued to be one of our most enthusiastic supporters. That, gentlemen, is the main reason for our giving away free advertising space. So that you will bring much equipment to light that many in this field may be able to use and which would otherwise run into a pretty penny if publicized elsewhere.

PARTS NOW

It is interesting to note that some of the better known supply firms in BEING RATIONED this industry have taken the bull by the horns, so to speak, and are conducting a rationing program of their own making. And very wisely, too, if we must say so. They realize that new parts and supplies are frozen by the U.S. in most cases. They also realize now that WPB has no intention of relenting on these freeze orders. Therefore, by carefully rationing whatever stock they have left, they are helping to prevent hoarding in this industry. Most of these are only allowing shipments in emergency cases. Some even demand, we have been told, that the old part be sent to them prior to shipment of the new, so that there is no hocus-pocus about the need for the part. If this is the case then the supply firms are to be credited with using good, hard-headed business sense to protect themselves and their customers and to outlast the war by careful rationing.

THE PRODICALS Some months ago there was a rush by some of the men who had been engaged ARE RETURNING in this industry for some years to suddenly get out of it. They portend ed the doom of this entire industry. They pictured it being scrapped in one resounding booming lump. They said this and that and the other thing. In the past few weeks we have begun to receive letters from a great many of these men advising us that they are cured of other types of businesses and are now back at the old stand and ask us what we think best for them at this time. Of course, we're going to help these men all we can - just like we would any prodigal son returning to the fold.

# RADIO TUBES FOR YOUR PHONOGRAPHS

We stopped selling tubes on October 3rd, but promised to let you know if we were able to build another stock. Not a tube have we been able to buy direct from the manufacturer since the October 3rd Federal Freezing order, and this stock was purchased FROM DISTRIBUTORS AT THEIR ASKING PRICES, and came to us from all over the United States'. We spent hundreds of dollars advertising, phoning, and wiring for these tubes, and although our prices are higher than previously, we hope you will appreciate the fact that we have collected this stock for the Coin Machine Trade.

This January list shows only two tubes which we cannot supply, namely 2A3 and 47. The February list may have to show as many as twenty types which we cannot furnish, as ten days sales might exhaust stocks of eighteen more types. However, in order to assist in keeping our stocks balanced, certain tubes listed below will be "rationed" so that small emergency orders can be handled for as long a time as possible. can't tell you what tubes they will be, as the picture will change from day to day as we fill orders. As an example, we have over 2000 each of 6L6G, 6J5GT and 6K7G as this list goes to press. There'll be no rationing on these types until our stock gets below 500 each. On the other hand, we have only 150 Type 79 tube, but it is a very slow mover, and we may never have to ration #79.

All tubes shipped are in individual cartons - just as you have been buying them from your dealers in the past. There are very few metal tubes, and we substitute glass


